GENERAL:

No issues to report.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Think Water Cambridge Premier (2400 metres)
ITSABIRD (R Norvall) - Slow to begin, raced wide from near the 1100 metres.	
WILIJONMCBRIDE (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.	
JAKE THE MUSS (M Cameron) - Held up rounding the final turn and could not obtain clear running until shifting outwards passing the 150 metres.	
NOTABADROOSTER (J Nason) - Briefly steadied when crowded passing the 250 metres by LUCKY DREAMER (L Satherley) which had shifted in when struck with the whip, L Satherley was advised she must exercise greater care, again inconvenienced approaching the 150 metres and forced wider on the track.	

EYE'S WIDE OPEN (S Spratt) - Dictated wider on the track over the final 50 metres by AIGNE which shifted outwards under pressure.

PRINCESS EL JAY (S Weatherley) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

LUCKY DREAMER (L Satherley) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had travelled well but had failed to respond once placed under pressure in the final straight and she was of the opinion that it may not have seen out the 2400 metre distance.

Race 2 | **AON Insurance Brokers Premier (1200 metres)**

LEWIS CAROLL (S Collett) - Slow to begin (3L), forced wide 400 metres.

VOLPE VELOCE (J Bayliss) - Shifted outwards to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres forcing LEWIS CAROLL wider on the track, J Bayliss was advised he must exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 3 | **Cambridge Equine Hospital Premier (1200 metres)**

STAR PERFORMANCE (A Collett) - Began awkwardly.

WAY ABOVE (A Calder) - Slow to begin, shifted outwards across heels making the bend near the 800 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of IRON EAGLE.

ELATE (V Colgan) - Slow to begin.

QIJI POWER (T Harris) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.

EXEMPLAR (M McNab) - Raced wide in the early stages, returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils which upon veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination was found to be from external trauma.

IRON EAGLE (S Collett) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

OUR WONDERLAND (R Elliot) - Had to steady passing the 700 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of EXEMPLAR (M McNab) which shifted in when not fully clear, M McNab was advised to exercise greater care.

NIRVANA IN FIRE (C Lammas) - Hung outwards throughout making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

Race 4 | **Maara Grange Rehabilitation and Fencing Premier (1600 metres)**

LINCOLN RAIDER (M McNab) - Slow to begin, raced keenly through the middle stages.

LINCOLN STAR (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOT USUAL TALENT (D Johnson) - Restrained soon after jumping from a wide barrier.

KONSTANTINA (M Cameron) - Crowded near the 500 metres when O'SAM lay in, raced in restricted room from near the 350 metres to the inside of O'SAM which lay in despite the efforts of its rider with KONSTANTINA then being steadied passing the 150 metres and not being persevered with for the remainder of the race.

EXECUTIVE POWER (T Harris) - Lay inwards in the final straight.

Race 5 | **Travis Stakes (Group 2) (2000 metres)**

PLATINUM COMMAND (K McCulloch) - Began awkwardly, passing the 1700 metres became awkwardly placed inside the heels of MIME for a distance.

YOUWANTMORE (A Collett) - Made brief contact with OUR ABBADEAN when denied clear running passing the 400 metres.

COTE D'OR (D Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses but was of the opinion that the mare may have come to the end of its preparation. Trainer K Kelso advised that the mare would be spelled.

Race 6 | **Maneline Cambridge Premier Fasttrack \$5K Bonus (1200 metres)**

ISLAND BAY (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly losing ground, over-raced when being restrained near the 900 metres, bumped near the 250 metres when ELUSIVE METEOR was taken out by FULLINBLOOM, had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of FULLINBLOOM which shifted away from LEGRAMOR near the 100 metres, with ISLAND BAY not being persevered with for the remainder of the race.

ELUSIVE METEOR (J Nason) - Began awkwardly.

TRUEMAN (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly.

