<b>Race 1</b>	<b>BIRTHDAY WISHES TODAY BRETT INGLIS HURDLES (3000m)</b>
<b>THE ENERGIZER</b> (M Cropp) – Slow away.	
<b>SOUTHERN AURORA</b> (C Studd) - Misjudged the first fence. Made a poor leap at the last fence losing ground.	
<b>SHEEZOFF</b> (H Bognuda) - Put in poor jumps at the first two fences, continued to jump indifferently throughout.	
<b>ADDITUP</b> (S O'Malley) - Hit the third fence.	
<b>JACKFROST</b> (S Higgins) - Poor jump at the fourth fence. Misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres.	

<b>DRUMGOLD</b> (G Walsh) – Poor jump at the second to last fence with the saddle shifting sideways disadvantaging its rider for the remainder of the race.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ONCEUPONATIME SPRINT (1200m)</b>
<p><b>SECRET POWER</b> (C Campbell) - Slow away.</p> <p><b>SOMETHINGS BURNING</b> (J Anderson) - Steadied to avoid heels approaching the 800 metres. Angled wider on the track passing the 300 metres to find clear racing room.</p> <p><b>DRESSED TOKILL</b> (L Callaway) - Shifted in when struck with the whip making contact with the running rail twice over the concluding stages.</p> <p><b>L Callaway</b> – Spoken to in regard to his whip use in the final straight.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES MAIDEN DASH (1200m)</b>
<p><b>SILHOUETTES</b> (C Campbell) - Bounded at the start then crowded shortly after and lost ground. Held up for several strides passing the 300 metres and held up again passing the 125 metres when ROCKAPAN shifted ground outwards at this point.</p> <p><b>SHOW CLOUD</b> (K Williams) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SO NATURAL</b> (B Morgenrood) - Began awkwardly. Crowded shortly after the start and lost ground.</p> <p><b>IZALLOYD</b> (T Jonker) - Lay inwards shortly after the start crowding FOLLOW THE STARS, SO NATURAL and SILHOUETTES who all lost ground.</p> <p><b>FOLLOW THE STARS</b> (S Collett) - Crowded shortly after the start and lost ground. Crowded and checked at the 950 metres.</p> <p><b>K Kwo</b> - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount TAKE ME THERE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of FOLLOW THE STARS near the 950 metres. After viewing films and hearing submissions on penalty the JCA suspended his licence to ride in races for 6 National days up to and including 26<sup>th</sup> July 2018.</p> <p><b>K Mudhoo</b> (MAH GIRL) - Was issued with a warning when allowing his mount to shift in passing the 900 metres and bumped with MAKES LEGEND who was forced inwards crowding ROCKAPAN which had to steady.</p> <p><b>ROCKAPAN</b> (M McNelis) – Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>MAKES LEGEND</b> (J Morris) – Bumped at the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>ALEX</b> (L Callaway) - Wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SANSA STARK</b> (T Comignaghi) – Lay outwards over the concluding stages and could not be ridden to full advantage.</p> <p><b>UBETIAM</b> (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout. When asked to comment regarding the performance of his mount, C Johnson could offer no tangible reason.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>JO MCGARTLAND MEMORIAL STEEPLECHASE (4280m)</b>
<p><b>SPEEDY JAX</b> (C Studd) – Began awkwardly. Jumped the last fence awkwardly.</p> <p><b>POINT PROVEN</b> (M Cropp) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Retired from the race prior to the second to last fence. Rider M Cropp reported that the gelding had mixed his jumping and also believed that he is better suited to tracks with more moisture in them.</p> <p><b>GOLD LEAF</b> (G Walsh) – Ran down the second to last fence.</p> <p><b>JUSTNAMETHEPRICE</b> (S O’Malley) – Retired from the race prior to the second to last fence when under pressure.</p> <p><b>IRISH DUDE</b> (H Bognuda) - Misjudged the second to last fence and landed awkwardly dislodging its rider who was uninjured. A post-race Veterinary inspection of IRISH DUDE revealed no obvious abnormalities.</p>	

