RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MORE FM DASH MAIDEN (1200m)
BRONNY'S LAD (C Barnes) – Slow to begin.	
REMARKABLE KATE (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.	

ODALISQUE (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly, held up for several strides passing the 200 metres and had to shift ground outwards to find clear racing room.

MAH GIRL (K Mudhoo) – Lay in passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened, continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.

INDULGENT (B Grylls) – Raced wide without cover in the early stages. When spoken to regarding performance the rider could offer no tangible excuses and was disappointed with the effort. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

MIACOCA (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

MAKS LEGEND (J Morris) – Raced keenly in the early stages and wide without cover throughout, steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of UBETIAM which shifted out under pressure passing the 300 metres.

SILHOUETTES (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

JEPEZZ GEORGE (J Lowry) – Lay in throughout the run home and had to be straightened passing the 150 metres and continued to shift ground inwards over the concluding stages.

SHOW ‘N’ GO (T Jonker) – Clipped a heel of the runner in front and blundered momentarily passing the 900 metres.

UBETIAM (T Comignaghi) – Shifted out under pressure passing the 300 metres, dictated inwards over the concluding stages by JEPEZZ GEORGE.

SECRET STASH (B Grylls) – Slow to begin.

ST REGIS (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

NAKYAMA (S Toolooa) – Raced wide from the 800 metres.

Race 4	CENTRAL SI OWNERS & TRAINERS ASSN 1200 (1200m)

SO NATURAL (B Morgenrood) – Began awkwardly and lost ground, over raced in the early stages.

FLICKA OF GOLD (Z Bholah) – Restrained to the rear on jumping, held up over the last 50 metres.

HEBERITE (J Lowry) – Bounded at the start.

DREAMING EASY (C Campbell) – Raced wide without cover throughout, shifted in when struck with the whip passing the 300 metres and had to be straightened.

SUGGESTIVE LOOX (K Williams) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.

THE BUMPER (K Mudhoo) – Had to be restrained when improving quickly onto the heels of DREAMING EASY passing the 100 metres.

MIRA (C Johnson) – Held up for some distance passing the 200 metres, raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

GREY GHOST (T Comignaghi) – Placed in restricted room passing the 175 metres when LADY ROSSA (B Grylls) shifted in under pressure. B Grylls was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 5	ONCEUPONATIME MILE (1600m)

TUILANA (C Johnson) – Slow into stride.

STUMBLIN IN (J Fawcett) – Raced keenly while leading in the early stages.

J Fawcett (STUMBLIN IN) was issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards shortly after the start when not fully clear hampering RICH HABIT and AMUN RA which both had to be steadied.

RICH HABIT (K Mudhoo) – Steadied to avoid heels shortly after the start, made the first bend awkwardly shifting wider on the track.

AMUN RA (T Moseley) – Steadied to avoid heels shortly after the start.

Race 6	SHAWEIGH MAIDEN (1600m)

Trainer **T Rae** was issued with a warning for presenting HATRICK BOYS without the notified side winkers.

DUNDEE FLAG (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

MOWENNA (E Wright) – Slow to begin, raced wide without cover throughout.

SHE'S FUN (T Comignaghi) – Lay out over the concluding stages and had to be straightened on at least two occasions.

WENTWORTH (L Callaway) – Over raced for a distance passing the 1300 metres and continued to over race through the middle stages, crowded and checked passing the 500 metres.

K Asano (JIMMY VITAL) was issued with a warning for shifting ground at the 500 metres after he had to check out of a marginal run and when doing so shifted out abruptly crowding and checking WENTWORTH. K Asano was shown replays of this incident with the apprentice jockey mentor for educational purposes.

Following the running of this race the connections of the second place horse HATRICK BOYS viewed replays of the concluding stages-before deciding not to proceed with a protest.

JILDI JILDI (J Fawcett) – Slow to begin, raced wide for the remainder of the race.

PAINTED ANGEL (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly shifting out and crowding ICEBERG ROCK which lost ground.

ICEBERG ROCK (B Morgenrood) – Crowded at the start and lost ground.

WILKIE GEORGE (T Moseley) – Over raced in the early stages getting its head up when being restrained to take a trailing position.

QUEEN EL JAY (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early stages and made the first bend awkwardly, raced wide for the majority of the race.

MAMMA SANS (T Comignaghi) – Lay out over the concluding stages and had to be straightened.

PAT IN BRACKETS (S Toolooa) – Slow into stride.

CROYDE (C Johnson) – Raced wide into the first bend.

JOBY (K Asano) – Raced wide throughout.

KNIGHT'S PRINCESS (T Comignaghi) – Over raced through the early to middle stages, held up rounding the final bend and had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

GIPSYROCKER (B Grylls) – Held up rounding the final bend.

ZENTESEA (J Lowry) – Bumped and unbalanced passing the 300 metres when ADVENT shifted out, continued to shift ground inwards and had to be straightened passing the 175 metres.

ADVENT (T Jonker) – Bumped and unbalanced passing the 300 metres when ZENTESEA shifted in.

<p>SOUTHERN AURORA (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>METASEQUOIA (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ADDITUP (C Barnes) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>DOCTOR EDEN (L Callaway) – Raced keenly through the middle stages. Shifted out under pressure at 250 metres. Dictated wider on track at 200 metres by inside runner.</p> <p>SKEEN (R Mudhoo) – Had to be steadied off heels of the runner in front passing the 1200 metres when racing keenly, held up rounding the final bend clipping a heel of the runner in front and blundering momentarily, lay outwards in the run home and had to be straightened at 300 metres. Continued to lay out and shifted ground outwards throughout the run home.</p> <p>R Mudhoo (SKEEN) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres contacting and forcing DOCTOR EDN wider on the track.</p> <p>MADAME LIBRE (BB Hong) – Over raced passing the 1100 metres shifting out and raced wide from this point. Shifted ground inwards passing 300 metres under pressure.</p> <p>ROYAL MISTRESS (T Jonker) – Held up rounding the final bend and had to be severely restrained passing the 250 metres when disappointed for a run between MADAME LIBRE (BB Hong) and DOCTOR EDEN (L Callaway) which both shifted ground. Riders BB Hong and L Callaway were advised to exercise greater care. Again held up passing the 200 metres having to shift ground inwards across heels to find clear racing room.</p>
