Rider **M Vance** advised Stewards on Tuesday, 1 May she would not be attending the meeting due to illness. M Vance is to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

Apprentice Rider J Grob did not attend the meeting due to personal reasons.

Race 7 - Inglis Sales Cambridge Breeders Stakes (Group 3) (1200 metres)

POP STAR PRINCESS (L Satherley) – Trainer F Cornege advised Stewards that following this race the filly underwent further veterinary examination upon return to his stable including a blood test which did not reveal any abnormality, adding it is his intention to add blinkers to the filly prior to racing next.

PAULOWNIA (M McNab) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the filly, adding that she would now be sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MURRAY WILCOX LTD (1600 metres)

FOREIGN INVESTMENT (M Cameron) – Late scratched at 12.16pm after becoming fractious in its barrier stall and rearing over. Connections were advised that FOREIGN INVESTMENT would now be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Co-Trainer A Forsman advised that FOREIGN INVESTMENT would not be persevered as a racing proposition from their stable.

INIGO MONTOYA (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

EASY WALKING (D Johnson) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SURREY (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SODA – (S Weatherley) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

RESURGENCE (M McNab) – Over raced when being steadied early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance M McNab advised that the colt had raced greenly when being settled further back in the field.

TREADSTONE (J Riddell) – Held up for a distance approaching the 350 metres.

Race 2 DON GRIFFITH TRENCHING LTD (1400 metres)

D Guy (CINNAMAN) – Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting the gelding to race without notified gear (Ear Covers).

KAURI COVE (S Rusof) - Shifted out leaving the barriers making contact with WHEAO for a distance.

WHEAO (V Colgan) - Contacted for a distance soon after leaving the barrier.

WRINKLE (T Abel) – Raced wide without cover.

NOT USUAL PRINCE (M Cameron) – Inconvenienced passing the 350 metres when improving onto the heels of WRINKLE which had shifted out when making the bend.

Race 3 SLATTERY CONTRACTING LTD (1400 metres)

CONCERTINO (S Collett) - Began awkwardly and shifted in crowding POPPIN' BUBBLES onto BLUE RATA ANNA. Pulled up by its rider after going amiss near the 900 metres. CONCERTINO was quickly attended to by the veterinarian and humanely euthanased after being found to have fractured its pelvis.

POPPIN' BUBBLES (R Smyth) – Crowded shortly after the start. Raced wide without cover.

BLUE RATA ANNA (M Tanaka) - Crowded shortly after the start.

CLADDAGH (M Coleman – Crowded shortly after the start, losing ground.

ELLE EYE ARE (J Riddell) – Crowded shortly after the start, losing ground. Held up for a distance rounding the final turn and shifted in to obtain clear running near the 350 metres and again briefly held up approaching the 200 metres before shifting in to obtain clear running.

MISS SEQUOIA (R Scott) - Began awkwardly.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL RACES (1400 metres)

LA FOI (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly.

TATTYBOGLER (M McNab) – Slow to begin (5L). Trainer K Fawcett was advised that a warning would be placed against the mares' barrier manners. Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

BLACK PEARL (A Collett) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

VASILIKI (S Collett) - Crowded leaving the barrier.

ELECTRIC AURA (M Coleman) – Crowded leaving the barrier. A post-race veterinary examination found the mare to have a slow recovery and to be coughing. A further endoscopic examination was found to be clear.

AVANT (D Johnson) – Dipped when making the course proper near the 1200 metres then over-raced for a distance.

INDIAN MAID (S Rusof) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

IMBLAZE (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 5 MATAMATA TRACTORS & MACHINERY (1200 metres)

GOBONIEGO (S Collett) – Was late scratched at 2.24pm after dislodging its rider in the preliminary and galloping some distance before being recaptured.

AKOYA PEARL (J Nason) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 900 metres.

SHOW 'N' GO (M McNab) – Crowded passing the 300 metres by MISTRESS which was dictated out by SAINT CROIX. Apprentice rider K Cowan was reprimanded by Stewards and advised to exercise greater care. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

COPPER XPRESS (R Smyth) - Inconvenienced 150 metres and forced wider on the track.

JUST KATE (L Satherley) – Lost the right front plate during the running.

Race 6 J SWAP STOCKFOODS LTD (1400 metres)

AMAZING BANKER (J Fawcett) – Underwent veterinary examination after dislodging its Rider in the preliminary and was cleared to start.

CLARIOS (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly, losing ground.

GARADOS (M McNab) – Began awkwardly, losing ground. Gave ground and was not persevered with from near the 400 metres with Rider M McNab unable to offer any excuses. A post-race veterinarian examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

PALAMEDES (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

SWEET NINETEEN (D Johnson) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

AVOCA WILLOW (D Danis) – The saddle shifted forward passing the 1000 metres with the filly not being persevered with for the remainder of the race.

CAVALLO ECCELLENTE (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance Rider S Weatherley advised that the colt had been making abnormal breathing noises.

M TANAKA (MIDNIGHT POETRY) – Rider M Tanaka was spoken to regarding the manner in which he used the whip.

Race 7 BNZ PARTNERS (2000 metres)

I SUGGEST (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin then was crowded shortly after having to be steadied.

PURE LORDE (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

QIAN GUA (O Bosson) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages and raced keenly in the middle stages.

ON PAROLE (J Nason) – Over-raced in the early stages having to steady away from heels.

RAISEDINASANDPIT (L Satherley) - Connections reported the mare had pulled up slightly lame with a post-race veterinary examination failing to find any obvious abnormalities.

Race 8 PGG WRIGHTSON LTD (2000 metres)

ACRE (S Rusof) – Began awkwardly and shifted out with PAVLICHENKO becoming awkwardly place on that runners heels having to be steadied.

PAVLICHENKO (S McKay) – Hampered leaving the barriers having to be steadied.

PRINCE JABEEL (L Innes) – Slow to begin.

VAN BLANC (S Collett) – Began awkwardly and was crowded shortly after.

PIERIAN SPRING (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

UNACCEPTABLE (M Tanaka) – Crowded and hampered approaching the 400 metres between MISTER GERONIMO (S Weatherley) which was improving to that runners outside and HATRICK BOYS (M Coleman) which became unbalanced when making contact. Footage of the incident was inconclusive with S Weatherley and M Coleman being advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

GO GO GOAL (J Nason) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the mouth which was found to be from an abrasion
