RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200M
LUVLUCY (M Tanaka) – Tightened at the start settling back. Dictated inwards shortly after the start by GAMEBREAKER. Held up passing the 800 metres having to be restrained off heels then continued to be held up for some distance before being angled back inwards to improve approaching the 500 metres.	
LONDON EXPRESS (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly making contact with LUVLUCY. Dictated inwards shortly after the start by GAMEBREAKER. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in its mouth, subsequent veterinary inspection revealed superficial cuts.	
WICKLOW (C Dell) – Jumped inwards at the start bumping STERLING MOSS, then lay inwards for a short distance.	

STERLING MOSS (D Bradley) – Bumped at the start.

TUTTA LA CLASS (L Allpress) – Jumped inwards at the start contacting SAGUNTO.

GAMEBREAKER (T Johnson) – Tightened then raced greenly for a distance shortly after the start when WICKLOW lay inwards dictating LUVLUCY and LONDON EXPRESS losing significant ground.

GLIDE QUEEN (M Hills) – Lay outwards rounding the turn. Tightened near the 350 metres when TUTTA LA CLASSE shifted inwards when not the required distance clear. Rider L Allpress was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

Race 2	HIREPOOL MAIDEN 1200M

ZEEFA ZED (J Parkes) – Slow away. Raced up on to heels making the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres.

QUAFF (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

CAPBLAMO (Z Moki) – Awkwardly away settling back.

KALIPER (D Bradley) – Raced keenly in the early stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. When questioned into performance D Bradley advised the filly was comfortable in the going but raced keenly and would improve with the run.

SURE HE CAN (S McKay) – Briefly held up near the 500 metres.

Race 3	THE KIWI BUTCHER 1200

ROYAL EMPRESS (J Parkes) – Held up approaching the 200 metres and was then angled outwards when not the required distance clear of SIMPLY IMPECCABLE which was hampered. J Parkes was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

FASHION SENSE (K Cowan) – Tightened when SIMPLY IMPECCABLE jumped outwards at the start.

SIMPLY IMPECCABLE (R Scott) – Jumped outwards at the start. Hampered near 200 metres.

FIELD OF FIRE (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

ENJOY THE RIDE (K McCulloch) – Tightened having to be restrained near the 900 metres when TURNCOAT lay inwards when being restrained off the heels of MORWEKA.

TURNCOAT (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Restrained off heels near the 900 metres.

Race 4	EVENTS TARANAKI MDN 1600M

OLD COUNTESS (T Miles) – Awkwardly away settling back.

GRINNER (W Pinn) – Tightened at start. Held up passing the 200 metres having to be restrained then angled inwards to improve inside the final 100 metres.

CALVADOS (Z Moki) – Raced ungenerously for a short distance near the 1200 metres getting its head in the air. Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

OUR CHARLI'S ANGEL (A Shin) – Had to be restrained when improving into a marginal run between the tiring TAAZMAN and ACACIA who was also briefly restrained passing the 500 metres. Apprentice A Shin was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Master N Harris.

ACACIA (D Bradley) – Briefly restrained passing the 500 metres.

Race 5	DENIS WHEELER EARTHMOVING 1600M
<p>ALI BABA (S McKay) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start after making contact with a fence leaving the enclosure.</p> <p>PRINCESS DILLON (L Allpress) – Tightened shortly after the start.</p> <p>FORTIUS (M Hills) – Raced keenly making the bend awkwardly getting its head in the air approaching the 1200 metres then continued to race ungenerously for a distance.</p> <p>BIG BEN – When questioned into the run of BIG BEN apprentice jockey Z Moki had no excuse.</p>	
Race 6	BNT GROUP OPEN HCP 1200M
<p>SALAMANCA (Z Moki) – Made contact with a fence leaving the enclosure, dislodging the rider then galloped a short distance before being recaptured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start.</p> <p>BALLYBAY (A Shin) – Bumped with KITAYA on a number of occasions and dictated inwards shortly after the start briefly unbalancing the rider approaching the 1000 metres inconveniencing TAURUS which was restrained. Apprentice R Scott was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) and advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>TAURUS (J Parkes) – Restrained shortly after the start.</p> <p>KITAYA (R Scott) – Bumped on a number of occasions by BALLYBAY shortly after the start.</p>	
Race 7	ENERGY CITY FORD OPEN 1800M
<p>EFFECTAV (M Tanaka) – Blundered near the 700 metres, rider advised that the mare had not handled the prevailing track conditions.</p> <p>ASSIGN (J Parkes) – Raced wide throughout. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding did not appreciate today's heavy 11 track conditions.</p> <p>DANZA LAD (T Allan) – Raced up on to heels having to be restrained near the 1000 metres.</p>	
Race 8	SETON PARK 1800M
<p>BATTLE KAT (K McCulloch) – Dictated inwards shortly after the start. Shifted in abruptly near the 250 metres and again approaching the 100 metres.</p> <p>WAFER (M Hills) – Dictated inwards shortly after the start.</p> <p>DUELLICIOUS – (D Bradley) Dictated inwards shortly after the start.</p> <p>ABACUS (J Parkes) – When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding did not appreciate today's heavy track conditions.</p> <p>ANIMATOR (T Johnson) – Lay inwards shortly after the start dictating DUELLICIOUS inwards on to BATTLEKAT and WAFER. Rider T Johnson was advised to exercise greater care. Then continued to lay inwards through the middle stages making contact with the running rail early in the home straight..</p> <p>BAD BOY BROWN (C O'Beirne) – Began awkwardly settling back.</p> <p>NEWSTEAD (W Pinn) – Hung outwards throughout.</p> <p>CALL ME IRISH (K Cowan) – When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding failed to handle today's heavy</p>	

track conditions.

REGAL WINKS (L Allpress) – Contacted and tightened when BATTLE KAT shifted inwards abruptly under pressure prior to being straightened near the 250 metres and again approaching the 100 metres having to be restrained when BATTLE KAT again shifted inwards abruptly.
