RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ASHBURTON RACING CLUB LIFE MEMBERS MAIDEN 1400

HADIYA (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly unbalancing its rider, became awkwardly placed inside heels near the 900 metres having to be continually restrained for some distance .

AL BE CIVICS (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly.

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (J Morris) - Began awkwardly.

FLASH GORDON (S Wynne) – When spoken to regarding the performance of this favoured runner the rider advised that the wide draw proved detrimental to its chances.

Race 2 SIMS BAKERY MAIDEN 1400

ADVENT (D Bradley) - Began awkwardly, shifted ground inwards near the 220 metres.

NAKURU (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

MISS DIORELLA (J Morris) – Raced keenly in the early stages, steadied in the shadows of the post when in restricted room.

GALISINI (K Williams) - Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

ATAAHUADREAMSRFREE (S Wynne) - Raced ungenerously for some distance in the middle stages.

JONTYS ACE (S McKay) – Tended to lay inwards early in the home straight and had to be straightened.

WHAT A DREAM (G Jogoo) – Steadied near the 220 metres when in restricted room to the inside of ADVENT (D Bradley).

D Bradley (ADVENT) was warned for shifting ground near the 220 metres.

IVAN KANE (B Murray) - Shifted out passing the 200 metres and made contact with RIDING HIGH.

RIDING HIGH (C Barnes) – Contacted passing the 200 metres.

SKEDADDLE SKEDOO (L Callaway) – Shifted ground inwards under pressure over the concluding stages. L Callaway was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Rider dropped his whip in the shadows of the post.

Race 3 PHAT DUCK BREW BAR AND KITCHEN MAIDEN 1200

EL CAMPEADOR (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly.

VOUCH (R Cuneen) – Began awkwardly.

REDFORD (G Jogoo) – Crowded shortly after jumping away.

DREAM START (K Williams) – Got its head up shortly after the start when restrained.

TEARS IN HEAVEN (D Bradley) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start. Raced in tight quarters when weakening passing the 200 metres. Rider reported the filly to be heavily fatigued on pulling up. A post race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

SHARP 'N' SILVER (T Moseley) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

LET HER RIP RILEY (S Collett) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

DON'T SHUFFLE ME (R Beeharry) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 4 HANLEY FORMULA AUTUMN SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER (1200m)

BRIDGET TOWN (R Beeharry) - Began awkwardly.

TIEBREAKER (R Cuneen) – Restrained leaving the barriers, lay out rounding the final bend becoming awkwardly placed inside heels.

MR CONDUCTOR (S Collett) – Raced in restricted room in the early stages.

MAL D'MOUR (L Callaway) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.

MADAM BENTLEY (B Murray) – Made the final bend awkwardly laying outwards.

BORN A ROYAL (S Wynne) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

B Murray MADAM BENTLEY admitted a breach of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at race meetings for 10 national days effective from the conclusion of racing on 18 May up to and including 1 June inclusive.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1600m)

KERRYTOWNCHARLOTTE (R Beeharry) – Slow to begin.

FIVEWAYEIGHT (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly and steadied.

SMART GARDEN (S Collett) – Began awkwardly, raced wide from the 800 metres.

FIENDISH (D Bradley) – Raced wide in the early stages.

DYLANS PRIDE (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied away from the heels of MOWENNA near the 1300 metres.

PATRICIA ROSE (L Callaway) – Had to steady approaching the 900 metres when awkwardly placed, held up for a short distance passing the 500 metres

MONTSERRAT (J Lowry) – Raced keenly in the middle stages, lay outwards passing the 300 metres and had to be straightened, continued to lay inwards throughout the final straight.

READY TO ROCK (J Laking) - Inconvenienced near the 300 metres when hampered by MONTSERRAT.

Race 6 MATT SMITH CONSTRUCTION RATING 75 1600

SEBRING DRAGON (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly.

WHY ME (S Weatherley) – Steadied when in restricted room passing the 1500 metres and continued to over race for some distance shifting outwards hampering NEWS FLASH, made contact with AMUN RA near the 200 metres.

JOBY (R Firdhaus) – Shifted inwards near the 1500 metres with BARCLAY CREEK shifting inwards and away, raced wide throughout.

NEWS FLASH (BB Hong) – Hampered 1400 metres.

WHISPERING (G Jogoo) – Improved up onto heels near the 1400 metres and was steadied for some distance when over racing, held up on entering home straight until inside the 200 metres.

AMUN RA (L Callaway) – Denied a marginal run near the 250 metres, having to steady, obtaining clear running near the 200 metres.

SHE'S A RIPPER (B Murray) - Crowded over the concluding stages when LONGFORD shifted in under pressure.

BARCLAY CREEK (C Barnes) – Shifted inwards near the 1450 metres and hampered WHY ME.

C Barnes (BARCLAY CREEK) was warned for shifting ground near the 1450 metres.

Race 7 SUPREME EQUINE FEEDS RATING 65 1400

CABERNET (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly.

FUGAWI (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly, crowded and unbalanced near the 800 metres.

JOLT (T Jonker) - Knuckled leaving the barrier.

ROSAEFLORA (S Collett) – Restrained leaving the barriers.

MOSSOMAK (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

DISRUPTION (L Callaway) – Over raced when being restrained in the early stages, crowded near the 800 metres.

AHYUM (S Wynne) – Raced keenly in the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 800 metres and shifting out and crowding DISRUPTION and FUGAWI which became unbalanced.

STITCH (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

PAT IN BRACKETS (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly for some distance when awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres.

DIORISSIMO (D Bradley) – Denied a run passing the 350 metres and had to shift inwards to obtain clear running.

STROWAN (R Firdhaus) – Shifted outwards under pressure in the final straight.

Race 8 NUFARM – KAISO INSECTICIDE MAIDEN 2100

BRAT PACK (P Shaikh) – Slow to begin.

PAINTED ANGEL (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly, heavily restrained near the 200 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of MAVRICK which shifted away from COUP DREAMWOOD.

PATROMIA (J Lowry) – Began awkwardly.

PRODUCER (S Wynne) – Knuckled leaving the barrier, steadied passing the 1700 metres when awkwardly placed inside heels, improved forward from the 1400 metres.

TATUM (S Collett) – Raced wide in the early stages.

WAR HERO (G Jogoo) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early and middle stages.

COUP DREAMWOOD (S Weatherley) – Denied clear running early in the home straight shifting inwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running, bumped near the 75 metres.

KEYBOARD WARRIOR (T Moseley) – Bumped with COUP DREAMWOOD near the 75 metres.

Race 9 PALAMOUNTAINS ANIMAL NUTRITION RATING 65 2100

SLAMMER (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

YOURLIPS AR MOVIN (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin then hampered losing ground.

SMILING ASSASSIN (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly, became awkwardly placed on heels when making the bend awkwardly near the 1700 metres and then raced ungenerously for a distance.

REBEL ROSE (J Morris) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

HARDCASE (D Bradley) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.

HILARIOUS (C Barnes) – Raced keenly in the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 1000 metres.

SOUTHERN AURORA (T Jonker) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SOUTHERN DANCER (G Jogoo) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages, awkwardly placed and steadied off heels passing the 500 metres, shifted ground outwards abruptly passing the 250 metres when looking for clear running.
