Race 1	MILLS REEF WINERY 1600
	<p>CABALLO GRANDE (J Seivwright) – Crowded start, steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>TRIUMPH (H McNeill) – Began awkwardly before being further hampered when crowded.</p> <p>MASTAPLAZA (A Kuru) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>E Farr – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount REGAL DANCER to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear dictating STARTLING REMINDER inwards placing SILVERADO in restricted room approaching the 1000 metres.</p> <p>SILVERADO (M Roustoby) – Steadied after being placed in restricted room approaching the 1000 metres, briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 550 metres.</p>

WILSON (C Studd) – Raced wide without cover.

REGAL DANCER (E Farr) – Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 550 metres.

MISHKA (W Gordon) – Briefly held up entering the final straight near the 350 metres, had to shift ground inwards passing the 50 metres after improving onto heels.

Race 2 | **DAVID WRIGHT MEMORIAL 2100**

BEVERLEY BECK (C Studd) – Slow to begin (4L), hampered 175 metres when avoiding fallen runners.

STORMING THE TOWER (G Walsh) – Commenced to over-race when the pace eased near the 1800 metres.

RAAJ (M Roustoby) - Over-raced when the pace eased passing the 1800 metres, then continuing to over-race through the middle stages, severely hampered 175 metres dislodging rider, underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a superficial wound to the medial left hind cannon.

J'WALKE (E Farr) - Over-raced when pace eased passing the 1800 metres, raced wide for the majority of the race.

NOAH JON (H McNeill) - Raced wide without cover throughout, hampered 175 metres when avoiding fallen runners.

GUESS WHO (T Harris) – Went amiss and fell passing the 175 metres dislodging rider T Harris who was uninjured, SOLDIER FIELD and RAAJ which were following were unable to avoid the fallen runner with SOLDIER FIELD being bought down dislodging rider A Kuru who was uninjured and RAAJ being severely hampered dislodging rider M Roustoby who was also uninjured. Badly hampered when avoiding the incident was IMRAN. GUESS WHO was quickly attended to by the veterinarian and humanely euthanised as it was found to have a compound fracture of the left fore fetlock.

SOLDIER FIELD (A Kuru) – Bought down 175 metres, underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have a small abrasion to the right corpus and right stifle.

IMRAN (J Riddell) – Badly hampered 175 metres.

WHITE DIAMOND (W Gordon) – Hampered 175 metres when avoiding fallen runners.

Race 3 | **GREERTON TAB 1300**

FASTELLIE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly then further hampered when crowded, over-raced when being restrained near the 1100 metres continuing to race ungenerously through the middle stages, held up early in the final straight.

ICEBOMB (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground, lay inwards in the final straight when placed under pressure.

MISTER PINNS (S Spratt) – Slow away.

IFFIDA (M Du Plessis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout, briefly steadied to avoid the heels of ICEBOMB which lay in near the approaching the 100 metres, M McNab was advised to exercise care.

SALT BAY (J Bayliss) – Held up until passing the 200 metres.

BOOGIE WOOGIE (L Satherley) – Held up until near the 200 metres.

BADEA (M Cameron) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

Race 4	THE INFORMANT PUNTER OF THE YEAR SATURDAY 23RD JUNE 1300
<p>POLITELY (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly then further hampered when bumped by SMILING PROUD which also jumped away awkwardly, raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SMILING PROUD (M Cameron) – Jumped away awkwardly, raced wide without cover throughout, checked when crowded near the 150 metres after being bumped by RUSALKA simultaneously as COME BACK TIGER shifted inwards, both T Thornton and J Fawcett were advised to exercise care.</p> <p>PERINZEPHY (R Scott) - Began awkwardly hampering MIZZELLI.</p> <p>MIZZELLI (S Weatherley) – Hampered start, had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.</p> <p>WILD CHILD (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1000 metres, inconvenienced near the 75 metres when POLITELY shifted inwards, J Bayliss was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>L Satherley – Issued with a warning after permitting her mount SECRET DREAMS to shift inwards when not fully clear of FULL OF GRACE which had to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of SECRET DREAMS passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>FULL OF GRACE (S Rusof) – Firmly restrained to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres then commenced to over-race, rider dropped whip near the 150 metres.</p> <p>LEONARDO (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover throughout, inconvenienced near the 50 metres when placed in restricted room.</p> <p>TOFFEE POP (A Collett) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>RUSALKA (T Thornton) – Hung outwards throughout making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly, made contact with SMILING PROUD when shifting outwards attempting to obtain clear running near the 150 metres then being held up for the remainder of the race.</p>

<p>DEVIL MAY CARE (S Rusof) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>NEW CROWN (S Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>CAMEAHOTFRIDAY (R Scott) – Began awkwardly, wide without cover for majority of race.</p> <p>UJJAYYI (D Johnson) – Lay inwards when placed under pressure in the final straight, when questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>SHOWTENAIRE (A Collett) – Inconvenienced near the 50 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of ZEDSATIONAL which shifted away from UJJAYYI.</p>	
Race 6	SANPELLEGRINO 1400
<p>STORYTIME (D Johnson) – Crowded start.</p> <p>YORKSHIRE DALES (A Collett) – Began awkwardly, raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>TERRIFIQUE (S McKay) – Began awkwardly before being further hampered when crowded, raced ungenerously making the bend near the 900 metres.</p>	

WAGNER (J Nason) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

NO LOITERING (D Danis) – Briefly raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres when runners to either side shifted ground.

LINK ROAD (S Weatherley) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.

THATSFORSURE (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse advising that the mare had been disappointing.

Race 7

BOYS GET PAID GET OUT STAKES 1600

RED MY MIND (J Riddell) – Jumped away awkwardly, held up rounding the final turn then having to shift outwards passing the 200 metres in an attempt to obtain clear running before improving onto heels having to be steadied over the concluding stages when disappointed for a run between MY PRIDE AND JOY and LUEN YAT MIRACLE which both shifted ground.

THAILAND (T Abel) – Began awkwardly then was crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied, lay in under pressure in the final straight.

NAUGHTY KNUCKLES (A Schwerin) – Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of RED JOHN (S Spratt) which shifted inwards near the 900 metres, S Spratt was advised to exercise care.

COURTMASTER (D Prastiyou) – Had to be steadied when racing keenly approaching the 1000 metres.

AVEC MOI (J Bayliss) – Raced three wide without cover.

FALKIRK LASS (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover.