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1200m)</b>
<p><b>PER FORM</b> (K Kwo) – Restrained to the rear on jumping.</p> <p><b>SITARIST</b> (G Jogoo) - Rider dropped rein passing the 150 metres with his mount shifting inwards at this point.</p> <p><b>SUGGESTIVE LOOX</b> (K Williams) - Steadied at the 100 metres when crowded for room by SITARIST.</p> <p><b>SARONIC MISS</b> (BB Hong) - Was taken in by ALL DRESSED UP and became awkwardly placed on the heels of STUMBLIN IN passing the 100 metres. Then had to be shifted outwards to find clear racing room inconveniencing ALL DRESSED UP in the shadows of the post.</p> <p><b>ALL DRESSED UP</b> (K Mudhoo) - Inconvenienced in the shadows of the post.</p> <p><b>TWILIGHT METEOR</b> (R Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>NIGHT 'N DAY PARK MILE (1600m)</b>
<p><b>ANDARTA</b> (S Jamie) – Very slow to begin.</p> <p><b>AMUN RA</b> (K Kwo) - Raced keenly early stages, then held up for several strides passing the 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>AGRICOM (1600m)</b>
<p><b>PAT IN BRACKETS</b> (S Toolooa) - Hampered at the start. Badly hampered near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>BUSHIDO</b> (C Johnson) - Went amiss when racing free of interference near the 900 metres. After being attended to by the Veterinarian BUSHIDO was found to have suffered a fracture to the left foreleg necessitating it to be humanly euthanized. Badly hampered as a result was DEEBEE BLACK, which when having to take evasive action clipped a heel and blundered. PAT IN BRACKETS and ABRAXOS were also badly hampered in this incident. Rider C Johnson was uninjured.</p> <p><b>DEEBEE BLACK</b> (K Kwo) - Over-raced badly in the early to middle stages, clipped heel and blundered when severely hampered near the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>TENFOLD</b> (K Williams) - Held up near the 300 metres then being hampered having to steady to avoid the heels of SKEEN near the 225 metres, held up over the final 50 metres.</p> <p><b>R Mudhoo</b> (SKEEN) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards under pressure when not fully clear of TENFOLD, which had to be steadied near the 225 metres, continuing to shift outwards hampering CHICA RAPIDA and ABRAXOS passing the 175 metres.</p> <p><b>ABRAXOS</b> (M McNelis) - Badly hampered near the 900 metres. Hampered again passing the 175 metres. Rider reported that the mare had felt to have pulled up sore with a post-race Veterinary examination revealing some minor muscle soreness.</p> <p><b>VILLERET</b> (G Saejorhor) – Rider dropped whip passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>CHICA RAPIDA</b> (C Campbell) - Hampered passing the 175 metres.</p> <p><b>KNIGHT'S PRINCESS</b> (T Comignaghi) - Wide without cover throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>CENTRAL SI OWNERS &amp; TRAINERS ASSN MAIDEN (1600m)</b>
<p><b>DUNDEE FLAG</b> (C Campbell) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>STEELE CANYON</b> (G Saejorhor) – Slow away.</p> <p><b>COURTS KING</b> (E Wright) – Crowded leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p><b>ELEGIDO</b> (S Collett) – Wide without cover after over racing in the early to middle stages.</p>	

**MAHANA** (C Johnson) – Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

**K Gundowry** (AL BE CIVICS) – Rider spoken to advisedly about the use of his whip and to ensure he rides his mount out fully to the finish.

**EDEN ROSE** (B B Hong) – Lost the right front plate during the running.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>MORE FM STAYERS MAIDEN (2100m)</b>

This race ran approximately 4 minutes late due to the bridle having to be replaced on ROYAL MISTRESS.

**M McNelis** (POWER PUNCH) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 619 in that he added gear after weighing out.

**SWIG** (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly.

**LATASSO** (S Toolooa) – Shifted outwards leaving the barriers hampering ON THE SAUCE, JILDI JILDI and FLAGS A FLYING. Raced three wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.

**FLAGS A FLYING** (J Anderson) – Hampered at the start. Angled inwards over the concluding stages. Apprentice Jockey J Anderson along with Apprentice Jockey Mentor D Walsh was shown a replay of this incident for educational purposes.

**JILDI JILDI** (S Collett) – Hampered at the start.

**ONTHE SAUCE** (C Campbell) – Hampered at the start. Finished a distant last. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Connections advised the gelding will be now retired as a racing proposition from their stable.

**WENTWORTH** (L Callaway) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**BABY MENAKA** (E Wright) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained going into the first turn near the 1800 metres.

**LIVE IN HOPE** (T Comignaghi) – Placed in restricted room passing the 900 metres, when ICEBERG ROCK lay in at this point. Briefly steadied passing the 175 metres when FLAGS A FLYING angled inwards at this point.
