RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MID WINTER CHRISTMAS JUNE 23 PREMIER (1400m)

KHORABELLA - C Johnson replaced R Cuneen who was unable to make the weight, being fined \$100 under the minor infringement schedule. Inconvenienced 500 metres.

ZAKYNTHOS (S Wynne) - Passed fit to run after undergoing a pre race veterinary inspection due to having made contact with a gate leaving the enclosure, raced ungenerously when being steadied in the middle stages and shifted outwards across heels near the 500 metres inconveniencing KHORABELLA.

OUR TEDDY BOY (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly and got back.

RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT (K Cowan) - Slow to begin, made contact with the running rail passing the 1000 metres

CLASSIC WARRIOR (BB Hong) - Commenced to over race shortly after the start, shifted outwards across heels approaching the 1000 metres then racing wide without cover being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader passing the 800 metres

NOWHERE MAN (S Weatherley) - Made contact with the running rail passing the 900 metres.

BB Hong (CLASSIC WARRIOR) - Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

K Mudhoo (MILK IT) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO PREMIER (2000m)

STANDREWS MASONIC - L Allpress replaced D Bradley due to transport difficulties.

THE MAN (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

SATIN GURU (J Lowry) - Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

SHANZINO (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early and middle stages, held up early in the final straight and continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race.

FRIDAY KNIGHT (R Beeharry) - Became awkwardly placed near the heels of SHANZINO for some distance in the back straight before striking a heel of that runner and blundering near the 1000 metres. Apprentice R Beeharry was advised he must show far greater judgement in his riding in future.

BULLITT (L Callaway) - Steadied when racing in restricted room rounding the first bend near the 1800 metres, improved wide from the 800 metres.

SO BRAZEN (S Weatherley) - Held up early in the run home before again being held up near the 200 metres and only gaining clear running approaching the 100 metres.

SHE'S PAYBACK (K Williams) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

Race 3 KARAKA MAY SALE PREMIER (1600m)

STOKERS ROCK (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly before being further hampered losing ground when runners to either side shifted ground shortly after the start, raced wide without cover.

SHAKTI (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

QUAINTRELLE (BB Hong) - Slow to begin.

EUPHORIA (R Myers) - Got its head up and raced ungenerously when over racing in the early to middle stages.

GLOSS (P Shaikh) - Steadied to avoid the heels of RESIDENTIAL (G Jogoo) which shifted inwards passing the 1500 metres. G Jogoo was advised to exercise greater care.

S Wynne (JOBY) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards when not fully clear of FIVE KINGS which had to be steadied approaching the 1400 metres.

FIVE KINGS (M Tanaka) - Crowded having to be steadied approaching the 1400 metres.

EL BEE DARCI (K Williams) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained to avoid heels near the 1000 metres.

TOMM JONES (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

RESIDENTIAL - Rider G Jogoo reported that the mare had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.

Race 4 ANGUS MEATS PREMIER (1200m)

K & P Hughes - Issued with a warning after presenting PAT IN BRACKETS with incorrect gear.

PAT IN BRACKETS (L Callaway) - Slow to begin, steadied over the final 75 metres.

SMOKE HOUSE BAY (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin.

SILVERMIST (K Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering SECRET STASH, crowded and checked near the 100 metres.

SECRET STASH (K Cowan) - Hampered at the start.

CZARISTA (L Allpress) - Raced wide without cover.

C Barnes (DREAMING EASY) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SILVERMIST which was checked and forced inwards resulting in BLACK LABEL also being checked near the 100 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended C Barnes' licence to ride at race meetings for 6 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 11 May up to and including 19 May.

BLACK LABEL (K Williams) - Crowded and checked near the 100 metres.

Race 5 BERKLEY STUD CHAMPAGNE STAKES (1200m)

PICK ME UP IN RIO - K Williams replaced D Bradley due to transport difficulties.

IWONDERWAI (J Morris) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground

DEVIOUS (T Moseley) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

NORMA JEAN (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

PICK ME UP IN RIO (K Williams) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

THUNDER BAY (S Weatherley) - Held up passing the 600 metres before obtaining clear running near the 350 metres.

XPRESSMYMIND (R Cuneen) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after over racing early the filly had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure.

Race 6 DAVID EMERSON ACCOUNTANT & BUSINESS CONSULTANT PREMIER (1200m)

WILLIAM WALLACE (R Myers) - Slow to begin.

KOXINGA (K Cowan) - Slow to begin, lay in away from WILLIAM WALLACE early in the final straight then being held up for a short distance near the 250 metres.

BARABAS (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly

WIZE ACT (L Allpress) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight and was then held up over the final 200 metres being unable to be fully tested by its rider.

UPPERHAND (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been unable to quicken in today's holding track conditions.

P Shaikh (LUCKY EDIE) - Spoken to regarding his whip action in the final straight.

Race 7 NZI GREAT AUTUMN HANDICAP (2500m)

R Mauger - Issued with a warning after presenting LARRIKIN with incorrect gear.

J Gordon - Issued with a warning after presenting THE GORDONIAN with incorrect gear.

WHO DARES WINS (S Wynne) - Over raced and got its head up in the early stages.

WHAT A DEEZA (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

THE GORDONIAN (K Mudhoo) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse other than the gelding's big weight, **a** post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 8 DAPHNE BANNAN MEMORIAL GREAT EASTER STAKES (1400m)

KINAGAT (S Wynne) - Slow away, rider reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action with a post race veterinary inspection finding KINAGAT to be lame in the right foreleg with a suspected over reach injury to the right front heel bulb. A veterinary certificate of fitness is now required prior to KINAGAT racing next.

P Shaikh (MORSE CODE) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear crowding KOLONEL KEV inwards onto JOHNNY JONES which had to be steadied.

JOHNNY JONES (R Hannam) - Steadied when crowded shortly after the start getting its head up.

KOLONEL KEV (M Tanaka) - Crowded shortly after the start.

KING PIN (T Comignaghi) - Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of IRISH EXCUSE passing the 1000 metres, rider dropped her whip passing the 175 metres.

SHAARA (G Jogoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MORSE CODE (P Shaikh) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SON OF MAHER (S Weatherley) - Rider reported that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 9 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE PREMIER (1600m)

RED RIVER ROCK (R Cuneen) - Slow to begin, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

YOURLIPS AR MOVIN (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

GIPSYROCKER (M Tanaka) - Slow to begin.

RUBY MARIE (T Moseley) - Over raced in the early stages to middle stages.

DARK PRINCESS (L Allpress) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

METASEQUOIA (R Beeharry) - Raced wide without cover throughout running very wide rounding the final turn.

REBEL ROSE (S Weatherley) - Hampered near the 1100 metres when TUILANA was forced outwards by I'LLAV BUBBLES which shifted outwards to avoid the heels of METASEQUOIA which was being steadied near the 1100 metres.

DARCI INN (K Williams) - Eased down by its rider over the final 250 metres with the bit having gone through the gelding's mouth.
