## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	GARRARD'S HORSE & HOUND MDN
<b>BOOGIE WOOGIE</b> (H Marzuki) - Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground, unbalanced and hampered when bumped near the 800 metres.	
<b>SWITCH PITCHER</b> (J Nason) - Commenced to over race near the 900 metres and raced ungenerously when being restrained shifting outwards hampering GIMMEE EXTRA.	
<b>GIMMEE EXTRA</b> (T Wenn) - Hampered 900 metres.	
<b>DIDI BAY</b> (G Saejorhor) - Over raced when being restrained near the 800 metres and shifted inwards when not fully clear of STAND TALL which when being steadied to avoid that runners heels shifted outwards making contact with BOOGIE WOOGIE which was unbalanced and forced wider. G Saejorhor was advised to exercise greater care.	

**G Saejorhor** - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of HIRAETH which was steadied near the 125 metres.

**HIRAETH** (J Grob) - Steadied to avoid heels 125 metres.

**PINSMAN** (S Weatherley) - Rider advised that the gelding had hung outwards throughout.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>APPRENTICE RIDERS DAY MDN</b>

**MARJI'S GOLD** (T Miles) - Began awkwardly, ran wide rounding the turn near the 600 metres.

**SNOWBELLE** (J Grob) - Steadied when racing in restricted room shortly after the start.

**DEVINE ONE** (T Newman) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

**FASTELLIE** (J Nason) - Raced three wide without cover.

**CHEEKY BEE** (R Elliott) - Shifted outwards under pressure over the final 50 metres.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>VILIGRAD MDN 3YO</b>

**FINE BOUQUET** (T Newman) - Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced, steadied when placed in restricted room rounding the bend near the 800 metres to the inside of EXPEDITION which was taken in slightly by OFF THE GRID (S Weatherley). S Weatherly was advised to exercise greater care.

**SEAN'S SECRET** (D Danis) - Crowded leaving the barriers, raced ungenerously passing the 900 metres making contact.

**STARRYBEEL** (H Marzuki) - Began awkwardly losing ground, when questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse but felt that the colt would benefit from the outing.

**MR LINSKLY** (Z Moki) - Rider dropped the left rein entering the final straight near the 250 metres.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE</b>

**POP DIVA** (J Nason) - Raced in restricted room shortly after leaving the barriers and was briefly steadied.

**LA ACHIEVER** (R Elliot) - Briefly held up passing the 300 metres.

**BABOONSKI** (Z Moki) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 200 metres to the inside of REILLY CENTRAL which shifted inwards under pressure when weakening. Rider H Marzuki was advised to exercise greater care.

**J Grob** - Spoken to with regard to his whip action in the final straight.

**REMEMBER ROSIE** (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race, when questioned regarding performance rider advised the mare had travelled comfortably enough but had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure, underwent a post race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality, trainer G Bedford confirmed that REMEMBER ROSIE would now be sent for a spell.

**WILSON** (E McCall) - Knuckled leaving the barriers then further hampered when crowded, raced wide without cover.

**J Nason** - Issued with a warning after changing riding gear after weighing out.

**VERDANT** (S Weatherley) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>CHIPPERFIELD ALL ROUND EQUINE EDUCATION RATING 65</b>
<p><b>THAILAND</b> (T Abel) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground.</p> <p><b>UNVEILING</b> (K Cowan) - Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>HOT SAKI</b> (E McCall) - Became awkwardly placed on heels when making the crossing near the 1500 metres having to briefly steady.</p> <p><b>GOOD INTENTIONS</b> (J Nason) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>NOTABADROOSTER</b> (D Danis) - Steadied approaching the 900 metres when improving onto heels.</p> <p><b>NOPELE</b> (J Grob) - Raced wide without cover.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE</b>
<p><b>WALKIN' BY</b> (J Nason) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TATTYBOGLER</b> (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BLACK PEARL</b> - Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced.</p> <p><b>ALMARIE</b> (D Danis) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of SACREDVISTA which steadied, a post race veterinary inspection found the mare to have been galloped on suffering a laceration to the right hind lateral cannon area.</p> <p><b>IMBLAZE</b> (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p><b>SACREDVISTA</b> (J Grob) - Rider reported that the filly had felt indifferent in its action, a post race veterinary examination revealed wounds over the flexor tendon to the left hind leg consistent with being galloped on requiring veterinary treatment.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>MARK WEAL L J HOOKER RATING 70</b>
<p><b>CUTTING UP ROUGH</b> (D Hirini) - Made contact leaving the barriers then becoming awkwardly placed on heels and steadied, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>JOE CARGO</b> (D Danis) - Over raced passing the 1600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels, raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.</p> <p><b>PRINCESS DAVONE</b> (T Newman) - When questioned as to why she moved away from the running rail allowing ROGER THAT to improve to her inside near the 800 metres rider advised that she had felt the track on the inside had become cut up and she had been looking for better footing. Whilst her explanation was accepted on this occasion T Newman was shown footage in the presence of the National Riding Mentor and spoken to advisedly.</p> <p><b>SMILING ASSASSIN</b> (R Elliot) - Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1400 metres.</p> <p><b>DELEGATE</b> (K Cowan) - Raced in restricted room when improving into a tight run to the inside of ROGER THAT over the final 50 metres.</p> <p><b>INFINITE JOY</b> - Rider reported that the mare had pulled up sore with a post race veterinary inspection finding INFINITE JOY to have suffered a tendon injury to the left foreleg with a veterinary clearance now required prior to racing again.</p>
