GENERAL:

D Turner, T Johnson and M McNelis all did not attend the meeting after advising that they were unwell and are required to provide medical clearances prior to riding next.
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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Hawke's Bay Hunt Maiden Hurdle
CULLISTER (D Jensen) - Slow away.	

SOIREE (S Higgins) - Began awkwardly, raced keenly for a distance passing the 1800 metres having to be heavily restrained when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of NORTH OF THE WALL near the 1600 metres, steadied after improving onto the heels of the weakening RIGHT SAID FRED passing the 700 metres, put in poor jumps at the final two fences.

NORTH OF THE WALL (M Gibbs-Manssen) - Hit the fence near the 2000 metres unbalancing its rider.

I'M BRONSON (G Walsh) - Hit the fence near the 1000 metres, badly misjudged the fence near the 600 metres and blundered dislodging its rider who was uninjured.

RIGHT SAID FRED (M Roustoby) - Hung throughout and raced ungenerously, hit the fence near the 1200 metres, hampered by the fallen runner at the fence near the 600 metres and was then not persevered with when well beaten, being retired from the race.

Race 2	Bay Ford NZ Punter Of The Year October 6 Maiden Hurdle
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BIGREDMOON (D Jensen) - Raced keenly in the early stages before being allowed to improve forward wide.

MESMERIZE (I Lupton) - Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages, put in a poor jump at the final fence.

RAISEDINASANDOPIT (E Farr) - Jumped the fence near the 2000 metres awkwardly.

ZEDSATIONAL (S Higgins) - Hit the second last fence.

ONEFORTHE DITCH (S Fannin) - Was not persevered with in the final straight when out of contention. When questioned, rider advised the mare was making an abnormal breathing noise and may have go its tongue over the bit and choked down. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

M Gibbs-Manssen - Spoken to regarding his whip use over the final stages when out of contention.

Race 3	Te Whangai Romneys Hawke's Bay Hurdle (Prestige Jumping Race)
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WEE BISKIT (B Lammas) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages, retired from the race prior to the second last fence when well beaten.

S Fannin - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount GUY FOX to shift inwards near the 1700 metres when not sufficiently clear of NO CHANGE which had to be restrained to avoid that runners heels.

NO CHANGE (A Kuru) - Restrained to avoid heels near the 1700 metres.

ARITE GURU (C Studd) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 1050 metres and fell badly hampering EL CORBY which dislodged its rider. Both horses and riders were uninjured.

EL CORBY (G Walsh) - Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1050 metres dislodging its rider.

HESALLJAZZ (S Higgins) - Badly misjudged the fence near the 950 metres blundering badly and dislodged its rider also making contact with the hind quarters of IT'S A WONDER. After being attended to by ambulance personnel S Higgins was found to be uninjured.

IT'S A WONDER (W Gordon) - Unbalanced when hind quarters were contacted after jumping the fence near the 950 metres.

KIPKEINO (E Farr) - Placed in restricted room close to the finish when TOMMYRA (H McNeill) lay in under pressure before being corrected by its rider. H McNeill was advised to exercise more care.

