RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 Porritt Sand Hurdle (2800 metres)

HESALLJAZZ (J Seivwright) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Hit the fence near the 350 metres. Misjudged the final fence.

YARDSTICK (E Farr) - Misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres.

RAAJ (M Roustoby) – Misjudged the fence near the 1100 metres. Hit the fence near the 1000 metres.

LETMEBY (D Turner) – Jumped indifferently throughout.

NO CHANGE (A Kuru) – Misjudged the final fence.

Race 2 Jumps Day 19/05 Packs Available Hurdle (2800 metres)

I'M BRONSON (H McNeill) – Misjudged the first fence.

THE OTHER HALF (J Seivwright) – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 350 metres. Put in a poor jump at the final fence.

JUSTNAMETHEPRICE (L Douglas) – Raced keenly when being restrained when the pace steadied near the 1650 metres.

JOEY JONZ (M Roustoby) – Raced keenly when being restrained when the pace steadied near the 1650 metres.

PERRY MASON (A Kuru) - Hit the fence near the 900 metres. Ran down the second to last fence. Hit the last fence.

NEK MINNIT (J Nason) – Raced wide for the majority of the race. Misjudged the second to last fence and blundered on landing dislodging its rider who was not injured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found blood present in the nasal area as a result of a laceration to the left nostril. Lost off fore plate during the running.

Race 3 Team Wealleans 1200

MIGHTY SOLOMON (A Shin) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide for the majority of the race.

MAHOLO (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly then was crowded shortly after having to be steadied.

INDECISION (M McNab) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

STRADIVARIUS (L Hemi) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

SELFIE (O Bosson) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Briefly steadied passing the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ROSA CAROLINA (D Johnson) which shifted out under pressure when not fully clear. D Johnson was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. Inconvenienced over concluding stages when becoming awkwardly placed inside heels.

A Shin (MIGHTY SOLOMON) – Reprimanded by Stewards and issued with a warning for his use of the whip on a horse that was out of contention.

Race 4 Ken & Roger Browne Memorial Steeplechase (3900 metres)

K Duncan - Fined \$50.00 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after SHAMAL was presented to race without notified gear (blinkers).

BEVERLEY BECK (M Roustoby) – Slow to begin. Misjudged the 12th fence. Misjudged the 14th fence dislodging rider M Roustoby who lost consciousness for a period and was transported to hospital for further assessment. M Roustoby is now required to obtain a medical certificate prior to riding again.

THENAMESBOND (J Seivwright) – Misjudged the 7th fence dislodging rider J Seivwright who was uninjured. A post-race veterinary examination found no significant abnormalities other than a superficial cut to the right front heel

NOAH JON (G Walsh) – Misjudged the 7th fence and fell dislodging rider G Walsh who was uninjured. A post-race veterinary examination could find no significant abnormalities other than minor nasal abrasions.

NGATIRA GOLD (I Lupton) – Shifted out when jumping the 11th fence making heavy contact with BEVERLEY BECK. Misjudged the 12th fence.

ISTIMAGIC (C Studd) – Misjudged the 14th fence.

JUSTA CHARLIE (W Gordon) – Contacted passing the 450 metres and briefly unbalanced by SHAMAL which had made the junction awkwardly

SHAMAL (H McNeill) – Made the junction passing the 450 metres awkwardly.

FAIR SCRIPT (E Farr) - Misjudged the last fence and knuckled on landing losing momentum.

H McNeill (SHAMAL) - Was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

Race 5 Double R 2100

DUBAI SHUFFLE (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

ZANYETTA (M Coleman) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages when awkwardly placed on heels. Held up early in the final straight.

PRINCE MAMBO (S Spratt) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1000 metres.

STACEY ANN (D Hain) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.

VICTORY DRIVE (L Satherley) – Held up early rounding the final turn.

CHERRY BAY (S Rusof) — Held up in the final straight until passing the 300 metres and then inconvenienced approaching the 175 metres by FRANCIS DRAKE (R Elliot) which shifted in to obtain clear running. Apprentice Rider R Elliot was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

FRANCIS DRAKE (R Elliot) – Shifted in to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

THE SHACKLER (J Fawcett) – Inconvenienced passing the 175 metres when weakening.

Race 6 Waikato Equine Veterinary Centre 2YO Stakes (1100 metres)

CAVALLO VELOCE (S McKay) – Crowded leaving the barriers and then became awkwardly placed on heels for a distance. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Lost the right front plate.

