RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TANK ELLIS, ALLAN BECK AND MATTY WILLIAMSON (2200m)
SULCIFERA (W Pinn) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was cleared to race after dislodging its rider at the start area. W Pinn was cleared by St John to take his ride.	
MINUE (J Morris) - Proved difficult to get near the barrier pre-race and was eventually late scratched at 11.38 am with the connections advised that the mare must barrier trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to racing next.	
SOUTHERN COOL (T Moseley) - Wide early stages.	
SHE'STOOHOTTOTROT (T Jonker) - Wide middle stages.	
BABAN (T Comignaghi) – Awkward making the first bend.	
OUR MADONNA (K Williams) – Awkward making the first bend shifting wider on the track. Held up for a distance passing	

the 500 metres. Rider dropped whip at 200 metres.

SIR ED (C Campbell) – Crowded shortly after the start and got back as a result. Improved wide from 1000 metres.

REDESDALE (J Fawcett) – Held up early the home straight and then momentarily placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

FRANCONI (BB Hong) - Over raced in the middle stages and had to be restrained off heels passing the 1200 when the pace of the race steadied.

Race 2 | **RITEWAY PAINT AND PANEL (2200m)**

SMILING ASSASSIN (C Johnson) - Over raced early stages and got its head up on a number of occasions. Keen for some distance passing the 1500 metres having to be heavily restrained off heels.

HOU LA LA (J Morris) - Began awkwardly and lost ground. Lay out in the final straight.

LADY BEALEY (T Jonker) - Wide throughout.

Race 3 | **PETER AND DAWN WILLIAMS/JOLLY HACKS LODGE (1200m)**

EXPRESS RIP (S Muniandy) - Keen early stages.

CORONITA (W Pinn) – Buffeted between runners as the start was affected and got back as a result.

REMEDY (K Mudhoo) – Slow to begin.

ANNE (S Toolooa) - Got its head up when being steadied near the 900 metres and raced greenly for a distance thereafter.

SABRAGE (BB Hong) – Over raced in the early stages and passing the 700 metres contacted the heel of the runner in front resulting in the rider being badly unbalanced and losing the use of his irons for the remainder of the race. Shifted out to avoid heels passing the 500 metres inconveniencing MISS MAXIPARK. Apprentice jockey BB Hong along with the Apprentice Jockey Mentor was shown a replay of this incident for educational purposes.

MISS MAXIPARK (C Johnson) – Inconvenienced at the 500 metres and dictated wider on the track for several strides.

CARNOUSTIE (K Williams) – Forced wide final turn.

PARIS AWAITS (L Callaway) – Forced wide final turn.

Race 4 | **GLENMOA FARMS LTD WAITAKI RIVER TROPHY (1200m)**

SECRET POWER (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.

SABER (J Morris) – Keen while leading.

SOMETHINGS BURNING (C Johnson) - Raced fiercely early to middle stages and had to shift out to avoid heels passing the 500 metres forcing BALLYBAY and WIZE ACT wider on the track at this point.

BALLYBAY (J Fawcett) - Over raced throughout. Had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1000 metres. Forced wider 500 metres.

WIZE ACT (K Williams) – Forced wider on the track at 500 metres. When asked to comment on today’s performance the rider advised that she had been trapped wide for the majority of the race and even wider on the home turn with the mare being better suited to being held up for one run.

L Callaway (EPIC DREAMER) – Issued with a warning after shifting ground passing the 1000 metres resulting in BALLYBAY being crowded and having to steady.

DRESSED TOKILL (T Jonker) – Wide without cover throughout.

DYNAMIC (BB Hong) - Steadied momentarily passing the 50 metres when placed in restricted room. Placed in restricted

room in the shadows of the post when EPIC DREAMER lay out under pressure.

EPIC DREAMER (L Callaway) – Lay out under pressure passing the 50 metres.

Following the running of this race the track conditions were upgraded to Slow 8.

Race 5 | **MOKE APPAREL LTD MAIDEN (1400m)**

BELLISSIMA BELLE (B Morgenrood) - Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

POETIC (W Pinn) – Gave ground from the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

ROCKAPAN (C Barnes) - Lay out passing the 1300 metres resulting in crowding to outside runners.

LET HER RIP RILEY (C Johnson) – Crowded passing the 1300 metres and had to be momentarily steadied then raced keenly in the early stages.

PLATINUM RAIDER (K Asano) – Wide throughout.

SANSA STARK (T Comignaghi) – Awkwardly placed between runners and held up for a short distance entering the home straight. Lay outwards over the concluding stages with the rider advising that the bit had displaced through the mare's mouth.

