D Turner failed to make the carded weight for **SERENITY** in Race 3 and **BANBURY LAD** in Race 6 and was fined \$200.

Race 1	LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES MAIDEN 1340					
RUOMAZA (S MacNab) - Began awkwardly settling back. Inconvenienced having to be restrained near the 600 metres then held up until approaching the 400 metres.						
CASTLE BLACK (R	Elliot) - tightened at the start settling back					

BUFFALO BELLE (M Tanaka) - Over-raced in the back straight and near the 800 metres had to steady when **THELMA (L Allpress)** and **THUTMOSIS (J Riddell)** shifted in. After questioning riders and viewing footage **J Riddell** and **L Allpress** respectively were advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Also inconvenienced was **FRANCESCA KATE** which had to be restrained off the heels of **BUFFALO BELLE**.

JOY RIDE (M MacNab) - Did not persevere with his mount over the final stages and on returning to the enclosure, reported the mare went off stride in the going near the 600 metres shifting inwards tightening **FRANCESCA KATE** and hampering **RUOMAZA** which had to be restrained. M McNab considered something was amiss with his mount. A subsequent inspection of the area by the Stewards revealed the track to be in a satisfactory condition. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a wound to the right hind.

FRANCESCA KATE (C O'Beirne) – tightened near the 600 metres

ORIGINAL GANGSTER (R Myers) – briefly held up passing the 400 metres

GLIMPSE (T Johnson) - raced keenly for a distance near the 1,000 metres

Race 2 WANGANUI CHRONICLE 1340

HUNDYAMONTH (S Collett) – Was removed from the barriers and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to start after being fractious in its gate.

RED SIERRA (C O'Beirne) - Jumped inwards at the start contacting **FATHER LENIHAN** and settled back.

FATHER LENIHAN (M Tanaka) – contacted at the start

GLADSTONE BELLE (A Jones) – held up from the 800 metres until approaching the 600 metres

REGAL WINKS (J Parkes) – Held up near the 350 metres having to be angled back towards the inside to gain clear running passing the 200 metres. Tightened again approaching the 50 metres going to the line without being fully tested.

MYRTLE (M Cameron) - Was not persevered with in the home straight when out of contention. Rider could offer no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

OTTAVIO (R Elliot) - When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding had not appreciated today's slow track conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 3 D HOSKIN CARRIERS 1200

TABARD (Z Moki) – Slow away. When questioned into the performance rider could offer no tangible excuse other than the gelding may improve with the run.

YOU'LL DO ME (W Pinn) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages

IRISH MIST (J Parkes) – When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding may not have appreciated today's track conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

STAROSSA (J Fawcett) – lay in under pressure in the home straight

Race 4 JOHN TURKINGTON FORESTRY LTD CASTLETOWN STAKES 1200

WEKAFORCE (M McNab) - Awkwardly away settling back. When questioned into the performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

QIJI EXPRESS (M Cameron) - Lay in under pressure over the final stages, having to be straightened.

ZANIAH (M Coleman) – When questioned rider advised the filly had been unsuited to today's track conditions.Race 5WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 2040

TOUCH OF SILVER (M Cameron) – Slow away. When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding may

appreciate a looser track. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

DUELLICIOUS (W Pinn) – Awkwardly away. Held up approaching the 400 metres having to be angled outwards to improve.

DR HANK (T Harris) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages getting its head in the air.

PRINCESS PAMME (S MacNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be restrained off heels near the 1,600 metres.

MISTRESS POROTENE (M McNab) - raced wide throughout

Race 6 BALANCE ACCOUNTANTS OPN 2040

DR WATSON - Late scratching on veterinary advice. After arriving at the start was found to be lame in the near foreleg.

ZENTANGLE (S MacNab) - Bounded at the start losing ground. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

THIRD TIME LUCKY (R Myers) – Slow away. Held up for a distance approaching the 600 metres.

KIPKEINO (S Collett) - raced three wide without cover throughout

Race 7 AG CHALLENGE STAKES 1590

OVERTHERIVER (Z Moki) – Raced without a rear plate which became detached on the way to the start and could not be replaced.

SCAPOLO (S MacNab) - Held up near the 250 metres having to be angled inwards across heels to gain clear running approaching the 100 metres.

PETIT EN JEU (L Allpress) – Was eased when in restricted room over the final stages.
