RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE SYDENHAM HURDLES (3100m)
<p>THE SHACKLER (A Kuru) - Underwent a pre race veterinary inspection after connections advised that the gelding had looked a little scratchy coming out of its box on race morning but had subsequently worked and appeared sound. THE SHACKLER was again inspected at the start following the preliminary and passed fit to race. After jumping the first fence the gelding became indifferent in its action and was then retired from the event immediately after jumping the second fence. Rider A Kuru advised that THE SHACKLER had felt fine during the preliminary and in the approach to the first fence during the race but immediately on landing had felt sore, further advising that he had been unable to pull THE SHACKLER up until after the second fence due to being unable to remove the gelding from the race clear of other runners. A post race veterinary inspection found the gelding to be lame in the right foreleg with swelling around the pastern. A veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to racing next.</p> <p>LAKEKEEPER (E Farr) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>MISS MIA (B Lammas) - Misjudged the fence near the 1500 metres, retired from the event after putting in a poor leap at the second to last fence when well beaten.</p> <p>GUY FOX (W Gordon) - Put in a poor leap at the fence passing the 800 metres losing momentum.</p> <p>JACKFROST (S Higgins) - Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of GUY FOX near the 700 metres.</p> <p>DRUMGOLD (G Walsh) - Made a poor jump at the last fence.</p>	
Race 2	EL DOUTE CASHMERE PLATE (1200m)
<p>FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground, raced greenly early in the final straight being reluctant to improve into a gap and then when doing so made contact with CORONITA near the 175 metres.</p> <p>CORONITA (K Williams) - Raced wide throughout, contacted near the 175 metres.</p> <p>REMEDY (K Mudhoo) - Shifted ground outwards passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>FIRE SHOW (G Jogoo) - Rider reported that the gelding had felt lame post race, with a veterinary inspection revealing signs of lameness in the right foreleg and early stages of tie up. A veterinary certificate of fitness is now required prior to racing next.</p>	
Race 3	VAINÉ STRICKLAND - 40 YEARS NZTR PREMIER (1400m)
<p>SHOWPIN (K Williams) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>WISE MOVE (B Morgenrood) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>FIRE LILY (R Myers) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>UPPERHAND (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>HE KIN FLY (T Moseley) - Held up until obtaining clear running inside the final 200 metres.</p> <p>GALWAY GARRY (B Murray) - Held up near the 175 metres.</p> <p>B Murray - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he directed his mount outwards when not sufficiently clear of LORD BEAVER which was checked near the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride at</p>	

race meetings for 8 national riding days effective from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 11 August up to and including Saturday 25 August.

KENSINGTON (S MacNab) - Held up rounding the final bend then having to be steadied near the 250 metres when attempting a marginal run to the inside of BORN A ROYAL which failed to eventuate.

Race 4 | **AVON CITY FORD MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE (3200m)**

POINT PROVEN (E Farr) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

GOLD LEAF (G Walsh) - Put in a poor jump at the fourth fence.

JUSTNAMETHEPRICE (L Douglas) - Tailed the field for the majority of the race and mixed its jumping throughout.

SPEEDY JAX (S Higgins) - Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 2000 metres hampering WINDERMERE LAD, made contact with MESMERIZE on a number of occasions over the final stages when both runners shifted ground passing the 100 metres.

WINDERMERE LAD (B Lammas) - Hampered at the fence near the 2000 metres.

MESMERIZE (I Lupton) - Made contact with SPEEDY JAX on a number of occasions over the final stages when both runners shifted ground passing the 100 metres.

Race 5 | **NZI KORAL STEEPLECHASE (4250m)**

THE BIG OPAL (B Lammas) - Mixed its jumping throughout, shifted outwards abruptly after jumping the first of the Kennels Double and had to be straightened to take the next fence, dipped on landing after jumping the fence at the 3000 metres, hampered by fallen runner after jumping the final fence.

UPPER CUT (M Cropp) - Retired from the race after jumping the fence near the 800 metres with the rider advising that the gelding had commenced to feel indifferent in its action just prior to that fence. UPPER CUT was attended to by the course veterinarian and found to have suffered a flexor tendon rupture to the left foreleg. A veterinary certificate of fitness will be required if the gelding races again.

