Race 1	HORORATA SUPPORTERS RATING 65 (1800 metres)
<p>M Simons (BUFFALO ROSE) - Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule for failing to declare a rider by the required time.</p> <p>RAPT N RED (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>HILARIOUS (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>MINUTES TO MIDNITE (R Firdhaus) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>PAMIR (H Bennet) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TENFOLD (G Jogoo) – Restrained off heels when racing keenly passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>LEULUAI – Received post-race veterinary attention after becoming entangled when returning to the weigh in stall.</p>	
Race 2	COCHRANES FARM MACHINERY RATING 75 (1400 metres)
<p>RAWMATERIAL (J Laking) – Crowded then restrained shortly after the start. Raced keenly when wide in the early stages.</p> <p>T Comignaghi (SNIPARINDA) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift in shortly after the start when insufficiently clear of RAWMATERIAL which was crowded.</p> <p>ZAWHIP (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider C Johnson advised that after over-racing in the early and middle stages the mare had failed to respond as a consequence.</p> <p>ZAKYNTHOS (A Collett) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 1200 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance. Held up in early in the final straight gaining clear running passing the 225 metres.</p>	
Race 3	SELWYN RAKAIA VET SERVICES THREE-YEAR-OLD (1200 metres)
<p>PIPIANA (BB Hong) – Bounded leaving the barriers. When questioned regarding performance Apprentice Rider BB Hong advised that the filly had raced keenly in the early to middle stages and had not responded as anticipated in the existing track conditions.</p> <p>BENEFICIAL (K Williams) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 700 metres. Lay in throughout the final straight and could not be ridden to full advantage.</p>	

Race 4	PETERSENS JEWELLERS LADIES BRACELET TWO-YEAR-OLD (1000m)
<p>UPSCALE (A Collett) – Slow to begin and further hampered when crowded shortly after the start. Raced greenly approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>FRANGLAIS (T Comignaghi) – Crowded and hampered passing the 950 metres when in restricted room between MIROSLAVA which was dictated out by KHIMAR WAR (J Lowry) and OCEAN OF CHAMPAGNE which was dictated inwards by MISS CURIOUS which lay in despite the efforts of its rider. J Lowry was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>MIROSLAVA (P Shaikh) – Commenced to lay out in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of KERANY passing the 600 metres then clipping a heel and blundering unbalancing rider P Shaikh who lost the use of his left iron for a distance.</p> <p>DEVIL’S STAIRCASE (K Kwo) – Raced greenly approaching the 150 metres.</p> <p>PARIS AWAITS (G Jogoo) – Inconvenienced inside the 100 metres.</p> <p>PICK ME UP IN RIO (C Johnson) – Inconvenienced inside the final 50 metres when crowded by XPRESSMYMIND (C Barnes) which shifted in under pressure. C Barnes was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>XPRESSMYMIND (C Barnes) - Advised that the filly had not been entirely comfortable in today’s track conditions.</p> <p>KERANY - Found post-race to have suffered lacerations to both hind legs with the connections advising that the filly would now be sent for a spell.</p>	
Race 5	R REDPATH LTD RATING 75 (2000 metres)
<p>RUBY ROW (T Moseley) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p>TAXIHOME (L Allpress) – Shifted out at the 300 metres to find clear racing room crowding ABLAZE which was hampered and steadied.</p> <p>ABLAZE (J Lowry) – Crowded and hampered 300 metres having to steady.</p> <p>L Allpress (TAXIHOME) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she angled her mount out near the 300 metres when insufficiently clear of ABLAZE which was hampered with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 31 March up to and including racing on Friday 6 April, 4 national riding days.</p> <p>HUMBLE PIE (R Myers) – When questioned regarding performance Rider R Myers advised that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in the existing conditions and may be feeling the effects of recent racing.</p> <p>L Allpress (TAXIHOME) - Issued with a warning for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>J Lowry (ABLAZE) - Issued with a warning for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>T Comignaghi (WHAT A DEEZA) - Issued with a warning for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 6	YALDHURST WOOLS & NZWTA LTD RATING 65 (1800 metres)
<p>PICKUP (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.</p>	

VIVIDREDSKY (K Gundowry) – Slow to begin. Had to be restrained passing the 900 metres when improving onto heels.

DESERT STORM (R Cuneen) – Over-raced in the early stages.

STONEMASON (K Williams) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

FEDERER EXPRESS (A Collett) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned regarding performance Rider A Collett explained that after being wide for the majority of the event the gelding had not responded once placed under pressure as a consequence.

SHANZINO (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

PASSAMAQUODDY (C Campbell) – Crowded and checked passing the 400 metres.

K Williams (STONEMASON) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift out near the 400 metres when insufficiently clear of PASSAMAQUODDY which was checked with the Judicial Committee suspending her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Monday 26 March, up to and including racing on Wednesday 4 April, 5 national riding days.

A Morgan (SO BRAZEN) - Issued with a warning for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

SON OF ZAC (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.

TIMY TYLER (B Murray) – Raced wide in the early stages.

FLAG THE GROOM (L Allpress) – Lay outwards throughout the final straight.

Race 8	SHARE OPEN SPRINT (1200 metres)

KOLONEL KEV (A Collett) – Began awkwardly and then hampered.

FAIRLIGHT (K Kwo) – Shifted out near the 400 metres to obtain clear running.

BB Hong (JAZZMAN) – Reprimanded by Stewards and reminded of his obligations in that he must ride out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

JOHNNY JONES (T Comignaghi) – Rider dropped her whip passing the 200 metres. Lost the near hind plate during the running.

MADAM BENTLEY – Rider C Johnson was of the opinion that the mare failed to handle the prevailing track conditions.

SHE'STOOHOTTOTROT (J Morris) – Bounded leaving the barriers. Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained.

ELFEE (C Johnson) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground. Held up early in the final straight. Shifted out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

BRING TO THE BLOCK (R Hannam) – Began awkwardly making contact with SMOKE HOUSE BAY with both runners losing ground. Over raced in the early to middle stages. Rider R Hannam reported that the mare had not been comfortable in the prevailing track conditions.

SMOKE HOUSE BAY (T Comignaghi) – Began awkwardly making contact and losing ground.

FLYING SARDINE (B Murray) – Raced wide throughout.

COULEE (J Lowry) – Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres.

EXCELLERATION – When questioned regarding performance rider R Myers advised that the filly had travelled well but failed to respond when placed under pressure from near the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination did not detect any obvious abnormalities.

T Johnson (RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT) - Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

LA FILLE EN JEU (L Allpress) – The connections were reprimanded after removing the blinkers prior to returning to the saddling stalls

Race 10	PAT REARDON FAMILY RATING 65 (1400 metres)

M & M Pitman (DON' T BE CHECKY)- Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting the gelding without notified gear (side winkers).

LAY OFF (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

LETMEGO (C Johnson) – Restrained in the early stages.

DON'T BE CHEEKY (A Morgan) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages. Raced in restricted room near the 1000 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider A Morgan advised that after over-racing in the early stages the gelding had not finished the race off as a consequence.

HOOFBEAT (T Comignaghi) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 950 metres.

MYSTIFY ME (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.

ELANA ROSE (K Williams) – Lay in and had to be straightened near the 250 metres.

BB Hong (CLASSIC WARRIOR) - Issued with a warning for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.