VAN IRVING (M McNab) - Crowded leaving the barriers. Crowded approaching 1000 metres and steadied.

SANTA CATARINA (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly making contact.

WHAT A SMASHER (T Allan) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KAILANI SUNSET which steadied passing the 800 metres. Held up approaching the 200 metres when attempting a marginal run to the inside of KAILANI SUNSET which shifted in slightly with WHAT A SMASHER then shifting out to improve inconveniencing SHIPSHAPE.

SHIPSHAPE (S Spratt) – Steadied 700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels. Inconvenienced 150 metres.

QIJI EXPRESS (M Coleman) – Raced in restricted room passing the 700 metres when shifting out to avoid the heels of SHIPSHAPE which was steadying. Could not obtain clear running early in the final straight and then was inconvenienced when bumped passing the 200 metres by VAN IRVING (M McNab) which shifted in. M McNab was advised to exercise extra care in similar circumstances.

Race 7 True Colours Mid-Winter Luncheon 7th July 1200

SOCIALLY EXCITED (J Riddell) – Crowded shortly after the start.

TOITOI (S Collett) – Crowded shortly after the start. Commenced to race ungenerously approaching the 900 metres becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of SIMPLY OPTIMISTIC which also commenced to over-race with TOITOI being further steadied and shifted back onto SUN GENES which was hampered when making the bend.

ALVINS DREAM (R Elliot) – Crowded shortly after the start.

SUN GENES (O Bosson) – Raced ungenerously early stages then hampered when making the bend at the 900 metres. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running being held up approaching the 200 metres and again held up inside the final 100 metres.

O'GUY (M McNab) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. Held up entering the final straight and shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres inconveniencing the weakening TOITOI.

DANGEROUS PONY (J Nason) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

DIRECT CAPITAL (A Calder) - Raced wide without cover.

CONJURING (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover.

SIMPLY OPTIMISTIC (G Cooksley) – Held up rounding final turn. Crowded and checked near the 250 metres.

D Danis (SHORT FUSE) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed SHORT FUSE to shift out passing the 250 metres when insufficiently clear of FOREVER CLEVER which was dictated into the line of SIMPLY OPTIMISTIC which was checked with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 12 May 2018 up to and including racing on Sunday 20 May, 6 national days.

SHORT FUSE (D Danis) – Shifted out to obtain clear running at the 250 metres crowding FOREVER CLEVER onto SIMPLY OPTIMISTIC which was checked with SIMPLY OPTIMISTIC then shifting out forcing DIRECT CAPITAL out into the line of TELLYAWHAT which was also checked.

TELLYAWHAT (D Turner) – Held up early in the final straight then crowded and checked passing the 250 metres before continuing to have difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.

WORDOFMOUTH (S McKay) – Lost the right hind plate.

Race 8 BCD Group 1600

TUSCAN WHISTLER (J Grob) - Began awkwardly. Commenced to over-race in the early stages and then shifted out to race without cover for the remainder of the race. When questioned regarding the riding tactics adopted Apprentice Jockey J Grob advised that he had intended to ride the gelding quietly in the early stages and obtain cover as the horse had a tendency to race keenly and when the pace slackened in the middle stages he advised that TUSCAN WHISTLER had travelled very keenly.

RUSTY IN MELBOURNE (L Hemi) – Slow to begin.

AUTUMN WIND (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages. Raced wide for the majority of the race. Hampered when in restricted room near the 450 metres.

ANICETA (M McNab) – Over-raced for a distance approaching the 1200 metres.

GEORGEGETTHEFIFTH (T Allan) - Over-raced for a distance approaching the 1200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SHOWTENAIRE which was steadied to avoid the heels of NEESON (L Innes) which shifted in when not fully clear. L Innes was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

STYLISH APPLAUSE (V Colgan) – Placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres.

Race 9 NZI 1600

MY PRIDE AND JOY (G Cooksley) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SKYWEKA (J Nason) – Slow to begin.

PYTHAGORAS (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

PIAZZETTA (A Calder) - Slow to begin.

LUCKY SWEEP (S Sweep) - Over-raced in the early stages.

LADDIE OF OAKVIEW (M Coleman) – Over-raced in the early stages.

STAND FIRM (S Collett) - Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

INCANTESIMO (M McNab) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.
