GENERAL:

J Lowry advised the stewards he was unwell and was replaced on his rides as per schedule below. Mr Lowry is to provide a medical certificate prior to riding next.

Due to safety reasons the 1800 metres starts were shifted back approximately 40 metres.

Stewards advised the Club that the 1800 metre start was unsatisfactory and a gate is required on the outside fence at the 1800 start point so that the starting gates can be lined up properly. This work is expected to be completed before their next thoroughbred meeting.

Trainer M Pitman advised the stewards after further veterinary examination QUEEN SERENE has been diagnosed as a Grade 4 roarer and has been retired from racing.

RACE COMMENTS:

Waimate Town & Country Club & Birchwood Genetics 1200m

EPIC DREAMER (T Comignaghi) - Slow to begin. Steady passing the 200 metre mark and shifted outwards near the 130 metres making firm contact with WOLFF SPIRIT.

TAPONISME (B Murray) - Restrained early stages and over raced for some distance. Lay inwards and had to be restrained when passing the 150 metres.

WHY ME (BB Hong) - Restrained early stages.

RICHIE ROX (J Laking) - Keen early stages and got its head up on a number occasions when being restrained.

VICE MARSHALL (T Moseley) - Keen early stages.

SAVASON (J Bassett) - Wide throughout. Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

WOLFF SPIRIT (K Kwo) - Held up rounding the bend near the 250 metres. Buffeted between EPIC DREAMER which shifted outwards and DEEBEE BLACK (R Firdhaus) which lay inwards passing the 130 metres.

Race 2 Garrards & Livamol Maiden 1200m

ROC LEONE (G Jogoo) – Hampered early. Had to steady and shift outwards off heels passing the 150 metres.

BOGATYR (R Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly. Wide early before improving to sit outside the leader passing the 700 metres.

ROCKAPAN (C Barnes) – Shifted outwards at the start hampering outside runners. Lay out on final bend forcing MATHIEU wider on the track.

ADVENT (C Johnson) – Hampered shortly after start.

TAP TAP (R Firdhaus) - Began awkwardly.

MY SOPRANO (R Beeharry) – Placed in restricted room and buffeted for a short distance when over racing passing the 1100 metres when NEVER QUITZ (B Murray) who was laying in, shifted in. Continued to over race and was again placed in restricted room passing the 900 metres when NEVER QUITZ shifted in again. B Murray was advised to exercise greater care.

MATHIEU (BB Hong) – Wide throughout. Forced wider final bend.

SHARP 'N' SILVER (T Moseley) - When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the filly had not handled today's conditions.

LUVABATTLE (L Callaway) - Held up by tiring runner for a distance passing the 400 metres.

Following this event the track was downgraded to a Slow 9.

Race 3 George & Mary Hennessy 1200m

KOXINGA (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

KEEP ON COMING (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin. Rider reported the horse did not feel comfortable in today's track conditions.

SABRE (J Bassett) – Keen early stages.

CELTIC CROSS (R Firdhaus) - Wide early stages.

SOMETHINGS BURNING (T Moseley) - Steadied momentarily when crowded for room and awkwardly placed on heels passing the 850 metres and had to be steadied away from the heels again passing the 600 metres.

G Jogoo (MADAM BENTLEY) – Issued a warning under Careless Riding Rule 638 (1)(d) when shifting ground inwards crowding SOMETHINGS BURNING passing the 850 metres.

Race 4 Ron Williamson Maiden 1800m

SMART GARDEN (T Comignaghi) - Fractious in the barriers and was slow to begin. Improved wide from the 800 metres.

PAINTED ANGEL (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runners. Contacted on a number of occasions passing the 1400 metres when racing tightly to the inside of ROCK THE CRADLE.

ROC THE CRADLE (G Jogoo) - Hampered at the start. Keen early and had to steady near the 1500 m when awkwardly

placed on the heels of JONTYS ACE. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Bumped on a numbered of occasions with PAINTED ANGEL near the 1400 metres. Lay outwards in the home straight and could not be ridden to any advantage.

WENTWORTH (R Firdhaus) - Slow to begin.

ACEDECEE (J Laking) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start having to steady when MISS GEE EYE lay out at this point.

JONTYS ACE (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout the early and middle stages. Lay inwards for some distance passing the 400 metres with the rider reporting the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's conditions.

HOLD THE RADDLE (C Barnes) – Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1300 metres.

OUR BOY BAZ (B Murray) - Rider reported the gelding had not handled today's heavy track conditions.

When questioned about the improved performance of runner **MRS GEE EYE** co-trainer N White reported that she had been surprised by the mares improved performance although the step up in distance and the looser track conditions may have aided the performance today.

Following the running of this event the track was downgraded to a Heavy 10.

Race 5 Dunstan Feeds 1800m

DREAM RICH (K Kwo) – Slow to begin and got back.

OUR MADONNA (S Toolooa) – Wide throughout.

VAN GOGH (K Williams) - Raced keenly early.

THE TETIAN TITAN (T Moseley) - Rider dropped his whip passing the 400 metres.

MADAME LIBRE (S Saejorhor) - Steadied off heels passing the 550 metres had to shift ground inwards passing the 100 metres when again becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

Race 6 Mark Meyer 1800m

HIGHER AUTHORITY (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

NESTA (L Callaway) – Raced keenly early and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained and continued to race keenly through to the middle stages.

OPIHI JADE (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin. Wide throughout.

LADY BEALEY (B Murray) – Slow to begin.

WHISPERING (C Johnson) - When spoken to regarding the performance of the favoured runner the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

GOLDEN BAY (C Barnes) - The rider reported the gelding had not handled todays heavy track conditions.

Race 7 Willow Glen Stud Waimate Cup 1800m

WILD JACK (A Bohorun) - Slow to begin.

STOKERS ROCK (C Barnes) – Crowded shortly after start and lost ground.

MAID OF STEEL (K Williams) – Raced keenly early stages, gave ground concluding stages finishing last. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 8 PGG Wrightson Waimate & McAlpine 1800m

BUSHIDO (C Johnson) - Hampered at the start, raced keen early stages. Raced fiercely for a distance passing the 1200

metres.

SIR ED (B Murray) – Made contact with BUSHIDO at start. Raced keenly for a distance passing the winning post on the first occasion having to be restrained off heels.

FLY WITHOUT WINGS (A Bohorun) – Slow to begin. Improved wide rounding the final bend.

GREY GHOST (K Kwo) – Keen for a distance when buffeted between runners passing the winning post on the first occasion. Dictated wider rounding the home turn when FLY WITHOUT WINGS (A Bohorun) shifted out to find clear racing room. A Bohorun was shown footage of this incident and advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground in future.
