BURLONE (T Harris) -Slow to begin.				
UNACCEPTABLE	(G Walsh) - Began awkwardly then was crowded.			

KANUMISS (J Riddell) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider J Riddell advised the filly raced further back than intended and had only made ground fairly in the straight in today's track conditions.

VIAAGO (H McNeill) - Over raced then restrained in the early stages.

S Phelan (BAY ROCKER) - Issued with a warning after allowing BAY ROCKER to shift out under pressure when insufficiently clear of ALL TRUMPED UP passing the 300 metres which was hampered.

ALL TRUMPED UP (J Seivwright) - Steadied when crowded passing the 300 metres.

MANGAROA FIRE (M Roustoby) Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 75 metres.

Race 2NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACEBITTERSWEET BABE (S Weatherley) – Slow away (4L).

HORSEY HORSE HORSE (R Norvall) - Raced wide without cover.

Jordan Nason - Stood down by Paramedics, after becoming unwell following Race 2.

RED JOHN (H Bognuda) - Saddle slipped forward in the early stages with H Bognuda retiring RED JOHN from the race near the 800 metres.

BUGS MORAN (J Seivwright) - Began awkwardly and then badly hampered losing ground. Steadied shifting ground when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KEEN TO KEEPER.

GEORGETHEFIFTH (C Studd) - Contacted leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced.

MASTER POET (G Walsh) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barrier. Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 WRIGHTWAY BUILDERS

KIPLING (D Danis) Began awkwardly losing ground.

LHOTSE Began awkwardly then raced in restricted room.

ONE DAY AT A TIME (A Calder) – Commenced to race keenly passing the 1000 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance.

COUNTRY BUMPKIN (V Colgan) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1000 metres, further inconveniencing ONE DAY AT A TIME.

LEAF (M Coleman) - Shifted in over the concluding stages making brief contact with COSSACK WARRIOR.

CAPTAIN ORANGE (K Cowan) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

COSSACK WARRIOR (J Riddell) – Lost right front plate during the race.

Race 5 HI TECH FLOOR SCRUBBERS

SHAMASH (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

IVORY CHALICE (D Danis) – Began awkwardly and then was hampered losing ground. Forced wider round the final bend.

JUST A PHOEBE (R Norvall) - Began awkwardly making contact and then was steadied.

REGAL ASSASSIN (S Spratt) - Got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

ELECTRIC LEXI (M Cameron) – Stumbled on jumping away. Got its head up near the 1200 metres when being steadied after becoming awkwardly placed inside heels. Hung throughout running wide rounding the final bend forcing IVORY CHALICE wider on the track and was then not preserved with over the final 350 metres.

Race 6NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACEALPHASTAR (D Danis) - Began very awkwardly losing ground.

SHOWTENAIRE (T Yanagida) - Slow to begin.

DAINTY ROSE (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

ZAPPEUR (D Johnson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

INDIAN MAID (M Cameron) – Held up passing the 300 metres. Lost right front plate during the race.

Race 7 COLCHESTER ENGINEERING

STORYTIME (D Johnson) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers and steadied.

RICKY BAKER (T Harris) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.

LIQUID INSPIRATION (D Danis) – Held up rounding the final bend having to shift in across the heels of SOROC to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

SOROC (M Vance) - When questioned regarding the gelding's performance rider M Vance advised the gelding was unsuited in today's track conditions preferring loser footing. Trainer L Sommerville advised that the gelding will now be spelled.

FORTUNE PATCH (S Weatherley) – Held up early in the final straight having to shift out across the heels of SIMPLY IMPECCABLE to obtain clear running.

Race 8 K.R. BELL ELECTRICAL

WHISPER ROCK (K Cowan) – Badly hampered leaving the barriers by SHEEZNOTEASY which shifted out abruptly, also hampered as a result was ARENARULER.

ARENARULER (T Newman) - Hampered start. Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 900 metres for a distance.

LIFE JACKET (R Smyth) - Slow to begin.

PACO LAD (S McKay) – Steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of SHOWCOBLU.

THE POORMANZABEEL (S Collett) -Commenced to over-race for a distance in the early stages.

NUTTEE (D Danis) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 9 TEAM WEALLEANS

ARAPAHO PRINCE (M Coleman) - Slow to begin.

CLARIOS (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly.

SHE'S MINE (C Lammas) - Slow to begin.

MALLORY SQUARE (D Johnson) - Slow to begin.

WAIWETU LASS (V Colgan) – Raced handy but was quickly under pressure passing the 250 metres. When questioned V Colgan felt the filly was unsuited to today's existing track conditions and also advised that the filly had pulled up well.

SHOW 'N' GO (T Yanagida) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after returning to the enclosure with a trickle of blood in one nostril which revealed the gelding to have some abrasions inside the nostril.

M Hills (TIME TO FLY) Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.