NOTABADROOSTER (W Gordon) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the final fence and fell. Rider W Gordon was examined by the course doctor and found to be uninjured other than a minor graze above the right eye. A post race veterinary inspection of NOTABADROOSTER revealed the gelding to have blood in both nostrils consistent with a head injury when falling. A veterinary certificate of fitness will be required prior to the gelding racing again.

CHOCOLATE FISH (S Phelan) - Hampered by fallen runner after jumping the final fence.

WISE MEN SAY (I Lupton) - Mixed its jumping at the rear throughout. When questioned, the rider advised that the gelding would be better suited to a longer journey.

Race 6 | **NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY PREMIER SPRINT (1200m)**

WIZE ACT (L Allpress) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

DRESSED TOKILL (G Jogoo) - Raced ungenerously through the middle stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

SALAMANCA (D Hirini) - Over raced in the early stages, lay in throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 7	CHANUI PREMIER (1200m)
<p>MASTER PLATINUM (J Riddell) - Slow to begin, held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home and had to be angled wider passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running, again held up passing the 125m having to angle across heels passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>MY SOPRANO (B Murray) - Restrained to the rear on jumping.</p> <p>J Lowry (MIRA) - Issued with a warning after angling his mount outwards near the 400 metres when not sufficiently clear of SAVASON which was crowded and made contact with SWISSKY.</p> <p>SWISSKY (J Morris) - Over raced in the early stages, contacted near the 400 metres.</p> <p>SAVASON (BB Hong) - Crowded near the 400 metres.</p> <p>MIDDAGURD (R Myers) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the run home.</p> <p>FREE AND EASY (T Moseley) - Held up through the early and middle stages of the run home.</p> <p>SARONIC MISS (C Johnson) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until the final 200 metres.</p>	
Race 8	WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS 121ST WINTER CUP (1600m)
<p>NASHVILLE (K Cowan) - Slow to begin, held up early in the run home.</p> <p>RED SIERRA (R Myers) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>ELFEE (C Johnson) - Slow to begin, forced wider on track 500 metres, hampered 200 metres.</p> <p>TIMY TYLER (J Morris) - Commenced to over race ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1300 metres and continued to do so through the middle stages with the rider reporting that the gelding had got its tongue over the bit.</p> <p>FASCINATE (J Lowry) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>STROLLING VAGABOND (B Grylls) - Steadied near the 1000 metres when TIMY TYLER shifted outwards when racing ungenerously.</p> <p>SHAKTI (G Jogoo) - Steadied near the 500 metres when PLATINUM COMMAND shifted outwards to avoid the heels of TIMY TYLER with SHAKTI then shifting outwards forcing ELFEE and STOKERS ROCK wider on the track.</p> <p>LOCHAN ORA (C Campbell) - Lay out in the run home and passing the 200 metres shifted outwards hampering ELFEE and STOCKERS ROCK.</p> <p>STOCKERS ROCK (T Moseley) - Forced wider on the track 500 metres, hampered 200 metres.</p> <p>R Elliott (PLATINUM COMMAND) was warned for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p> <p>G Jogoo (SHAKTI) was warned for his whip use prior to the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 9	GOLD CLUB PREMIER (1800m)
<p>SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS (S McKay) - Delayed the start when reluctant to load. Raced ungenerously in the early stages with the rider advising that the mare had felt sore in front. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	

MILK IT (R Mudhoo) - Raced keenly in the early stages and wide without cover throughout.

HAND IT TO JONSEY (C O'Beirne) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion that the gelding would be better suited to more rain affected conditions.

LOVETAKEEPHIM (L Allpress) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after beginning awkwardly the gelding had never travelled well. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 10

SPEIGHT'S PREMIER (1600m)

HIGHLY LIKELY (S MacNab) - Bounded at the start and lost ground.

O'KIWI (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early stages.

BRIDGET TOWN (G Jogoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HEAVEN KNOWS (R Elliot) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

REDESDALE (K Cowan) - Held up early in the run home.

SITARIST (C Campbell) - Lost the right hind plate during the running.