JANE AVRIL (G Jogoo) – When asked to comment about the improved performance co-trainer J Parsons advised that mare had appreciated today's better track conditions and had also found the 1400 metres to be to her liking.

Race 6 | **BRACKENS PRINT MAIDEN (1400m)**

WILKIE GEORGE (C Barnes) – Buffeted between runners at the start and lost ground.

BET YA WOOD (J Lowry) – Buffeted between runners at the start and got back. Made the first bend awkwardly and got its head up for several strides.

SEKATIA (G Jogoo) - Lay out across heels passing the 900 metres and had to be restrained. The rider reported the gelding had lay outwards throughout the running.

SHE'LL CAT CHOUX (C Campbell) – Crowded at the start and got back. Over raced for a short distance passing the 1300 metres and got its head up when being restrained.

TUSSOCK (T Comignaghi) – Shifted in abruptly at the start crowding inside runners and then bumped with BET YA WOOD momentarily unbalancing rider. Wide throughout.

THE SAINTLY ONE (L Callaway) – Shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip and had to be straightened passing the 250 metres.

CHOWDER (W Pinn) - Placed in restricted room and had to steady passing the 1000 metres when TO SIR WITH LOVE shifted in.

T Jonker (TO SIR WITH LOVE) - Issued with a warning when allowing her mount to shift inwards passing the 1000 metres crowding CHOWDER who had to steady.

Race 7 | **MCKEOWN GROUP (1400m)**

GOLD'NGURU (J Fawcett) – Keen early stages.

ELUSIVE BOXERS (K Williams) - Wide throughout.

TAIERI GEM (C Campbell) - Wide throughout. Crowded and had to be steadied at the 150 metres when ISHINKTAALEDO lay in at this point with the trailing BORN A ROYAL having to be steadied.

WISE MOVE (J Morris) - Slow to begin.

ISHINKTAATLEDO (W Pinn) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room passing the 500 metres and shifted out at the 400 metres to obtain clear running. Lay in passing the 250 metres and had to be straightened continued to shift inwards over the concluding stages and bumped with inside runner.

BORN A ROYAL (J Lowry) – Had to steady at 150 metres.

NOWHERE MAN (BB Hong) - When asked to comment on the performance of the favoured runner the rider advised that from the good draw he was positioned more forward than normal and in his opinion the gelding is better when ridden further back in the field.

RIDEITLIKEUSTOLEIT (T Comignaghi) – Lay out over the concluding stages and bumped with ISHINKTAATLEDO in the shadow of the post when both runners shifted ground. When questioned about the improved performance trainer P Collins advised that the mare had appreciated today's better track conditions.

MILK IT (C Johnson) – When spoken to regarding the performance of the favoured runner the rider advised that in his opinion the gelding was less than genuine in its efforts today and he could offer no tangible excuse.

NAKYAMA (S Toolooa) - Held up early in the run home and had to change ground inwards passing the 175 metres to find clear racing room.

Race 8 | **CROMBIE & PRICE OAMARU CUP (1600m)**

S Muniandy - Admitted a breach of Rule 330 (3)(c) in that he failed to make the contract weight for FINBARR and was replaced as per schedule above. The JCA imposed a fine of \$100.

STOKERS ROCK (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

TIMY TYLER (J Morris) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Crowded and had to be steadied passing the 125 metres.

LUKE (K Gundowry) - Held up early in the run home and then again at the 150 metres only gaining clear racing inside the final 100 metres.

ZAWHIP (J Fawcett) - Knuckled at the start.

FINBARR (L Callaway) – Wide throughout.

THE GORDONIAN (K Mudhoo) - Shifted out and away from STOKERS ROCK who had improved quickly to the geldings inside crowding TIMY TYLER who had to be steadied passing the 125 metres.

Race 9 | **OAMARU LICENSING TRUST (1400m)**

WHISKEY IN THE JAR (J Morris) – Slow to begin.

SHOWPIN (K Williams) – Very slow to begin.

DUTCH COURAGE (K Mudhoo) – Raced keenly.

BRIDGET TOWN (J Fawcett) – Bounded at the start.

JUMEIRAH (T Jonker) – Began awkwardly.

ROC LEONE (C Barnes) – Wide throughout.

SITARIST (G Jogoo) - Crowded then had to steady skying its head near the 900 metres when JULIETTE who was over racing had to be steadied in and away from the heels of TAPONISME (C Johnson) who shifted in marginally at this point. After interviewing riders and reviewing replays it was established that SITARIST had over reacted when asked to steady. Stewards took the matter no further than to advise Mr Johnson to ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground.

MONTERRAT (C Campbell) – Held up from the 300 metres until the 200 metres for clear racing room. Raced in restricted room concluding stages.
