RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	DONAGHYS MAIDEN 1400m
<p>STROKE OF LUCK (W Pinn) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up entering the home straight when HANDSOME BLUE lay inwards then had to be angled outwards across heels to gain clear running near the 200 metres. Apprentice C Waddell was advised to exercise care. When questioned into the run rider advised that the gelding had raced keenly throughout and had little left at the finish.</p> <p>HANDSOME BLUE (C-M Waddell) - Lay inwards in the home straight.</p>	

ARIANA (Z Moki) – Slow away. Raced in restricted room from the 200 metres having to be angled inwards inside the final 100 metres to gain clear running and when doing so, tightened OUR CHARLI’S ANGEL. Z Moki was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

OUR CHARLI’S ANGEL (A Shin) - Tightened inside the 100 metres.

TWO EYE (S McKay) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up for a short distance near the 500 metres. Tightened and checked approaching the 50 metres when MR MUFITTT (M Tanaka) shifted inwards. M Tanaka admitted a subsequent breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) and had his licence to ride in races from the close of racing on 30 June up to and including 13 July – 7 days.

CASSINO TO TRIESTE (L Allpress) – When questioned into the performance L Allpress could offer no excuse.

T JOHNSON (QUAFF) – Was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) (ii) with respect to his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 2	NORWOOD MAIDEN 1200m

SHE’S GOT THE LOOK (S MacNab) - Awkwardly away settling back. Rider advised that she had been hit with a clod during the running and was examined by paramedics prior to being cleared to ride.

MY ZED (L Allpress) – Slow away. Briefly held up approaching the 400 metres. Lay out under pressure in the home straight.

BELLA PADOZA (M Singh) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SARDEEN (J Parkes) – Raced ungenerously for a short distance approaching the 900 metres getting its head in the air when being restrained.

OUR MILO (W Pinn) - Raced wide throughout.

Race 3	TASMAN TOYOTA 1200m

DRAGON DANCER (C Dell) – began awkwardly

YOU’LL DO ME (W Pinn) - slow away

HEINEKEN ROCKS (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously for a short distance near the 800 metres when being restrained.

CHESTER CARLSON (D Turner) - Briefly inconvenienced approaching the 150 metres when JUSTA SMALL RANSOM (R Hannam) lay in, in the home straight. R Hannam was advised to exercise care.

THATZ LOUIE (C-M Waddell) - Held up for a distance from the 400 metres gaining clear running entering the home straight.

Race 4	IPLEX MAIDEN 2200m

APEROL (T Allan) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages when the pace eased near the 1,400 metres.

VENERATE (J Nason) – slow away

BLACK ANASTA (D Turner) - began awkwardly settling back

OUR CHUCKY (S McKay) – bumped at start settling back

LHOTSE (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned into the performance rider could not offer any tangible excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Apprentice Jockey T Johnson (OUR MATRIARCH) admitted a charge under Rule 638 (1) (d) in that he allowed his mount to shift in approaching the 1,800 metres when not clear of RHETT BUTLER which clipped that runner’s heels and blundered. After submissions T Johnson had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 5 July up to and

including 14 July – 5 days.

HE NO OPILIO (W Pinn) - Raced keenly in the back straight and when being restrained off the heels of COG KNISH, shifted outwards contacting RHETT BUTLER on a number of occasions forcing that runner wider on the track. When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding had not appreciated today's slow track conditions.

Race 5	McMILLAN 2200M

AL MUNROE (R Hannam) – Awkwardly away settling back.

HAMILTONIAN (L Allpress) – Slow away, then raced keenly throughout, shifting out near the 1,900 metres contacting WAZUZU.

WAZUZU (R Myers) – contacted 1,900 metres

ZARTAN (M Singh) - Raced keenly for a short distance near the 1,400 metres so was allowed to improve forward to lead.

Race 6	NUFARM 1650M

SO IT WAS (A Shin) – Tightened when **ROYAL EMPRESS** jumped outwards at the start settling back.

ZEDABEL LASS (D Turner) – When questioned into the performance rider could offer no tangible excuse.

A Shin (SO IT WAS) – Rider was spoken to regarding the manner in which he used his whip over the final stages.

LECTIO DIVINIA (W Pinn) - slow away then raced keenly in the early stages

MAGIC IVAN (S McKay) – held up behind the tiring ALL IN LUCK approaching the 500 metres

ALL IN LUCK (S MacNab) – when questioned into the performance rider could offer no excuse
