# **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 NOVUS AUTO GLASS NAPIER MILE (1600metres)

STARRYBEEL (S Wynne) - Slow to begin, made the bend awkwardly near the 1500 metres when racing ungenerously

**VANNOSS** (C Johnson) -Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied

**CULLEN BOHANNON** (S McKay) - Raced wide without cover throughout

**TERRA FIRMA** (R Myers) – Held up early in the final straight before shifting inwards approaching the 200 metres to obtain clear running

**UPMARKET** (M Tanaka) - Had to be steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HEART OF FAME (A Jones) which shifted in approaching the 200metres.

A Jones was advised to exercise more care.

**SACRED DELIGHT** (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the final bend having to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

### Race 2 VERTIGO CATERING @ HB RACING MILE (1600 metres)

**STACEY ANN** (D Hain) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after dislodging its rider in the preliminary and was cleared to start.

**LONDARO** (M Tanaka) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after dislodging its rider in the preliminary and was cleared to start, raced in restricted room near the 100 metres.

**IRISH CALL** (L Allpress) - Slow to begin, when questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding was unsuited to today's track conditions.

**LADY GUINESS** (C Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages, tightened near the 100 metres when STACEY ANN (D Hain) lay out under pressure simultaneously as DISTURBANCE (CM Waddell) shifted in resulting in LONARDO and LADY GUINESS being place in restricted room for a short distance and tightened. Both CM Waddell and D Hain were advised to exercise greater care when riding out a finish and issued with a warning.

**STROLLING VAGABOND** (A Shin – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

**HINERANGI** (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a laceration to the left fore medial splint.

**D Hain** – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior the 100 metres.

# Race 3 KARAKA MAY SALE 2YO (1200 metres)

**SOCIALIGHTS** (S Wynne) – Slow to begin

**DERECHO** (S MacNab) - Slow to begin

**PERFORMANTE** (M Tanaka) - Raced three wide without cover throughout, had to be steadied over the concluding stages when CASSIUS CLAY shifted away from NOT USUAL JUNE (J Parkes) which shifted out. J Parkes was advised to exercise greater care.

**NOT USUAL JUNE** (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

**JUST FABULOUS** (R Myers) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had raced greenly throughout.

RIPNROLL (J Grob) - Was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight

**MIGHTY CONNOR** (L Hemi) - Held up early in the final straight and when shifting ground outwards in an attempt to obtain clear running made contact with GAMEBREAKER near the 300 metres.

**HIGHER POWER** (D Bradley) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running over the concluding stages.

Race 4

HAWKE'S BAY OWNERS ASSOCIATION 1200 (1200 metres)

VINO BLANCO (M Tanaka) - Slow to begin.

**QUANTUM** (B Morgenrood) - Slow to begin, steadied and hit the running rail when attempting a narrow run near the 100metres and went to the line untested.

MISS CONTESSA (S MacNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

PAKAPUNCH (A Shin) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**HUNDYAMONTH** (L Allpress) - Shifted out near the 600 metres dictating WINDSOR wider on the track.

**ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL** (L Hemi) – Clipped a heel and blundered near the 500 metres.

**R Myers** -Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she angled her mount ZAPPEUR out when not sufficiently clear of ONE PRIZE ONE GOAL which clipped a heel and blundered near the 500 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending Miss Myers licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 5<sup>th</sup> May up to and including12th May (5 days).

#### Race 5 HAWKE'S BAY BREEDERS ASSOCIATION 2100 (2100 metres)

**ANIMATOR** (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly losing ground, then lay in over the early stages making contact with the running rail near the 2000metres and again near the 1800metres, hung throughout and could not be ridden to advantage

**VOXER** (A Shin) - Blundered and became unbalanced near the 1700metres when racing free of interference. After questioning A Shin and inspecting the track, it was suspected the gelding may have placed its foot in a divot. Ground staff were alerted and several divots in the area concerned were replaced prior to Race 6.

**ROYAL RUBY** (Z Moki) - Shifted out to avoid heels when racing keenly near the 1500metres and then was obliged to race wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

KATIEM MARIE (R Myers) – Held up until the 200metres.

**KAIPAWE** (M Tanaka) – The tongue tie became displaced prior to the start and was unable to be reapplied. Connections were advised a further warning would be placed on the mare regarding barrier manners after being difficult to get to the start.

#### Race 6 PREFERMENT@ BRIGHTHILL FARM 1400 (1400 metres)

GO NICHOLAS (R Myers) - Slow to begin

TAURUS (L Hemi) – Blundered shortly after the start, raced three wide without cover throughout

**DEALS IN HEELS** (L Allpress) – Held up rounding the final bend and had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight

**BARCELO** (M Tanaka) - Held difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight. When questioned regarding performance the rider had no excuse.

## Race 7 MULCASTER BLOODSTOCK MILE (1600 metres)

PINCANTO – Late scratching @12.13pm on veterinary advice

JOHNNY LINCOLN (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

WHOSHOTMYMATE (D Bradley) – Made the first bend awkwardly running wide

**RASPBERRY BERET** (J Parkes) – Raced wide throughout. Bumped and forced wider passing the 350metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after racing wide throughout the filly was unable to finish off.

**LUBAYA** (C Johnson) - Shifted out passing the 350metres making contact with RASPBERRY BERET. C Johnson was advised to exercise care.

**WHAT A DIVA** (R Myers) Steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of JOHNNY LINCOLN near the 250metres.

**S Wynne** was issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift out when not sufficiently clear of WHAT A DIVA near the 250metres.

**GATA** (L Allpress) -Raced in restricted room approaching the 100metres

#### Race 8 LIVAMOL 1400 (1400 metres)

MANHATTAN FLAME (J Grob) - Slow to begin.

VINEVALE (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

**BEVAN STREET** (R Myers) – Over-raced in the early stages, bumped passing the 500metres, lay in then placed under pressure in the final straight.

**WORDOFMOUTH** (S McKay) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when being restrained, steadied to avoid the heels of SOROC which shifted in when not fully clear near the 800m. L Hemi was advised to exercise care. S McKay advised after over-racing the gelding had little left in the finish.

**CAPUCINE** (J Parkes) – Shifted out passing the 500metres making contact with BEVAN STREET. Bumped and forced wider approaching the 350metres by MONEY TRAIL which shifted out to obtain clear running.

**MONEY TRAIL** (L Allpress) - Shifted out approaching the 350metres making contact with CAPUCINE which was forced wider.

**J Grob** - Was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100metres.
