Hawke's Bay Racing - 30 June 2018 Race 3 Te Whangai Romneys Hawke's Bay Hurdle (Prestige Jumping Race) ARITE GURU (C Studd) – Trainer J Williams advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.
Whangarei Racing Club - 29 June 2018 Race 1 Almanzor at Cambridge Stud (900 metres)

KEEP THE CASH (S Spratt) – Trainer K Rae advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 2 ITM/GIB Whangarei Gold Cup 30 June (1200 metres)

CLARA (V Colgan) – Trainer T Pike advised Stewards that the filly underwent a veterinary examination upon return to his stable which did not reveal any abnormality, adding it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TE AROHA STALLION PLACEMENT SCHEME HURDLE
<p>VIAAGO – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 7.55am.</p> <p>REVERSE TACTICS – Slow to begin, jumped indifferently throughout, retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten.</p> <p>BIG ‘N’ RICH (T Moki) – Jumped indifferently throughout, required veterinary treatment following the race for a laceration to the left foreleg.</p> <p>TRIUMPH (M Cropp) – Jumped indifferently throughout, retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten.</p> <p>DEFER (S Phelan) – Over-raced in the early stages, retired from the race prior to the final fence when well beaten, a post-race endoscopic examination found the gelding to be suffering from mild respiratory disease.</p> <p>SO KEEP EM (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Over-raced in the early stages shifting outwards to avoid heels near the 2800 metres hampering COUNTER ATTACK, ran down the third fence, poor jump at the fence passing the 1000 metres landing awkwardly.</p> <p>COUNTER ATTACK (W Gordon) – Hampered 2800 metres, jumped the third fence poorly.</p> <p>BOSTON HAVOC (G Walsh) – Jumped the final three fences poorly.</p> <p>RAY’S LEGACY (B Lammas) – Landed awkwardly after jumping second last fence when well back.</p> <p>SENASSY (M Roustoby) – Badly misjudged the final fence almost dislodging its rider, lost the right hind plate during the running and suffered superficial wounds to the right hind leg requiring veterinary treatment.</p> <p>E Farr (NEK MINNIT) – Fined \$250 after making a celebratory gesture prior to passing the winning post.</p>	
Race 2	PATRON PADDY’S HURDLE
<p>JOEY JONZ (M Roustoby) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SINO HEIGHTS (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Misjudged the fence near the 1400 metres dislodging its rider who was uninjured.</p> <p>RAISAFUASHO (W Gordon) – Returned to the enclosure showing signs of lameness with a post-race veterinary inspection revealing slight swelling of the medial fetlock joint in the right foreleg. A veterinary certificate of fitness is now required from RAISAFUASHO racing again.</p>	
Race 3	FLAIR AMATEUR RIDER SERIES 2200
<p>MASTER RICK (N Jensen) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p>	

BURLONE (C Isdale) – Hampered when crowded shortly after leaving the barriers, made the bend near the 1800 metres awkwardly.

BURLING (M Northcott) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

MISS SEQUOIA (B Rogerson) – Unbalanced when making contact with CABALLO NOIR near the 1700 metres.

C Isdale (BURLONE) – Fined \$250 by the Judicial Committee after admitting a charge in that he used the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.

Race 4	TE AROHA LIQUOR 2200
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J'WALKE (M Cropp) – Slow to begin (3L).

BANBURY LAD (S Higgins) – Hung outwards in the early stages rounding the first bend.

S Fannin (MASTER POET) – Suspended from the conclusion of racing today, Friday 6 July until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 4 August, 6 national jumping days, after admitting a charge in that he used the whip excessively prior to the 100 metres. In assessing penalty, the Judicial Committee found the breach to be in the high range along with this being S Fannin's third breach of the rule this jumping season.

S Phelan (IN A MINUTE) – Issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5	RACING TE AROHA SUPPORTERS CLUB STEEPLECHASE
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ISTIMAGIC (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence.

PIONEER (G Walsh) – Jumped indifferently throughout, retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten.

CRIKEY CRON (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Rider was dislodged jumping the seventh fence. M Gibbs-Manssen was transferred to hospital for further evaluation and treatment for a shoulder injury. Lost the right front plate during the running.

SIR AL SYD (A Roustoby) – Hampered by the rider less horse jumping the fence near the 1200 metres dislodging its rider who was uninjured.

MANDALAY (S Fannin) – Made contact with ZEDSATIONAL jumping the third last fence.

ZEDSATIONAL (A Kuru) – Bumped jumping third last fence.

Race 6	KNOTTINGLY FARM STEEPLECHASE
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NGATIRA GOLD (S Phelan) – Misjudged the third last fence and the final fence.

GAGARIN (S Fannin) – Badly misjudged final fence dislodging its rider who was uninjured.

Race 7	TE AROHA TRACTORS & MACHINERY (2015) LTD 1600
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BANKS ROAD (S Fannin) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

GUTSY GUSSIE (D Turner) – Began awkwardly before being further hampered when crowded.

W Gordon (COUNTRY BUMPKIN) – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when not fully clear of KANUMISS which had to be steadied near the 450 metres.

KANUMISS (J Riddell) – Steadied to avoid the heels of COUNTRY BUMPKIN near the 450 metres.

R Elliot (BEACHED AS BRO) – Spoken to regarding his whip action.

LUCKY TONIGHT (G Walsh) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

JIGSAW (J Nason) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MOOSE (W Gordon) – When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding may be better suited by more rain affected conditions.
