Race 1	LUSTY'S SHOWCASE JEWELLERS HANDICAP (1600m)

HIGHER AUTHORITY (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

**GALWAY GARRY** (K Kwo) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

**ROAD TO REDEMPTION** (K Mudhoo) – Saddle slipped backwards passing the 600 metres placing the rider in difficulty for the remainder of the event.

WHAT'S UP ALF (R Beeharry) – Lay inwards near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

Official track conditions were downgraded to Heavy 11 retrospective to Race 1.

## Race 2 ALL FOR LOVE FLOWERS & RIVERTON ELECTRICAL (1400M)

**MIDNITE KAOS** (T Moseley) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked at the start area and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 12.11pm.

**LIL MISS SWISS** (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly unbalancing its rider and getting back as a result. Lay inwards near the 200 metres and had to be straightened.

**ROCK MASTER** (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly. Lost contact with the body of the field passing the 800 metres despite the urgings of its rider.

**RED ROSETTE** (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly through the early stages.

**RED MAJOR** (K Mudhoo) – Held up on the heels of the tiring RED ROSETTE passing the 600 metres.

FRANKY DOYLE (T Comignaghi) – Held up early in the run home.

Following the running of this event Stewards convened a meeting with the riders from Race 2 who expressed concerns with the visibility due to splash back from the track following persistent heavy rain. Stewards then convened a further meeting with a delegation of senior riders, club officials and trainers where it was determined the meeting be abandoned for safety reason due to visibility issues.
