Race 1	MID WINTER CHRISTMAS RACES JUNE 23 MAIDEN (1200m)					
ITSTOLATE (P Shaikh) – Slow to begin.						
FUNNY FACE (LA	llpress) – Crowded at the start and lost ground. Dismounted shortly after pulling up and was led back to					

FUNNY FACE (L Allpress) – Crowded at the start and lost ground. Dismounted shortly after pulling up and was led back to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the filly to be a bleeder and accordingly was stood down for the mandatory three months with a vet clearance required prior to racing next.

MISS DIORELLA (C Campbell) – Raced wide throughout.

SHARP 'N' SILVER (T Moseley) – Raced wide throughout.

MONZA CIRCUITO (R Mudhoo) – Over raced near the 700 metres, had difficulty obtaining clear racing near the 350 metres.

REDFORD (G Jogoo) – Had difficulty obtaining clear racing in the early stages of the home straight.

P Shaikh (ITSTOLATE) was spoken to advisedly regarding whip use prior to the 100 metres.

R Mudhoo (MONZA CIRCUITO) was spoken to advisedly regarding whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 GAVELHOUSE.COM TWO-YEAR-OLD (1000m)

J Laking (DEVIOUS) admitted a breach of Rule 649(1) in that he attempted to weight out without his irons, with the Judicial Committee imposing a suspension of his licence to ride at race meetings for 2 weeks effective from the conclusion of racing on 24 April up to and including 8 May 2018.

OPHELIA ROSE (K Williams) – Over raced for a short distance shortly after the start.

DEVIOUS (J Laking) – Over raced when leading throughout. Rider reported that the gelding had failed to settle during the running.

MONTREUX MISS (J Morris) – Raced wide throughout.

NORMA JEAN (S Wynne) – Over raced and became awkwardly placed on the heels of MONTREUX MISS near the 600 metres, inconvenienced and steadied near the 50 metres.

DEVIL'S STAIRCASE (D Bradley) - Lay inwards under pressure in the final stages.

XPRESSMYMIND (C Barnes) – Lay inwards passing the 50 metres inconveniencing NORMA JEAN, FINAL SAVINGS and PARIS AWAITS which had to be steadied. Rider reported that the filly had hung throughout the running and had not been aided by being taken on when in the lead.

FINAL SAVINGS (C Johnson) – Inconvenienced and steadied near the 50 metres.

PARIS AWAITS (L Callaway) - Inconvenienced and steadied near the 50 metres.

Race 3 SPEIGHT'S RATING 75 (2000m)

OPIHI JADE (L Allpress) – Slow to begin and then crowded shortly after the start losing ground, angled across heels passing the 350 metres to find clear racing.

CAN YOU HEAR ME (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly shifting ground outwards and crowding outside runners.

TAXIHOME (R Cuneen) – Began awkwardly and then raced keenly in the early stages, improved wide from the 800 metres.

HI YO UGO (S Muniandy) – Crowded at the start and lost ground, lost its stride momentarily passing the 900 metres.

LONG HABOUR (J Laking) – Raced wide in the early stages.

TRAVEL WISE (T Jonker) – Raced wide throughout.

MADAM DE SOIR (S Wynne) – Awkwardly placed close to heels near the 900 metres, rider dropped her whip at the 300 metres.

SHANZINO (C Johnson) – Held up early in the run home.

Race 4BREEDERS ASSOCIATION FILLIES OR MARES BONUS RATING 65 (1400m)YOURLIPS AR MOVIN (C Campbell) – Slow to begin, inconvenienced and steadied near the 1000 metres.

OPIHI RANGER (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin, inconvenienced and steadied near the 1000 metres.

FIRE LILY (J Lowry) – Raced wide and keenly in the early stages.

RICHIE RICH (A Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

PETITE MIDAS (T Moseley) – Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages, raced ungenerously near the 1000 metres and had to be steadied resulting in the trailing KHORABELLA, YOURLIPS AR MOVIN and OPIHI RANGER all having to be steadied as a consequence.

GOLDEN BAY (R Hannam) – Over raced in the early stages.

KHORABELLA (R Cuneen) – Inconvenienced and steadied near the 1000 metres.

ROBIN CHARLES (M Tanaka) – Raced wide throughout.

THOM BROWN (C Johnson) – Held up for the majority of the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 100 metres.