<p>ZED LEPELIN (H Cushing) - Jumped inwards at the start contacting FIRENZE.</p> <p>FIRENZE (M Browne) - Contacted at start, inconvenienced near the 700 metres when DELEGATE shifted outwards.</p> <p>WAGNER (C Isdale) - Began awkwardly settling back, hampered 800 metres.</p> <p>NAPOLEON (C McLean) - Slow away.</p> <p>SENASSY (J McIlroy) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages when being restrained.</p> <p>KIDDO (C Myers) - Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>DELEGATE (J Lupton) - Raced in restricted room going into the 800 metre turn and when being steadied shifted inwards hampering WAGNER, shifted outwards across heels to improve near the 700 metres.</p> <p>M Browne - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 5	Taradale Club 2100
<p>CALL ME ROYAL (R Jones) - Crowded start losing ground when WOODSMAN shifted outwards forcing HAND IT TO JONESY outwards onto CALL ME ROYAL and LOVETOKEEPHIM.</p> <p>HAND IT TO JONESY (W Pinn) - Over-raced for a distance passing the 1200 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p>TRISHA LEA (M Singh) - Lay out under pressure near the 250 metres having to be straightened and again near the 150 metres.</p>	
Race 6	Just A Swagger HB Hunt Maiden Chase
<p>TRIUMPH - Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 11.30am after suffering an injury when being transported to the race meeting.</p> <p>TELL ME MORE (H Bognuda) - Slow away, misjudged the fence near the 800 metres.</p> <p>OLD COUNTESS (B Lammas) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>MY MAGICIAN (C Studd) - Ran down a number of fences throughout.</p> <p>ZEDACE (S Phelan) - Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1400 metres, retired from the race prior to jumping the final fence when tailed off.</p> <p>ZAMORA (A Kuru) - Rider lost irons near the 30 metres becoming unbalanced.</p>	
Race 7	Simon's 50th Birthday Hawke's Bay Steeplechase (Prestige Jumping Race)
SHAMAL (H McNeill) - Misjudged the 5 th fence blundering on landing and dislodging its rider. With H McNeill unable to be moved while being attended to by ambulance personnel the field were directed inside the fence near the 500 metres on the next two circuits. H McNeill was transferred to hospital for further evaluation/treatment for a suspected fracture of the right collarbone/shoulder.	

THENAMEBOND (S Higgins) - Hampered in the approach to the 6th fence by the riderless horse.

STAGEHAND (A Kuru) - Put in a poor jump at the 6th fence, misjudged the fence near the 800 metres on the final occasion dislodging its rider who was uninjured.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (B Lammas) - Retired from the race prior to the final fence when well beaten.

KING DEEP (E Farr) - Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres between JUSTA CHARLIE and WISE MEN SAY which both shifted ground.

Race 8	Stella Artois 1400
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DIVINE PRINCESS (C O'Beirne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

OHTHOSERUSSIANS (S McKay) - Began awkwardly.

AQUA HOUSE (H Durrant) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE WHITE QUEEN (J Parkes) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

STEVIES SURPRISE (A Sims) - Raced wide without cover.

GLIMPSE (M Tanaka) - Raced three wide without cover.

ENUFF TALK (D Hirini) - Raced greenly approaching the 700 metres losing ground.

TED TALKS (S MacNab) - Briefly steadied near the 600 metres when FOILING shifted out when not fully clear. W Pinn was advised to exercise more care.

Race 9	Animal Health Direct 1400
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ALMO STREET (R Hannam) - Refused to leave the barriers with the remainder of the field losing considerable ground and its chance in the race. The stable representative was advised that ALMO STREET is now required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward on multiple occasions prior to being able to race again.

RED SIERRA (C O'Beirne) - Jumped away awkwardly.

TURNCOAT (W Pinn) - Lay in near the 600 metres becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of STRAIGHT SETS, unable to obtain clear running over the final 250 metres.

L Allpress - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount PETITE EN JEU to shift inwards under pressure when not fully clear of STRAIGHT SETS which had to be steadied near the 250 metres.

STRAIGHT SETS (R Elliot) - Steadied to avoid the heels of PETITE EN JEU near the 250 metres.

R Elliot - Issued with a warning for his use of the whip prior to the 100 metres.

Race 10	"Stockies" Day July 19 1400
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VERACIOUS (C O'Beirne) - Slow away.

RICKY BAKER (T Yanagida) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1200 metres to the outside of TURFSHAKER which when over-racing then lay outwards crowding RICKY BAKER which had to be steadied approaching the 1000 metres.

FIELD OF FIRE (W Pinn) - Inclined to over-race in the middle stages, when questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the gelding was not suited by today's track conditions.

REPEAT (A Sims) - Raced three wide without cover.

NEW CROWN (S McKay) - Held up for a short distance near the 250 metres having to shift ground to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.
