Race 1	KEVIN MYERS STABLES 2040m
SEA KING (J Seivwright) – Tightened shortly after the start when TALLYHO TWINKLETOE (S Fannin) shifted in dictating CULLISTER inwards. Raced three-wide without cover throughout. S Fannin the rider of TALLYHO TWINKLETOE was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).	
MENDOZA (S Karnicnik) - slow away	

IT'S A WONDER (W Gordon) - had to steady near the 1,300 metres when over-racing

CULLISTER (D Jensen) - raced keenly in the early stages

M CROPP (Pukeake Sam) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) with regards to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 | **LISA LATTA RACING STABLES MAIDEN 1600m**

VENERATE (W Gordon) - slow away (5l)

OUR WONDER (A Kuru) - raced three-wide without cover throughout

MISTER GERONIMO (J Riddell) - Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled out across heels entering the home straight and when doing so was dictated outwards by KANGAROO which cornered poorly when MAY WE ALL Improved to its inside. This resulted in LA JUNGLES being tightened.

LA JUNGLES (D Jensen) – tightened and restrained near the 350 metres

KANGAROO (J Seivwright) - lay out near the 350 metres

Race 3 | **COOKSON RACING MAIDEN 1200m**

THE CHASER (S Rusof) - raced three-wide on the pace without cover throughout

VERBALIZER (T Harris) – slow away

MIDNIGHT POETRY (A Collett) - raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages

BENSON (S MacNab) - raced up on to the heels of **THE CHASER** having to be restrained passing the 1,000 metres

STOCKING (C O'Beirne) – inconvenienced near the 500 metres when **ESTEFANIA** shifted outwards.

FREDEFENDER (L Allpress) – L Allpress was spoken to regarding her whip use on a horse out of contention. When questioned into the disappointing run of **FREDEFENDER** L Allpress advised the gelding raced greenly throughout.

Race 4 | **I G & R J HACKETT FARRIER AND RACING 1200m**

FASCINO LASS (T Johnson) – awkwardly away contacting **MAGICELLA**

MAGICELLA (J Riddell) – Raced keenly passing the 1,000 metres having to be restrained off heels, then held up for a distance from the 700 metres and again near the 300 metres, going to the line not fully tested.

PRAWN STAR (S MacNab) – Tightened approaching the 50 metres when **WINDSOR** was dictated outwards by **NOM DU BEEL** (C O'Beirne) which improved to its inside. **Apprentice C O'Beirne** was advised to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion.

INCANTATION (R Myers) - raced three-wide without cover throughout

Race 5 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1340m**

PINCANTO (A Collett) – Charged the gate as the start was effected, opening its gate marginally early and was subsequently slow away.

STAROSSA (J Fawcett) – raced in restricted room near the 250 metres then dictated wider on the track near the 200 metres

HELENAOFTROY (R Myers) – tightened 200 metres

J RIDDELL (Ballet Choux) - Admitted a breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) in that he allowed his mount to shift outwards when

not sufficiently clear of **HELENAOFTROY** which was tightened, then dictated **STAROSSA** wider on the track before being straightened. **J Riddell** admitted a subsequent charge of careless riding and after submissions had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Monday, 2 April through until the conclusion of racing on Sunday, 8 April – five days.

MISS DOHERTY (J Parkes) – Disappointed finishing well back. When questioned J Parkes was of the opinion the mare may not have been suited to racing near the rail which was described as cutting up. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

MARTINELLI (L Allpress) – When questioned into the disappointing run L Allpress had no particular excuse other than the filly maybe feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 6 | **TINA EGAN RACING MAIDEN 1340m**

THREE WAY CUT (R Hannam) - began awkwardly bumping **GALWAY LIL** at the start

GALWAY LIL (C O’Beirne) - Tightened shortly after the start, then raced ungenerously having to be restrained off heels approaching the 1,000 metres.

HER DESTINY (D Bradley) – raced three-wide without cover throughout

LA SOEUR (L Allpress) – raced keenly throughout

Race 7 | **RAYNERS STABLES MAIDEN 1340m**

DANCING AURIOLE (C Dell) - raced keenly in the early stages

PIRIWAI (J Parkes) - raced three-wide without cover throughout

BLACK ANASTA (J Fawcett) - raced ungenerously in the early stages

NANCEES GOLD (A Shin) – A Shin was advised to exercise greater care after angling his mount inwards shortly after the start dictating **DANCING AURIOLE** and **THUTMOSIS** inwards into the line of **MIDNIGHT STORY** which when being corrected, shifted outward.

BLUE RATA ANNA (L Allpress) - Raced four wide throughout. L Allpress was excused from weighing in after being dislodged on pulling up and after being attended to by paramedics, was cleared.

BOY SOLDIER (R Hannam) – bounded at the start settling back then raced keenly in the early stages

TUSCAN WHISTLER (T Harris) - Was held up entering the home straight and had to be angled inwards near the 250 metres to gain clear running. Ran outwards abruptly near the finish briefly inconveniencing **THUTMOSIS**.

MIDNIGHT STORY (T Johnson) – Steadied shortly after the start. Held up approaching the 600 metres having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running near the 250 metres.