WHY ME (P Shaikh) – Placed in restricted room passing the 150 metres when REBEL ROSE lay inwards at this point, then held up only gaining clear racing room passing the 50 metres.

REBEL ROSE (J Laking) – Lay inwards throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 5 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO OPEN SPRINT (1200m)

The start was delayed when several runners proved difficult to load.

JAZZMAN (BB Hong) – Bounded at the start.

DON CARLO (K Williams) – Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runners, bumped at the 400 metres.

SHAARA (G Jogoo) – Crowded at the start

FIVE KINGS (L Allpress) – Slow to begin, held up over the concluding stages and went to the line untested by its rider.

ZAWHIP (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout.

DRESSEDTOKILL (L Callaway) – Raced keenly early and had to be steadied passing the 1000 metres when JAZZMAN (BB Hong) improved forward to lead, lay in passing the 400 metres making brief contact with DON CARLO, crowded again at the 300 metres when DON CARLO had to shift out to avoid the heels of JAZZMAN which lay out under pressure at this point. **BB Hong** (JAZZMAN) was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

JOHNNY JONES (T Comignaghi) – Held up for the majority of the run home.

MORSE CODE (P Shaikh) – Crowded at the start, had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.

KOXINGA (A Collett) – Held up from the 400 metres improving quickly onto the heels of the tiring DRESSEDTOKILL passing the 250 metres having to be steadied inwards crowding TWOZNOTENOUGH.

TWOZNOTENOUGH (T Moseley) – Crowded at the 200 metres.

GALWAY GARRY (B Murray) – Crowded shortly after the start and got back.

SHE'S A RIPPER (L Allpress) - Raced very keenly while leading through the early to middle stages.

NOWHERE MAN (BB Hong) – Held up in the early stages of the run home for some distance only gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.

LONGFORD (J Lowry) – Held up near the 350 metres and had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running.

Race 7 NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK WARSTEP STAKES (2000m)

ZA ZA GABOR (T Moseley) – Slow to begin, brushed with COURTE ZARINDI near the 200 metres and bumped at the 100 metres being shifted wider on the track and brushed again in the shadows of the post.

RESPIN (D Bradley) – Slow to begin.

GIPSYROCKER (S Wynne) – Raced wide in the early stages.

PODRAVINA (L Allpress) – Over raced in the early stages, held up near the 350 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no tangible excuses and advised that the filly had failed to let down over the concluding stages.

MERCY HILL (A Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

THE SPARKLE (J Laking) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

COURTE ZARINDI (T Comignaghi) – Lay out over the concluding stages and brushed with ZA ZA GABOR at the 200 metres and was then straightened and again shifted out at the 100 metres bumping with ZA ZA GABOR, shifted out under pressure in the concluding stages.

T Comignaghi (COURTE ZARINDI) was warned for shifting ground over the concluding stages.

CARICATURE (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the early stages, raced in restricted room rounding the final bend. When asked to comment on performance the rider reported that the filly had raced keenly early but had failed to respond to his urgings and he could offer no excuse for the performance.

GREENPARK GEM (R Cuneen) – When asked to comment on the performance of the filly the rider advised in his opinion she had not backed up from recent racing and may not have seen out the distance of today's race.

The connections of 2nd placed **ZA ZA GABOR** lodged a protest against 1st placed **COURTE ZARINDI** alleging interference over the concluding stages. After reviewing replays and hearing evidence the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

T Moseley (ZA ZA GABOR) was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 8 COCA-COLA CANTERBURY GOLD CUP (2000m)

The start was delayed 3 minutes due to the protest in the previous race.

SON OF ZAC (C Barnes) – Slow to begin and slow through the early stages.

TIMY TYLER (L Callaway) – Got its head up when over racing in the early stages.

TRAVIMYFRIEND (C Johnson) – Raced wide in the early stages, raced wide from the 800 metres.

ENDEAN ROSE (A Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

AUTHENTIC PADDY (R Hannam) – Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the performance other than feeling the effects of recent racing.

B Murray (FLYING SARDINE) admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 11 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 24 April up to and including 9 May.

L Allpress (SAINT EMILION) was warned for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 9 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (2000m)

KEEP THE LOT (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

TUILANA (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages, held up early in the run home. When questioned about performance the rider advised that the mare got back, travelled well but failed to let down in the final stages.

FEDERER EXPRESS (A Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

HARDCASE (D Bradley) – Held up rounding the bend near the 500 metres.

SO BRAZEN (S Wynne) – Held up early in the run home.
