L Somervell (IMPULSIVE HABIT) – Issued with a warning [Rule 340] for comments made in a post-race interview with *Trackside*.

W Pinn (IMPULSIVE HABIT) – Reprimanded for comments made in a post-race interview with *Trackside*. Apprentice W Pinn is to receive further training and supervision by his employer Mr A Sharrock and National Riding Master N Harris.

Race 1	MCROBBIE CONTRACTING LTD 1400
<p>PIAGET (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>STOLE THE SHOW (R Scott) – Slow away.</p> <p>REGAL ASSASSIN (S Spratt) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>CARRELEUR (T Miles) - Steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1000 metres. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>ZABEELIOUS (A Sims) – Raced keenly in the early stages before becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 950 metres and shifted out making contact with BANKS ROAD.</p> <p>SWISS HAZE (S McKay) - Lay out inside the final 100 metres finishing wide on the track. A warning was placed on the gelding's racing manners.</p>	
Race 2	GOLDEN GRAIN LTD 3YO
<p>MARJI'S GOLD (T Miles) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.</p> <p>CAVALLO ECCELLENTE (C Lammas) – Commenced to over race for a distance when being steadied shortly after jumping away.</p> <p>BACK IN A FLASH (A Calder) - Crowded and checked near the 950 metres.</p> <p>ARENARULER (K Cowan) – Bumped and became unbalanced near the 950 metres.</p> <p>TIME TO FLY (M Hills) – Inconvenienced when passing the 200 metres and again near the 50 metres.</p> <p>ENGLISH GAMBLER (J Riddell) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>J Riddell - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount ENGLISH GAMBLER to shift out when not sufficiently clear of TIME TO FLY which was inconvenienced near the 200 metres and again near the 50 metres.</p> <p>R Jones - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed his mount BAYAMO to shift in near the 950 metres when not sufficiently clear of BACK IN A FLASH which was crowded and checked also hampered as a result was ARENARULER. After viewing films and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended R Jones' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 17 June up to and including racing on 24 June, 5 National days.</p>	

Race 3	H R FISKEN & SONS LTD 1200
<p>NAVAL BRIGADE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly then further hampered losing ground. Over raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>MOFARA (V Colgan) - Hampered on jumping away losing ground.</p> <p>KIRRAMISU (S Collet) – Steadied shortly after the start when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of GOODNIGHT IRENE (A Jones) which shifted in when not fully clear then commenced to over race for a distance. A Jones was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>CINNAMAN (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres then had to be firmly restrained shortly after when GOODNIGHT IRENE (A Jones) shifted in when not fully clear.</p> <p>GOODNIGHT IRENE (A Jones) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p> <p>A Jones - Issued with a warning for allowing her mount GOODNIGHT IRENE to shift in when not sufficiently clear of CINNAMAN which had to be steadied near the 950 metres.</p>	
Race 4	TEAM WEALLEANS 2100
<p>DUKE SREET (J Nason) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>EN SOIE (T Thornton) – Steadied near the 1800 metres then commenced to over race for a distance. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly failed to handle today’s track conditions.</p> <p>MR WOODI (T Miles) – Made the bend near the 1650 metres awkwardly and shifted out forcing PWERFECT wider on the track also hampered as a result was MAGIC CANNON.</p> <p>PWERFECT (S Collet) – Forced wider 1650 metres.</p> <p>MAGIC CANNON (C Lammas) - Hampered 1650 metres.</p>	
Race 5	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>ALPHASTAR (S McKay) – Late scratching at 2.30pm by order of the Stewards after refusing to go to the start. Connections were advised that the filly would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.</p> <p>AVEC MOI (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>NEW CROWN (S Collet) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>GANGSTERS LASS (A Calder) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ELECTRIC AURA (S Weatherley) – Underwent a post-race veterinary including an endoscopic examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 6	NZI/SWEENY TOWNSEND INSURANCE BROKERS LTD 1200
<p>SLOW HANDS (A Calder) – Crowded on jumping away losing ground.</p> <p>RITANI (D Johnson) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight then had to be steadied passing the 200 metres when placed in restricted room.</p>	

SAPPHIRE SKY (J Fawcett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

VEINE D'OR (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after becoming worked up pre-race and over racing in the middle stages the filly had failed to finish the race off. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

BEALE STREET (V Colgan) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after racing keenly in the middle stages the gelding had raced greenly in the final straight and failed to finish the race off. A post-race examination did not reveal any abnormality.
