Race 1	BDO ROTORUA 1600
<p>OR BLANCHE (R Scott) – Late scratching at 12.36pm after rearing over backwards when being loaded in to its barrier stall with apprentice rider R Scott being transferred to hospital for further evaluation. OR BLANCHE is required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>PRETTY LION (A Sims) – Began awkwardly then crowded.</p> <p>HUNUA HANK (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>EL COOLIO (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Steadied 300 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>MASKOBI PEARL (T Newman) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres before shifting outwards to avoid heels approaching the 900 meters forcing ACRE wider. Crowded 300 metres briefly steadied.</p> <p>ACRE (T Harris) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>T Harris (ACRE) - Issued with a warning after allowing ACRE to shift in passing the 300 metres crowding MASKOBI PEARL and JOLLY ZAM which were both briefly steadied.</p> <p>JOLLY ZAM (T Yanagida) - Crowded 300 metres and briefly steadied.</p>	
Race 2	THE MEAT CO, ROBOW'S TWOTONES 1600
<p>PRINCESS RAAJ (A Sims) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>DELUXE EDITION (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>AVEC MOI (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ST SATURNIN (J Nason) - Steadied 1500 metres when briefly crowded.</p> <p>EENY MEENY MINY MO (T Newman) – Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>SECONDS OUT (D Danis) - Steadied 300 metres when awkwardly placed.</p> <p>DIEHARD (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider M Coleman advised the horse may have not been suited by the existing track conditions.</p>

<p>MI PIACI (A Sims) - Began awkwardly losing ground</p> <p>GOOD VIBES (L Satherley) – Anticipated the start, forcing its barrier to open marginally prior to the start being effected. Prior to confirming the result Stewards established that GOOD VIBES had not gained any advantage.</p> <p>T Newman (IMBLAZE) - Issued with a warning for using her whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 5	MATAMATA HIRE CENTRE 1200
<p>SHEEZNOTEASY (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly then shifted out crowding CHOUX LACE which clipped a heel and blundered.</p> <p>CHOUX LACE (E McCall) – Crowded shortly after the start clipping a heel then blundered.</p>	

<p>MY CLARITY (A Sims) - Began awkwardly making contact. Made the bend awkwardly approaching the 800 metres when shifting out to avoid heels, inconveniencing SUSPENSE which was forced wider on the track.</p> <p>SUSPENSE (T Thornton) - Forced wider on the track 800 metres.</p> <p>LOWRIDER (R Smyth) - Contacted leaving the barrier. Crowded over the final 50 metres and steadied.</p> <p>AMEN CORNER (J Fawcett) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>CLARIOS (M Coleman) – Made the turn approaching the 800 metres awkwardly shifting out across heels. Steadied approaching the 250 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels and then shifted in to obtain clear running.</p> <p>PACO LAD (J Riddell) - Crowded over the final 50 metres and steadied, when improving into a marginal run to the inside of SHEEZNOTEASY which shifted in slightly.</p>	
Race 6	COLIN WEST PANELBEATERS 1200
<p>ROUGH CONDUCT (B Grylls) - Over raced early and middle stages.</p> <p>SIMPLY IMPECCABLE (M Coleman) – Not persevered with from near the 200 metres after failing to respond when placed under pressure. Rider M Coleman advised that the gelding had felt to have choked down making abnormal noises. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 7	NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY 2000
<p>ROCKING GOOD TIME (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>R Elliot (DEFER) - Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 8	FAIRVIEW MOTORS 2000
<p>RAY'S LEGACY (R Elliot) – Became tailed off and was not persevered with from near the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>HORSEY HORSE HORSE (R Novall) – Crowded shortly after the start.</p> <p>TWIN SPINNER (G Cooksley) – Began awkwardly. Crowded and steadied passing the 150 metres.</p> <p>J Waddell (LOTHBROK) - Issued with a warning after allowing LOTHBROK to shift in passing the 150 metres when insufficiently clear of TWIN SPINNER which was crowded and steadied with Stewards taking into account outward movement from CASSIO.</p> <p>C Lammas (CASSIO) – Issued with a warning for using his whip excessively prior to 100 metres.</p>
