### GENERAL:

G Cooksley and J Parkes did not attend today's meeting due to illness. Both riders required to provide medical clearances before riding next.
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### SUPPLEMENTARY:

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**RACE COMMENTS:**

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>FRUITFED CUSTOMER SERVICES HURDLE (2500 metres)</b>
<p><b>WHITE DIAMOND</b> (W Gordon) – Fell at the second fence dislodging its rider. Rider W Gordon was attended to by on-course paramedics and was found to be suffering from concussion being transferred to hospital for further assessment. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found minor lacerations in its nasal passage.</p> <p><b>CULLISTER</b> (D Jensen) - Slow away. Hampered after jumping second fence when runners either shifted around the fallen runner.</p> <p><b>DES DE JEU</b> (T Johnson) - Ran down a number of fences throughout.</p> <p><b>COUNTER ATTACK</b> (C Studd) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today’s track conditions and would benefit from more rain effected footing.</p> <p><b>ZEDSATIONAL</b> (A Kuru) – Hit the final fence.</p> <p><b>MANGATUTU</b> (M Cropp) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.</p> <p><b>HER SON</b> (L Douglas) – Hit the final fence and blundered.</p> <p>Due to the fallen rider, Stewards directed runners around the second-to-last fence.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ADAMA NZ LTD HURDLE (2500 metres)</b>
<p>The start of Race 2 was delayed approximately 3 minutes to allow the ambulance to return to the course.</p> <p><b>GUY FOX</b> (S Fannin) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>KIPKEINO</b> (E Farr) – Jumped outwards at the fence near the 1900 metres inconveniencing <b>CANDIDLY</b>. Contacted near 600 metres.</p> <p><b>CANDIDLY</b> (M Roustoby) – Inconvenienced 1900 metres.</p> <p><b>NO CHANGE</b> (A Kuru) - Contacted <b>KIPKEINO</b> when attempting a narrow run to the inside near the 600 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>AGRITRADE VALAGRO 2100 (2100 metres)</b>
<p><b>HIDDEN VALLEY</b> (S Rennie) - Tightened at start.</p> <p><b>OUR CHUCKY</b> (E Glasgow) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.</p> <p><b>SOIREE</b> (E Taiaroa) – Began awkwardly, then commenced to race keenly in the early and middle stages when racing wide. Crowded and clipped a heel when runners either side shifted ground near the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>STARBRO</b> (H Parkes) - Had to be restrained off heels when racing keenly near the 1650 metres making the bend awkwardly. Raced wide round the final bend.</p> <p><b>THE DASH</b> (A Reid) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>A Reid</b> (<b>THE DASH</b>) – Issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) for allowing her mount to shift in near the 250 metres crowding <b>SOIREE</b> onto the heels of <b>SNUFFLEUPAGUS</b>, with <b>SOIREE</b> clipping a heel and blundering. Contributing to this incident was outward movement from <b>SNUFFLEUPAGUS</b>.</p>	

**PIERIAN SPRING** (M Northcott) – Held up until near the 250 metres then tightened approaching the 150 metres when improving into a narrow run to the inside of LA JUNGLES which shifted in under pressure before being straightened. Tightened again passing the 100 metres when LA JUNGLES shifted in.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends a protest was lodged under Rule 642(1) by the connections of the second placed PIERIAN SPRING against the first placed LA JUNGLES alleging interference in the home straight. After viewing footage and hearing evidence the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

**Race 4** | **STU COVELL MEMORIAL (4000 metres)**

**NOAH JON** (M Roustoby) - Jumped erratically in the early stages resulting in the saddle slipping forward and was pulled up approaching the fifth fence.

**BRER** (S Fannin) - Ran down the fence near the 1200 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have a right fore tendon injury. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

**ZARDETTO** (A Kuru) - Blundered at the fence near the 800 metres.

**OUR JACKSON** (I Lupton) – When questioned regarding performance rider reported that the gelding would prefer more rain-affected going.

**H McNeill** (DOCTOR FOX) - Issued with a warning under Rule 636(1)(d) and reminded of his obligations in regard to riding his mounts out fully to end of the race when circumstances permit.

**Race 5** | **BALLANCE AGRI-NUTRIENTS LTD 2YO (1200 metres)**

**TILDY** (S Weatherley) – Late scratching at 1.08pm after refusing to load. Connections were advised that the filly must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards before racing next.

**FACETIME** (S Collett) - Slow away. Made the bend awkwardly approaching the 800 metres.

**BEASTMODE** (S McKay) - Had to be restrained off heels making the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres when INSYNC (L Innes) shifted in when not fully clear. L Innes was advised to exercise care. Inconvenienced near the 300 metres after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of INSYNC which shifted out. Contributing to this incident was BESTMODE'S tendency to lay in. Rider reported that BEASTMODE had got its tongue over the bit during the running.

