Race 1	MID WINTER CHRISTMAS RACES 23 JUNE MAIDEN (1000m)
JAMIE (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runner. MATHIEU (AUS) (P Shaikh) - Shifted in at the start crowding inside runner. SHOW CLOUD (R Mudhoo) - Crowded between runners and lost ground at the start. OUR BELLE AMIE (BB Hong) - Bounded at the start and lost ground. EMILY MARGARET (J Fawcett) - Crowded at the start.	

TEE CEE COUP (L Allpress) – Crowded at the start losing ground.	
Race 2	JOIN THE CLUB MEMBERSHIP AVAILABLE NOW RATING 65 (1200m)
<p>LUCKY EDIE (P Shaikh) - Shifted in at the start crowding inside runners. Raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>O'KIWI (J Bassett) - Bounded at the start. Shifted wider on the track passing the 300 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>SARCONIC MISS (AUS) (S Weatherley) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>DON'T BE CHEEKY (BB Hong) - Crowded at the start.</p> <p>SUGGESTIVE LOOX (K Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground.</p> <p>FLY TO THE SKY (J Lowry) - Raced keenly early. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised that the gelding had battled in today's heavy track conditions.</p> <p>DISRUPTION (K Cowan) - Held up for several strides passing the 400 metres having to change ground inwards to find clear racing room.</p> <p>ULTRA CHIC (S Collett) - Finished a distant last. Stewards ordered a post-race Veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be suffering respiratory distress with the connections advised a Veterinary clearance to be provided before racing next.</p>	
Race 3	SPEIGHT'S MID ALE OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)
<p>DYNAMIC (S Weatherley) - Crowded and checked passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>LUKE (K Kwo) - Rider reported that the gelding had lay inwards throughout the run.</p> <p>L Allpress (WIZE ACT) admitted a breach of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift out passing the 200 metres when not sufficiently clear of DYNAMIC which was checked. After hearing from Mrs Allpress and the Stewards the JCA suspended her licence to ride from the 21st up to and including 30th May (6 days).</p>	
Race 4	MEMBERS REWARDS AT RICCARTON PARK MAIDEN (1600m)
<p>The start of the event was delayed due to several runners proving difficult to load.</p> <p>GALISINI (K Williams) - Was fractious in its stall just prior to the jump and was slow to begin as a result.</p> <p>SMART GARDEN (AUS) (T Comignaghi) - Bounded at the start and lost ground. Held up in the run home and had to shift ground outwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p>LET HER RIP RILEY (J Fawcett) - Heavily contacted at the start unbalancing the rider for a short distance. Raced keenly in the early stages and had to be restrained away from heels passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>DYLAN'S PRIDE (AUS) (B Murray) - Placed in restricted room passing the 500 metres when LET HER RIP RILEY (J Fawcett) shifted out for clear racing room. J Fawcett was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>SKEDADDLE SKEDOO (L Callaway) - Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>WHISKEY IN THE JAR (J Morris) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance trainer S Hewitt advised that the gelding had appreciated today's heavy track conditions.</p> <p>ROC THE CRADLE (S Collett) - When asked to comment on the performance of the favoured runner, the rider advised the gelding had only battled in today's testing track conditions and may be looking for looser track conditions.</p>	
Race 5	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO OPEN HANDICAP (1600m)
<p>LAAFFAIRE (L Allpress) – Raced keenly while leading in the early stages. Lay out in the run home and had to be straightened passing the 150 metres.</p>	

Race 6	GAVELHOUSE.COM RATING 75 (1400m)
<p>The start of this event was delayed due to DOCKET and KINGS PAL both proving difficult to load.</p> <p>KINGS PAL (B Murray) - Fractious in the barriers. Slow to begin.</p> <p>ALL BLACK MAGIC (J Laking) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>THE PRECIOUS ONE (S Wynne) - Hampered at the start losing some ground. Held up for clear running rounding the final turn. Lay inwards early stages of the home straight. Shifted ground inwards passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>HE KIN FLY (K Williams) - Wide early.</p> <p>PROMISING (K Kwo) - Keen early stages. Shifted inwards making firm contact with DOCKET near the 1200 metres. Keen for a short distance passing the 700 metres. When spoken to regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare was stepping up in class today however had still been disappointing adding that she may be feeling the effects of recent racing in his opinion.</p> <p>DOCKET (G Jogoo) - Firmly contacted and unbalanced near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>MOSSOMAK (L Allpress) - Keen for a short distance when restrained passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>SECRET STASH (K Cowan) - Raced wide from the 700 metres. Rider reported that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable with today's track conditions.</p> <p>MOYRABELLA (S Collett) - Was inclined to lay out throughout the run home shifting wider on the track.</p>	
Race 7	RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE RATING 75 (2000m)
<p>SATIN GURU (J Lowry) - Underwent a pre-race Veterinary inspection after being fractious in the tie up stalls and was cleared to start. Shifted in shortly after the start.</p> <p>J Lowry (SATIN GURU) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1)(d) for allowing his mount to shift in shortly after the start when only marginally clear of SHANZINO who was crowded and had to be steadied inwards.</p> <p>TAXIHOME (S Wynne) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly and wide early stages.</p> <p>LONG HARBOUR (B Murray) - Keen early stages.</p> <p>THE MAN (K Cowan) - Raced wide throughout. Lay in throughout the run home.</p> <p>SHANZINO (S Weatherley) - Crowded and had to be steadied shortly after the start. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home having to shift outwards passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>LADY BEALEY (S Collett) - Rider dropped whip passing the 250 metres.</p> <p>SHEZATOUCHA (T Comignaghi) - Rider reminded of her obligations to make sure she rides her mount to the finish line when circumstances permit.</p>	
Race 8	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1600m)
<p>FUGAWI (K Gundowry) - Began awkwardly and lost ground then threw its head in the air when being restrained soon after the start.</p> <p>QUAINTRELLE (BB Hong) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>MONZA CIRCUITO (R Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1400 metres. Wide throughout. Raced greenly in the final straight and shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>K Williams (SHOWPIN) – Issued with a warning for careless riding when allowing her mount to shift ground inwards passing the 1400 metres crowding MONZA CIRCUITO which had to be steadied outwards away from heels.</p>	

SHOWPIN (K Williams) – Had to be restrained passing the 1300 metres when crowded for room. Briefly crowded again passing the 150 metres.

HOLLYPOP (L Callaway) - Had to be severely restrained off heels passing the 1300 metres when over racing and crowded for room. Had to be again restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres when continuing to over race.

K Cowan (MOREIRA) - Warned for careless riding at the 1300 metres when shifting in when only marginally clear dictating SHOWPIN inwards on to HOLLYPOP.

OPIHI RANGER (J Fawcett) – The connections will be spoken to in coming days in regards the apparent improved performance.
