| MIGHTY MAK – Late scratched on veterinary advice at 12.40pm after being injured enroute to course. | |
| COLOUR ME RED (J Lowry) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding the rider advised the horse had only battled fairly in today’s testing conditions. | |
| ROCKWITHME (R Firdhaus) - Keen early stages. Held up by tiring runner passing the 600 metres. | |
| BLACK EYED SUSAN (K Kwo) – Wide throughout and gave ground from 800 metres. | |
| ROYAL MISTRESS (T Jonker) - Lay inwards near the 900 metres and had to be straightened and continued to lay inwards for a distance thereafter. Hampered passing the 200 metres. | |
| FIVEWAYEIGHT (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room rounding the final bend and early in the run home when attempting a marginal run to the inside of TATUM. | |
| TATUM (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin. | |
| PAINTED ANGEL (K Mudhoo) - Got its head up in the early stages to take cover. | |
| MASTER COURTSMAN (J Laking) – Rider issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. | |
| Race 3 | PK KERBING LTD 1400M |
| Rescheduled to 1.47pm. | |
| GALWAY GARRY (B Murray) - Restrained to the rear on jumping. Held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres. | |
| WHAT’S UP ALF (K Kwo) – Reared as the start was effected and got back. Over raced passing the 1200 metres getting its head up on a number of occasions. Rider reported the gelding had not handled today’s testing heavy track conditions. | |
| EL BEE DARCI (K Williams) – Slow to begin. Lay inwards passing the 200 metres and brushed with MOYRABELLA. | |
| Race 4 | DR KANO’S VIRTUAL REALITY MAIDEN 1200M |
| Rescheduled to 2.17pm. | |
| MAH GIRL - Late scratching on veterinary advice 1.38pm. | |
| BOGATYR (R Mudhoo) – Bounded as the start was made and began awkwardly. Lay outwards in the run home shifting wider on the track. | |
| AMOUR LA VIE (C Barnes) – Slow to begin. | |
| NEVER QUITZ (R Firdhaus) – Wide throughout. | |
| SEKATIA (G Jogoo) - Briefly held up passing the 450 metres and then lay outwards rounding the final bend. Continued to lay out throughout the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage. | |
| OUR GOLDEN GIRL – Rider R Beeharry replaced declared rider Z Bholah who was unable to make the contract weight and was fined \$100 by the JCA under Rule 330(3)(c). Saddle slipped back passing the 800 metres placing the rider in difficulty for the remainder of the event. | |
| Race 5 | SPORTS BAR CENTRAL MAIDEN 1200M |
| Rescheduled to 2.47pm. | |
| LORD HERCULES (J Lowry) – Slow to begin. Had to be straightened near the 150 metres when laying inwards. | |

EUPHRASIA (G Saejorhor) – Slow to begin. Raced fiercely when being restrained to take cover in the early stages.

ROCKAPAN (C Barnes) – Lay outwards rounding the final bend.

VIOLETMARY (R Firdhaus) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

TALKABOUTME (K Kwo) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

TAP TAP (G Jogoo) - Steadied passing the 600 when held up by a tiring runner. Held up for several strides passing the 350 metres.

LO AZALEA (K Williams) - Rider reported the filly had not handled today's testing Heavy 11 track.

MY SOPRANO (T Moseley) – When spoken to regarding the improved performance trainer B Tapper advised that he had been surprised by the effort of the filly today and could offer no other explanation.

Race 6 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200M**

Rescheduled to 3.20pm.

ON POINT (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

IMELDAS GIRL (J Laking) – Slow to begin. Wide early.

MISS BRAHMOS (B Murray) – Slow to begin. Keen early stages.

TWILIGHT METEOR (R Mudhoo) - Lay out in the home straight shifting wider on the track.

DREAMING EASY (R Firdhaus) - Lay out over the concluding stages and had to be straightened passing the 50 metres.

Race 7 | **OAMARU LIQUORLAND MAIDEN 1600M**

Rescheduled to 3.48pm.

VILLERET (G Saejorhor) - Began awkwardly and shifted out abruptly crowding outside runners, with the rider becoming unbalanced when making contact with SEBRING'S DELIGHT.

SEBRING'S DELIGHT (K Kwo) - Crowded shortly after the start and lost ground.

HERCULES MORSE (R Beeharry) - Crowded shortly after the start and lost ground.

ADVENTURESS (J Morris) – Raced keenly early stages.

JANE AVRIL (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly and got back. Keen for a distance passing the 1400 metres. Held up passing 450 metres for a short distance and then lay out rounding final bend. Steadied at the 250 metres and shifted inwards to obtain clear running.

ELEGIDO (B Murray) - Wide throughout.

AL BE CIVICS (L Callaway) - Wide throughout.

MISS CATHERINE (K Williams) – Wide early. When spoken to regarding the performance the rider could offer no tangible explanation. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination of the mare which revealed no abnormalities.

EDEN ROSE (T Moseley) – Lay outwards when negotiating the crossing near the 1400 metres.

COOLIN ROO (K Mudhoo) - Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

Race 8 | **NORTHSTAR RESTAURANT AND BAR 1600M**

Rescheduled to 4.18pm.

PATRICIA ROSE (L Callaway) - Slow to begin. Began to over race passing the 1100 metres and had to be steadied off heels.

VAN GOGH (R Firdhaus) – Slow to begin. Over raced through the middle stages.

PAT IN BRACKETS (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly then raced wide throughout.

VERNA AUDREY (K Williams) - Jumped a mark on the track near the 1400 metres.

DOPPELGANGER (T Moseley) - Raced fiercely for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

OREPUKI LAD (J Lowry) - Made contact with SKEEN passing the 400 metres.

SKEEN (R Mudhoo) – Bumped and forced wider passing the 400 metres when OREPUKI LAD improved into a marginal run to the inside of SKEEN. J Lowry was advised he must exercise greater care.
