RACE COMMENTS:

GENERAL:

Race 1	LINCOLN FARMS SALUTE TO THE STARS (1400 metres)

RAINBOW DUNDEE (J Parkes) - Hampered start when SATIN BELT was bumped outwards by MALO BIK which began awkwardly.

SATIN BELT (L Allpress) - Bumped start.

MALO BIK (D Turner) - Began awkwardly, over-raced when being restrained in the middle stages, had to be angled outwards across heels to improve near the 300 metres.

BEAUDEN (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Race 2 SAVVY COUP CUP (1600 metres)

KIWEKA (S Weatherley) - Jumped away awkwardly unbalancing its rider losing ground, raced keenly in the early stages.

OUR JOCKO (A Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

CALVADOS (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover throughout, rider dropped whip near the 200 metres.

SLIGO (R Myers) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse.

Race 3 AVANTAGE CUP (1200 metres)

PADDY BOURKE (T Johnson) - Jumped away awkwardly, had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

SWEEPSTAKE (R Myers) – Inconvenienced start when BALLYBAY jumped inwards.

BALLYBAY (S Collett) – Hung outwards in the final straight making contact with RAYAS near the 200 metres.

LA BELLA ROSA (L Hemi) - Briefly inconvenienced near the 250 metres

Race 4 START WONDERING CUP (1200 metres)

MADAM ACE (C Johnson) – Reared at the start losing ground, held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres, lost near hind plate during the running.

LODI (S Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly, held up entering the final straight and did not obtain clear running until angling outwards across heels near the 250 metres, rider S Collett issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

CRAFTY CRIM (S Weatherley) – Held up early in the final straight then when attempting a marginal run between NANCEES GOLD and VENETO near the 250 metres VENETO shifted inwards slightly under pressure with CRAFTY CRIM making contact with that runner's hind quarters, unbalancing VENETO with CRAFTY CRIM then making contact with NANCEES GOLD which was bumped inwards on to DESTINY ONE, which had to be steadied, S Weatherley was advised to exercise care, rider dropped his whip near the 150 metres.

DESTINY ONE (C-M Waddell) – Hampered having to be steadied near the 250 metres.

VENETO (L Allpress) – Unbalanced when receiving contact to hind quarters near the 250 metres.

NANCEES GOLD (A Shin) – Bumped 250 metres.

PLAY THE FIELD (J Parkes) - When questioned rider advised the mare had been unable to quicken in the ground.

Race 5 STOLEN DANCE CUP (1000 metres)

CASAQUINMAN (D Turner) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after being kicked behind the barriers being passed fit to run, began awkwardly settling back then raced ungenerously for a short distance when being restrained.

DREAMS OF PLATINUM (L Allpress) – After becoming fractious in the barriers was removed to undergo a veterinary inspection and passed fit to run, raced three wide on the pace throughout.

VATICAN NEWS (T Allan) - Jumped in the air at the start,

BROTHER ONE (C-M Waddell) – Hampered approaching the 200 metres when LEIGHS MATE (A Collett) was tightened and dictated outwards by AVASTIN (J Parkes) which shifted out and away from DREAMS OF PLATINUM (L Allpress) which lay out under pressure and continued to lay out resulting in AVASTIN having to steady near the 175 metres. Rider L Allpress was advised to exercise care.

LEIGHS MATE (A Collett) – Tightened and dictated approaching the 200 metres. Required veterinary treatment following the race for a wound to the left hind leg consistent with the gelding having been galloped on during the race.

AVASTIN (J Parkes) - Dictated outwards approaching the 200 metres having to be restrained near the 175 metres

MAGICELLA (S Weatherley) – Lay out under pressure in the home straight inconveniencing DANCE FOR MONEY near the 50 metres. S Weatherley was advised to exercise case. Prior to the authorisation of dividends trainer G vile viewed footage but elected not to proceed with a protest.

Race 6 FIVE TO MIDNIGHT CUP (2100 metres)

SHADOW KING (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly, crowded 150 metres.

T Allan (GORBACHEV) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres and had his licence to ride in races suspended by the Judicial Committee from the close of racing on Wednesday, 25 April up to and including racing on Wednesday 2 May (5 days).

M Tanaka (SHARED SECRETS) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after allowing his mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear crowding SHADOW KING near the 150 metres.

SYLVESTER (S Collett) – Lost front off plate during the running.

Race 7 SCOTT BASE CUP (1400 metres)

BRING TO THE BLOCK (D Turner) – Jumped away awkwardly.

BLACK SAV (A Collett) - Held up near the 250 metres having to be angled inwards across heels to gain clear running passing the 150 metres.

CLASSIC TOUCH (R Hannam) – Inconvenienced, bumping with BRING TO THE BLOCK near the 200 metres when SUGAR RUSH shifted out under pressure before being straightened then bumped with BRING TO THE BLOCK on a number of occasions over the final stages.

OPHELIA LEE (M Tanaka) - Briefly held up approaching the 200 metres.

MCPHOEBE (S Collett) - Raced in restricted room inside the final 100 metres when OPHELIA LEE lay inwards.

Race 8 KAWI CUP (1600 metres)

BANSTEAD (A Collett) - Lay inwards near the 800 metres bumping TOMS then shifted out contacting COTTONEVA which was inconvenienced.

COTTONEVA (J Parkes) – Hampered 800 metres.

C O'Beirne (TOMS) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) after angling her mount outwards when not clear of DAL SIR TEE which was crowded then checked near the 300 metres and had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 29 April up to and including racing on Sunday 6 May (5 days).

DAL SIR TEE (T Johnson) – Crowded then checked near 300 metres.

WHIPPED (R Myers) - Held up passing the 400 metres making contact with the hind quarters of BUSHFIRE approaching the 300 metres, turning that runner inwards.

BUSHFIRE (B Lammas) – Unbalanced when receiving contact to the hind quarters near the 300 metres.

GIFTED (L Allpress) – Held up for a short distance passing the 300 metres.