CINEMATIC (K Chowdhury) - Crowded leaving the barriers between ELUSIVE METEOR which had begun awkwardly shifting inwards and TRUEMAN which also had begun awkwardly shifting outwards, made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when being steadied after improving onto the heels of LEGRAMOR then having to be further restrained to again avoid the heels of LEGRAMOR which shifted outwards.

SOUTH FORK (S Collett) - Held up near the 350 metres having to shift inwards across the heels of CHICANE to obtain clear running.

LEGRAMOR (M Cameron) - Held up near the 350 metres continuing to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

FORTUNE PATCH (S Weatherley) - Bumped near the 50 metres when CINEMATIC lay out. Following the race the connections of the 3rd placed horse FORTUNE PATCH viewed Stewards' footage before electing not to proceed with a protest against the 1st placed horse CINEMATIC.

Race 7 | **Inglis Sales Cambridge Breeders Stakes (Group 3) (1200 metres)**

MALAMBO (R Elliot) - Underwent a veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers after making contact with a fence leaving the parade ring being passed fit to run, briefly steadied near the 250 metres, inconvenienced near the 100 metres when HANGER shifted outwards.

PROM QUEEN (A Collett) - Crowded start when MERLINI began awkwardly and shifted inwards, crowded and forced inwards approaching the 1100 metres having to steady, lost the left hind plate shortly after the start, raced three wide without cover, unbalanced when hind quarters contacted near the 100 metres then not being persevered with for the remainder of the race, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that after jumping from an outside barrier the filly had not been suited being unable to obtain cover, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

ASTOR (S Collett) - Bumped start, crowded and checked approaching the 1100 metres, raced wide without cover, when questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the filly may have come to the end of its preparation.

J Nason (MERLINI) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards near the 1100 metres when not sufficiently clear of PROM QUEEN which was crowded and forced inwards onto ASTOR which was

checked with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 5th May up to and including racing on Thursday 17th May 2018 - 8 national riding days.

OZIL (J Riddell) - Slow to begin then further hampered losing ground.

POP STAR PRINCESS (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly and shifted inwards making contact with OZIL then blundering, hampered near the 1000 metres when PAULOWNIA went off stride then ducking away from that runner having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of THE GREAT SOUTHERN, rider reported that the filly had faltered in the early stages then feeling indifferent in its action for the remainder of the race. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

LE CASTILE (V Colgan) - Hampered soon after leaving the barriers, over-raced in the middle stages, ducked outwards rounding the final turn near the 450 metres, when attempting a run to the outside of CAESOUR'S DREAM was dictated outwards when CAESOUR'S DREAM lay out near the 100 metres with LE CASTILE making contact with the hind quarters of PROM QUEEN unbalancing that runner.

THE ICE KNIGHT (T Harris) - Contacted soon after leaving the barriers becoming briefly unbalanced, over-raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres and shifted outwards hampering SACRED CHARM which then raced ungenerously for a distance.

PAULOWNIA (M McNab) - Went off stride badly near the 1000 metres with the rider reporting immediately following the race that he thought the filly had gone amiss at that point but had recovered although never really travelling comfortably for the remainder of the race, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SACRED CHARM (M Coleman)- Hampered near the 1000 metres and raced ungenerously for a distance, held up near the 200 metres having to shift outwards to obtain clear running.

HANGER (L Innes) - Held up rounding the final turn and was unable to obtain clear running until shifting outwards passing the 150 metres.

LEEDS (R Hannam) - Dropped its head as the start was effected losing ground (5L).

DOIKNOWYOU (T Harris) - Crowded leaving barriers.

SHADOWS (A Schwerin) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SHOWEMUP (M Coleman) - Heavily contacted leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced, hampered 1000 metres.

J Fawcett (GALAXY MISS) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift inwards passing the 1000 metres when not sufficiently clear of DONNA ANNE BILLY which had to shift outwards to avoid that runners heels hampering SHOWEMUP.

DONNA ANNE BILLY (T Thornton) - Steadied and shifted outwards to avoid heels 1000 metres.
