RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Vilagrad Winery 1150
MANRICO (K Cowan) – Apprentice K Cowan was permitted as the replacement rider as there no suitable senior rider available to replace T Thornton who was late to arrive on course due to a transport delay. Raced greenly going off stride when placed in restricted room near the 800 metres going back onto JAKAMA KRYSTAL with LUCKY STRIKE also being hampered, ducked outwards abruptly near the 650 metres.	

RIPNROLL (D Johnson) – Slow away.	
LUCKY STRIKE (M Coleman) – Jumped away awkwardly, raced ungenerously early stages, hampered 800 metres, made the bend near the 600 metres awkwardly running wide.	
JAKAMA KRYSTAL (L Satherley) – Hampered 800 metres, blundered when again hampered near the 650 metres by MANRICO which ducked outwards when racing greenly.	
IF WE MEET AGAIN (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
Race 2	Fiber Fresh Feeds 2000
HEAVENLY GOLD (A Jones) – Slow away, raced keenly through the middle stages.	
DELEGATE (K Cowan) – Held up rounding the final turn until near the 250 metres.	
BATTLE ROYAL (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality with trainer V Prendergast advising that the gelding would now be spelled.	
Race 3	Waipa Towing 2000
MEMPHIS STAR (A Jones) – Raced wide without cover until approaching the 1000 metres.	
CHELSEA STREET (D Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the middle stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.	
MISS SEQUOIA (R Scott) – Shifted inwards abruptly to avoid the heels of the weakening VIAAGO near the 600 metres making firm contact with ROCKING GOOD TIME which became unbalanced when making contact with the running rail.	
ROCKING GOOD TIME (S Rusof) – Unbalanced when bumped making contact with the running rail near the 600 metres.	
Race 4	Timmo's ITM, Te Awamutu 1150
SUPER BULLET (S Collett) - Slow away.	
SWOON (C Lammas) – Slow away.	
MALAMBO (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.	
STOLE THE SHOW (J Fawcett) – Steadied when crowded between STAND TALL (A Goindasamy) which shifted outwards and DIDI BAY which shifted inwards slightly near the 1000 metres. In this incident both STAND TALL and STOLE THE SHOW became unbalanced when making contact. Apprentice Goindasamy was advised to exercise greater care.	
DIDI BAY (S Spratt) – Steadied to avoid the heels of LUCKY ESCAPE (S Rusof) which shifted inwards when not fully clear near the 650 metres, S Rusof was advised to exercise greater care. Held up for a distance passing the 400 metres.	
Race 5	Chipperfield All Round Equine Education 1400
MARIOTA (S McKay) – Crowded start when OWEN PATRICK began awkwardly shifting outwards.	

OWEN PATRICK (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly, made contact with SIR LINWOOD when attempting to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been disappointing, but in his opinion would be better suited racing on a roomier track.

Race 6	Waipa Home Of Champions 1400

S Rusof – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount SEIRIOS to shift inwards shortly after the start when not sufficiently clear crowding COSSACK WARRIOR onto SIENNA GRACE. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Rusof's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 12 May until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 24 May, 7 national riding days.

COSSACK WARRIOR (J Riddell) – Crowded start. Shifted out in an attempt to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres making contact with SEIRIOS then was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

SIENNA GRACE (D Johnson) – Crowded start.

MIZZELLI (S Weatherley) - Crowded shortly after the start when runners to either side shifted ground.

SHOW 'N' GO (S McKay) - Began awkwardly and shifted outwards forcing TUNZAGUTZ outwards onto MISTER PINNS which raced in restricted room for a distance.

MISTER PINNS (R Elliot) - Raced in restricted room for a distance shortly after the start. Checked when crowded 1150 metres.

L Satherley – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount SECRET DREAMS to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SEIRIOS which was forced inwards crowding MISTER PINNS which was checked near the 1150 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension of her licence from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 12 May until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 20 May, 5 national riding days.

SEIRIOS (S Rusof) – Hampered 1150 metres.

HENLEY ROAD (R Norvall) – Crowded shortly after the start.

VERRY FLASH (R Smyth) – Slow to begin.

BITTERSWEET BABE (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

MCCARTNEY (R Elliot) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions.

VAINGLORY (C Lammas) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

BABOONSKI (C Dell) – Raced wide without cover.

BARRY'S BOYO (D Hain) – Made contact with the running rail when improving into a marginal run passing the 200 metres.

CODECRACKER (M Coleman) – Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious undergoing a veterinary inspection being passed fit to run.

INVERNESS (T Newman) – Slow away.

GOBONIEGO (S Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly.

MADAM ACE (R Elliot) – Checked when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of TOKOMUTU MISTRESS (L Satherley) which shifted inwards to avoid the heels of IFFIDA going into the bend near the 800 metres. L Satherley was advised to exercise greater.

LADY DE WINTER (S Weatherley) – Rider reported had made abnormal noises once placed under pressure, a post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality with the trainer advising would be subject to further tests on return to its stable.

Race 9

Paper Plus, Te Awamutu 1150

P & J Brosnan – Issued a minor infringement notice and fined \$50 for presenting BEWITCHED to race with incorrect gear.

REPEAT (D Johnson) – Slow to begin.

BEWITCHED (L Satherley) – Jumped away awkwardly, raced in restricted room for a distance shortly after the start to the inside of RICKY BAKER (J Fawcett) which shifted inwards slightly with some contributing outwards movement from GUMBOOTS. J Fawcett was advised to exercise care. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

SENASSY (T Abel) – Jumped away awkwardly then further hampered when crowded losing ground.
