<p>YGRITTE was a late scratching at 9.22 am due to transport difficulties.</p> <p>BOGATYR (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>ZENTESSA (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>SO NATURAL (R Beeharry) –Proved difficult to load Barrier Manners warning. Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>ELEGIDO (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>JANE AVRIL (G Jogoo) – Lay outwards passing the 400 metres having to be straightened, held up in the early stages of the home straight.</p> <p>SWISSKY (S Weatherley) – Lay inwards throughout the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage.</p> <p>EL CAMPEADOR (J Lowry) – Buffeted when in tight quarters near the 220 metres.</p> <p>BROTHER WILL (K Mudhoo) – Steadied outwards across heels near the 200 metres, lay inwards and had to be straightened near the 50 metres, rider lost his whip in the shadows of the post.</p> <p>Retrospective to this race the track was upgraded to Slow (7).</p>

<p>SILHOUETTES (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly, raced wide throughout.</p> <p>TO LOVE YOU (C Johnson) - Got its head up shortly after the start, raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>HEAD OFFICE (R Beeharry) – Got its head up shortly after the start.</p> <p>SHARP’N’SILVER (T Moseley)- Keen for a distance passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>TOO PRECIOUS (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>AMOUR LA VIE (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>BY MAGIC (G Jogoo) – Heavily restrained passing the 900 metres when improving onto heels.</p>	
Race 3	GERALDINE VILLAGE INN SPORTS BAR DASH 1200m
<p>ON POINT (J Lowry) – Slow to begin, attempted a marginal run passing the 250 metres and raced in restricted room for some distance thereafter jostling with outside runner.</p> <p>PINSHARP (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>LUCKY EDIE (P Shaikh) – Raced keenly in the early stages, raced wide throughout, bumped 250 metres and jostled with ON POINT for some distance thereafter.</p>	

J Lowry (ON POINT) was warned for the manner in which he attempted to shift ground passing the 250 metres.

TWILIGHT METEOR (R Mudhoo) – Awkwardly placed on heels near the 200 metres having to steady and shift ground outwards.

BILBAO (R Firdhaus) – Lay inwards near the 180 metres.

R Firdhaus (BILBAO) was was warned for shifting ground near the 180 metres.

BLACK LABEL (K Williams) – When questioned regarding improved performance, the connections advised that the mare was better suited to today's track conditions.

Race 4	SUPREME EQUINE FEEDS HANDICAP 1200m

ELUSIVE BOXERS (S Collett) was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 12.45 pm after dislodging its rider and escaping and galloping a circuit of the track.S Collet was unharmed in this incident.

MR CONDUCTOR (C Barnes) which was already at the start area when ELUSIVE BOXERS escaped was late scratched at 12.50 pm after also dislodging its rider and escaping whilst being lead. C Barnes was unharmed in this incident.

SOMETHINGS BURNING (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.

SABER (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages, held up for a short distance near the 200 metres and shifted outwards to obtain clear running.

CELTIC CROSS (R Firdhaus) – Lay inwards throughout the home straight and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

The start was delayed when **FIENDISH** proved difficult to load. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's barrier manners.

FIVEWAYEIGHT (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

MEASURED TWICE (J Laking) – Slow to begin.

MOWENNA (G Jogoo) – Steadied when in restricted room near the 1300 metres.

SHOCK AND AWE (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.

LET HER RIP RILEY (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1200 metres, rider dropped her whip passing the 150 metres.

VILLERET (G Saejorhor) – Rider dropped his whip passing the 100 metres.

Race 6	ONCEUPONATIME & MORE FM MAIDEN 1600m

RETORT (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin, bumped and unbalanced from the inside passing the 400 metres. Returned to the birdcage with a superficial injury to the right front leg consistent with striking itself.

ROC THE CRADLE (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

DREAM START (S Toolooa) – Hampered between runners shortly after jumping and got back, contacted a heel and blundered near the 400 metres ,badly unbalancing the rider, when awkwardly placed between COOLIN ROO which had shifted outwards and RETORT.

COOLIN ROO (K Kwo) – The saddle slipped forward shortly after the start placing the rider in some difficulty, shifted outwards near the 500 metres and continued to shift outwards despite the rider’s efforts, shifted outwards near the 400 metres.

K Kwo (COOLIN ROO) was warned for shifting ground near the 400 metres. In coming to this decision Stewards took into account the fact Mr Kwo’s saddle had slipped badly.

HOLD THE RADDLE (C Barnes) – Got its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance passing the 1400 metres.

LOUVRES (K Williams) – Raced keenly for some distance passing the 1300 metres

BEAM ME UP SCOTTY (S Muniandy) – Raced wide throughout.

LIVE IN HOPE (R Firdhaus) – Raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.

DAMANAKA (J Lowry) – Lay inwards throughout the final straight and had to be steadied when laying inwards across heels near the 200 metres and again near the 100 metres having to be straightened off heels.

JONTYS ACE (S Weatherley) – Held up over the concluding stages when in restricted room and could not be ridden fully to the finish.

METASEQUOIA (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

O’KIWI (C Johnson) – Slow to begin, raced keenly for some distance passing the 1000 metres.

RICHIE RICH (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages when restrained. Rider K Mudhoo was severely reprimanded for easing the pace near the 1300 metres. Gave ground over the concluding stages. The connections advised it was their intention to retire the gelding from their stable as a racing proposition.

FEDERER EXPRESS (T Comignaghi) – Contacted a heel and blundered badly near the 1400 metres.

BRIDGET TOWN (R Beeharry) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

SHE’SSTOOHOTTOTROT (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.

GOLDEN VALKYRIE (T Moseley) – Raced keenly for some distance passing the 1200 metres.

I’LLAV BUBBLES (R Firdhaus) – Raced keenly for some distance in the middle stages becoming awkwardly placed between runners.

FUGAWI (S Muniandy) – Raced keenly for some distance near the 1100 metres.

PRECIOUS PERCY (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly in the early stages, improved wide from the 900 metres, raced in restricted room near the 200 metres with the rider momentarily losing use of her whip.

LADY BEALEY (S Collett) – Not afforded clear running throughout the early part of the home straight.

PICKUP (J Laking) – Held up in the early stages of the run home, shifted out near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

THE MAN (J Lowry) – Lay inwards and had to be straightened near the 200 metres.

ACEDECEE (R Firdhaus) – Slow to begin.

SMART GARDEN (C Johnson) – Slow to begin, steadied for some distance passing the 600 metres, came together with DYLANS PRIDE on a number of occasions over the concluding stages when in tight quarters.

PAINTED ANGEL (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin.

DYLANS PRIDE (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly, came together with SMART GARDEN on a number of occasions over the concluding stages when in tight quarters.

SAGESSE DE SOTHYS (C Barnes) – Raced wide in the early stages.

TATUM (A Comignaghi)- Steadied 1400 metres when on awkwardly placed on heels .

ROYAL MISTRESS (S Collett) – Raced wide throughout.

HEZA DUKE (J Lowry) – Lay inwards in the early part of the straight.

K Kwo (BLACK EYED SUSAN) – reminded of obligations in respect of whip use on a runner out of contention.

G Jogoo (BABAN) was reprimanded for unnecessary use of the whip over the concluding stages when well clear of the field.
