RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TASTE THE DALLY WINE HURDLE

CRUISEO (S Phelan) – Slow to begin. Hit the third to last fence then fell dislodging its rider who was uninjured. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations inside both nostrils.

COMMANDER (R Elliot) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Raced keenly early to middle stages.

JOEY JONZ (M Roustoby) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Hit the final fence.

BOSTON HAVOC (G Walsh) – Raced ungenerously approaching the fourth and fifth fence then continued to race keenly in the middle stages.

NORTH OF THE WALL (J Seivwright) – Knuckled on landing and fell after jumping the third to last fence dislodging rider J Seivwright who was stood down from his remaining rides. Lost left fore plate during the running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration inside the right nostril.

H McNeill (VIAAGO) – Admitted a breach of rule 647(1) in that he failed to weigh in following the race. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$250.

Race 2 WAIHOU TAVERN HURDLE

BURLING (M Roustoby) – Slow to begin then raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early to middle stages. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

CRIKEY CRON (L Douglas) - Steadied near the 2700 metres when in restricted room to the inside of LACUSTRE which was dictated in by MEDINI which shifted in despite the efforts of its rider.

CABALLO NOIR (B Lammas) – Pulled up prior to jumping the fourth to last fence. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a deep laceration to the left fore leg which required veterinary attention.

REVERSE TACTICS (S Higgins) – Hit the final fence losing ground.

Race 3 FRANK AND ANNIE MATIJASEVICH MEMORIAL HURDLE

HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) - Knuckled on landing after jumping the second to last fence.

CANDIDLY (A Roustoby) - Pulled up prior to jumping the last three fences.

LAEKEEPER (E Farr) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

DANZA LAD (S Higgins) - Raced keenly in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 2300 metres having to be further restrained. Misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres and fell. Rider S Higgins was uninjured. DANZA LAD was humanely euthanised after it was found to have fractured his right fore leg.

EL CORBY (G Walsh) – Hit the third to last fence and knuckled on landing.

Race 4 YELAVICH TRANSPORT LTD 2200

CARTAGENA (S Rennie) – Very slow to begin (5L). Trainer E Rennie was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the mare.

MAGNANIMOUS MAN (L Calitz) - Began awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Rider dropped her right rein passing the 200 metres and when attempting to re-gather that rein, veered out sharply.

FORT KNOX (B Rogerson) - Commenced to over-race when the pace steadied near the 1700 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels when racing ungenerously then shifted out abruptly. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Lost the left fore plate during the running.

BARB DWYER (J McIlroy) – Inconvenienced near the 300 metres by IN A MINUTE which lay out under pressure.

Race 5 JADRAN BASKETBALL TEAM 1000

IF WE MEET AGAIN (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

INITIATIVE (A Calder) – Contacted soon after leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced greenly throughout.

RIPNROLL (T Harris) – Raced in restricted room shortly after leaving the barriers.

JEWELKEEPER (R Smyth) – Awkwardly placed passing the 350 metres for a distance.

SHEEZ LEICA (S Rusof) – Rider dropped his whip approaching the 350 metres.

Race 6 STEVE LUNJEVICH CONTRACTING STEEPLECHASE

J'WALKE (L Douglas) - Slow to begin. Inconvenienced after jumping the third fence by the rider less horse. Misjudged the second to last fence and fell dislodging rider L Douglas who was stood down from his remaining ride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations in both nostrils.

BEVERLEY BECK (S Higgins) - Slow to begin.

BIG MEADSY (B Lammas) - Misjudged the second fence making contact with GAGARIN then blundered badly on landing dislodging rider B Lammas who was attended to by the on-course doctor and cleared for his remaining ride. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

PIONEER (H McNeill) – Eased down after jumping the final fence. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Due to the fallen rider at the second fence who had not sufficiently recovered to be moved, the field was directed onto the course proper along the back straight with jumps nine, ten and eleven not being used.

Race 7 VICTOR & FRANK MATIJASEVICH STEEPLECHASE

STAGEHAND (A Roustoby) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Jumped indifferently in the early stages. Hampered on jumping the second to last fence by KINGS KITE which shifted in, STAGEHAND then blundered badly on landing dislodging rider A Roustoby who was uninjured. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor skin abrasion on the right fore leg.

KINGS KITE (G Walsh) - Had to steady approaching the fourth jump when in restricted room.

I'VE GOT THIS (I Lupton) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor abrasion to the left hind fetlock.

ST D'ORE (S Higgins) - Knuckled on landing after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

T Moki - Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after failing to make the weight for STAGEHAND. L Douglas initially replaced T Moki before being replaced by A Roustoby due to injury.

Race 8 DAVE, FRED & MICHAEL LAURICH 1400

IN DREAMLAND (T Wenn) – Slow away.

THE HEIRESS (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance, rider could offer no excuse.

JOLLY ZAM (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after.

Race 9 KARL DAVIS BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1600

CANZAC (D Danis) - Slow to begin. Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 700 metres.

MR BAZAMOUR (S Collett) - Slow to begin.

MISTRESS (A Calder) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1400 metres.

BEACHED AS BRO (J Riddell) - Raced in restricted room passing the 1400 metres.

T Harris – Admitted a breach in that he used his whip excessively when riding THE GOOD FIGHT prior to the 100 metres. After viewing footage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended T Harris' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 30 June 2018 up to and including Friday 13 July 2018, 6 national riding days.

Race 10 MLAADI LAURICH (YOUNG LAURICH'S) 1600

INVERNESS (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

CONSPIRATOR (T Harris) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages.

ARITE GURU (R Scott) - Became awkwardly placed outside the heels of CONSPIRATOR over the final 50 metres.

A Sims - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.
