RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NORWOODS MAIDEN (2200 metres)			
POST GRADUATE (C-M Waddell) – Raced three wide from the 1700 metres				
KIWEKA (R Hanna	m) - Held up approaching the 400 metres.			

MISTER GERONIMO (S Weatherley) – Held up behind the tiring LUCQUIDE approaching the 600 metres and again nearing the 400 metres, having to be angled outwards across heels entering the home straight to improve. Lay in under pressure in the home straight having to be straightened near the 100 metres.

STUNNING (M Tanaka) – When questioned into the run M Tanaka advised his mount was comfortable in the going and had no excuse.

LUCQUIDE (J Parkes) - When questioned rider could offer no excuse.

Race 2 HOOPER ENGINEERING RATING 65 (2200 metres)

ACCOLADES (S MacNab) – Awkwardly away. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

HAND IT TO JONESY (R Myers) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages getting its head in the air approaching the 2000 metres and when doing so shifted outwards inconveniencing LINCOLN'S SECRET.

SO IT WAS (A Shin) - Raced keenly for a distance when being restrained approaching the 1600 metres.

WOTAMISSION (S McKay) - Raced keenly for a distance approaching the 1400 metres.

XCESSORY (R Hannam) - Raced three wide without cover.

JUSTA CHARLIE (Z Moki) – Held up entering the home straight having to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running approaching the 100 metres.

GIFTED (C-M Waddell) – Slow away. Gave ground from the 800 metres finishing a distant last. When questioned rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Track upgraded to Dead (6) following Race 2.

Race 3 ULTRASCAN 3YO MAIDEN (1400 metres)

PONDERING (S Collett) – Slow away then raced greenly. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout.

PRINCE OBERYN (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

COOKIE TIME (S MacNab) – Inconvenienced near the 1200 metres. Held up near the 300 metres having to be angled outwards across heels inside the final 100 metres.

DIAMOND DANCER (R Myers) - Made the bend awkwardly approaching the 1200 metres inconveniencing COOKIE TIME. Raced in restricted room over the final stages.

Apprentice Jockey D Hirini (RAINBOW DUNDEE) defended a charge under Rule 636(1)(d) of failing to ride her mount out fully to the finish when able to do so. After hearing evidence the JCA found the charge proved and Ms Hirini had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 14 April up to and including racing on Saturday 12 May (4 weeks).

Race 4 VETFARM MAIDEN (1400 metres)

VENETO (S Collett) - Underwent a veterinary check after being kicked prior to the start and was cleared to run.

CANDY CROSS (C O'Beirne) – Slow away.

MINI COOPA (S MacNab) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages when being restrained.

NEBRASKA (S McKay) – Raced three wide on the pace throughout.

BRAHMARAHMA (M Tanaka) – Due to their being inadequate video footage an inquiry was opened and adjourned into the tightening of BRAHMARAHMA near the 600 metres making contact with the rail and losing several lengths. Also inconvenienced was ALL IN ABREEZE.

SLIGO (R Myers) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

RIP INTO GHIA (R Hannam) – Tightened on the point of the turn when ALL IN ABREEZE (J Parkes) shifted out simultaneously as STRADA ROCCIA (D Hirini) shifted in. After questioning riders both J Parkes and D Hirini were advised to exercise more care. Held up approaching the 100 metres having to be angled inwards to improve.

ALL IN ABREEZE (J Parkes) – Inconvenienced 600 metres. Ran up on to heels having to be restrained when in restricted room near the 200 metres.

SHANGHAI NOON (D Bradley) – Tightened when NEBRASKA shifted outwards abruptly near the 150 metres simultaneously as SLIGO shifted inwards under pressure.

Race 5 KL HARVESTING MAIDEN (1200 metres)

OUR LITTLE RIPPA (L Hemi) –Ducked inwards abruptly after leaving the gates taking no part in the race. Connections were advised that as OUR LITTLE RIPPA had been stood down at its previous start for the same issue the mare is now required to trial on multiple occasions to the satisfaction of stewards prior to next racing. Trainer G Innes advised that the mare may be retired.

JUST GEORGIE (C O'Beirne) - Tightened at start when runners either side shifted ground and clipped a heel and blundered. Ran up on to heels having to be restrained over the final stages.

FIFTYSHADESOFPINK (S Collett) – Tightened, having to be restrained near the 1100 metres when AUTHENTIC CHARM (R Hannam) shifted inwards. R Hannam was advised to exercise more care. gm

BEFORE DAWN (R Myers) – Raced ungenerously making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly. Lay inwards under pressure approaching the 200 metres, having to be straightened. Lay in again near the 100 metres bumping CRAFTYCRIM, dictating CRAFTY CRIM inwards on to AUTHENTIC CHARM.

CRAFTY CRIM (D Hirini) -Bumped 100 metres.

AUTHENTIC CHARM (R Hannam) – Bumped 100 metres.

LEIGHS MATE (J Nason) – Raced three wide throughout.

Race 6 CLARENDON HOTEL MAIDEN (1650 metres)

PENTICOUP (M Hudson) – Slow away settling back then raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages having to be heavily restrained to avoid heels passing the 800 metres running wide on the track then hung outwards rounding the turn. Rider advised the saddle slipped early in the race putting her at a disadvantage.

PRODUCER (J Parkes) – Raced ungenerously getting its head in the air when being restrained in the early stages after being crossed going into the first turn by CASSINO TO TRIESTE (S McKay) which was marginally clear. After questioning J Parkes, S McKay was advised to exercise care. Restrained off the heels of HYPATIA near the 600 metres then held up rounding the turn.

HYPATIA (D Hirini) – Held up for a short distance from the 500 metres.

DAL QUATTRO (J Nason) – Restrained off heels near the 1200 metres.

Race 7 EGMONT WANGANUI HUNT / JOHN ALEXANDER MAIDEN (1650 metres)

LOST FLAG (M Tanaka) – Slow away.

WINEHOUSE (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

OUR CHARLI'S ANGEL (D Bradley) - Raced keenly in the early stagest

CULLEN BOHANNON (J Parkes) – Restrained off heels passing the 800 metres. Bumped with OUR CHARLI'S ANGEL when attempting a narrow run near the 250 metres resulting in OUR CHARLI'S ANGEL becoming unbalanced and shifting out, causing CULLEN BOHANNON to be tightened. A short distance further near the 100 metres CULLEN BOHANNON had to be steadied when REALM shifted in. When questioned J Parkes advised that he eased his mount inside the 100 metres when anticipating the inward movement of REALM.

Race 8 FAREWELL ERIC AND JILL LENNOX RATING 65 (1400 metres)

GATA (L Allpress) – Awkwardly away.

BROTHER ONE (C-M Waddell) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

KATE THE GREAT (R Hannam) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Tightened near the 300 metres when MIKJENE (M Tanaka) was angled outwards simultaneously as DARK PRINCESS (R Myers) shifted in. Stewards took into account simultaneous inward movement from DARK PRINCESS when assessing the interference. Nevertheless M Tanaka was issued with a warning.

DESANO (M Hudson) - The saddle moved forward during the race but shifted back prior to the finish.