**MARBUZET** (R Elliot) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**Race 6** | **CORTEVA AGRISCIENCE 1200 (1200 metres)**

**SHADY LADY** (H Durrant) – Awkwardly away settling back. Had to be restrained near the 800 metres, making the bend awkwardly.

**KELTIC ROCKSTAR** (M Tanaka) – Slow away.

**HAPPY SEA DRAGON** (T Johnson) - Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres then continued to lay out rounding the bend.

**FLEUR DELACOUR** (D Bradley) – Hung outwards throughout.

**AKOYA PEARL** (M Cameron) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Had to shift ground outwards approaching the 100 metres to obtain clear running.

**MR JIMMY POCKET** (T Newman) - Was unable to obtain clear running inside the final 200 metres.

**FUTURE PATCH** (S Weatherley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 150 metres.

**CARILLION** (T Allan) – Checked passing 100 metres.

**D Johnson** (RAPOSA RAPIDA) - Admitted a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that she allowed her mount RAPOSA RAPIDA to shift in when not sufficiently clear of CARILLION which was checked passing the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending Ms Johnson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 30 May up to and including Wednesday 6 June (6 national days).

Prior to the authorisation of dividends, T Allan the rider of the second placed horse CARILLION, viewed Stewards' footage alleging interference in the final straight by the winner RAPOSA RAPIDA (D Johnson) before electing not to proceed with a protest.

**Race 7** | **SYNGENTA CROP PROTECTION 3YO (1300 metres)**

**THE HEIRESS** (M Cameron) – Late scratching at 1.51pm on veterinary advice after injuring itself in the tie-up stalls.

**NAVAL BRIGADE** (D Johnson) – Slow away. Commenced to over-race in the early stages making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly running wide despite the efforts of its rider crowding GARADOS (A Jones) out on to the heels of JUDITH (V Colgan) with GARADOS clipping a heel and falling, dislodging its rider. A Jones was attended to by paramedics and found to be suffering from mild concussion and was transferred to hospital for further assessment.

**GARADOS** (A Jones) – Clipped a heel and fell rounding the bend near the 800 metres when crowded, dislodging its rider. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration to the left nostril.

**SALVATION** (L Innes) – Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Race 8** | **NUFARM LTD 1300 (1300 metres)**

**ICEBOMB** (T Newman) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.

**EDWARDIAN LADY** (T Allan) - Jumped outwards at the start contacting CRAFTY CRIM, which jumped inwards. Raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.

**CRAFTY CRIM** (M Tanaka) – Began awkwardly making contact with EDWARDIAN LADY, losing ground.

**DANCE FOR MONEY** (S MacNab) – Slow to begin.

**DANGEROUS PONY** (E McCall) – Briefly held up near the 200 metres.

**NEW CROWN** (S Collett) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 150 metres.

**ACTRESSSA** (L Innes) - Improved on to heels over the final 100 metres.

**Race 9** | **FRUITFED SUPPLIES 1400 (1400 metres)**

**IN DREAMLAND** (D Hirini) – Slow away.

**GALILEO HEART** (T Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

**THELMA** (S Collett) - Began awkwardly.

**THUTMOSIS** (T Allan) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up for a distance from the 600 metres gaining clear running near the 200 metres.

**STEVIE'S SURPRISE** (A Sims) – Raced wide throughout.

**PAINT THE TOWN** (D Johnson) – Lay out when placed under pressure inside the final 150 metres forcing **ROCKONEVE** outwards slightly.

**ROCKONEVE** (R Myers) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Forced outwards inside the final 50 metres by **PAINT THE TOWN** which lay out.

**DOWN THIS ROAD** (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse.

Prior to authorisation of dividends the connections of the second placed horse **ROCKONEVE** (R Myers), viewed stewards' footage alleging interference over the concluding stages by the first placed **PAINT THE TOWN** (D Johnson), before electing not to proceed with a protest.

**Race 10**

**PIERCIE'S LEGACY 1400 (1400 metres)**

**OWEN PATRICK** (S Weatherley) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked behind the barriers and was cleared to start.

**JELLIS** (M Tanaka) - Began awkwardly contacting **ELSTON** which settled back.

**ELSTON** (V Colgan) – Contacted start, settling back. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 850 metres.

**SMOOTH TALKER** (T Harris) – Made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly.

**INVERNESS** (T Newman) – Held up for a distance near the 400 metres, then raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres.
