<b>Race 1</b>	<b>SPEIGHT'S PREMIER HURDLE (3100m)</b>
<p><b>BLUES BREAKER</b> (S Higgins) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, put in a poor jump at the fence near the 800 metres, rider reported that the gelding had failed to back up from its race on Wednesday with a post race veterinary inspection not revealing any obvious abnormalities.</p> <p><b>GOLD'NGURU</b> (G Walsh) - Placed in restricted room passing the 2700 metres when DOCTOR EDEN (W Gordon) shifted in, W Gordon was advised to exercise greater care, landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>MASTER COURTSMAN</b> (L Douglas) - Jumped indifferently throughout.</p> <p><b>CIVIC RECEPTION</b> (B Lammas) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the third fence, put in a poor leap at the fence near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>ADDITUP</b> (D Jensen) - Misjudged the fence near the 1700 metres and landed awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SOUTHERN AURORA</b> (S Phelan) - Retired from the event prior to the third last fence when well beaten, rider reported that in his opinion the gelding had failed to back up from its run on Wednesday.</p> <p><b>DOCTOR EDEN</b> (W Gordon) - Retired from the event prior to the last fence when well beaten.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ZILCO PREMIER MAIDEN (1400m)</b>
<p><b>SANSA STARK</b> (T Comignaghi) - Fractious in the barriers and slow to begin.</p> <p><b>HERMANO ROSE</b> (D Hirini) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>BY MAGIC</b> (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MIDNITE KAOS</b> (B Murray) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied losing ground.</p> <p><b>RINGBOLT</b> (T Moseley) - Got its head up when racing keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>TO SIR WITH LOVE</b> (L Callaway) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages having to be firmly restrained near the 800 metres then clipping a heel of BULLY BOY and blundering.</p> <p><b>ELEGIDO</b> (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages and had to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres, inconvenienced near the 200 metres when BULLY BOY (K Cowan) shifted outwards to obtain clear running. K Cowan was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p><b>UBETIAM</b> (C Campbell) - Raced wide without cover throughout and forced over extra ground rounding the bend near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>LET HER RIP RILEY</b> (BB Hong) - Got its head up when being restrained for a distance rounding the bend passing the 800 metres, held up for a short distance near the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>QUAFF</b> (B Grylls) - Held up approaching the 300 metres having to steady and shift inwards to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>BULLY BOY</b> (K Cowan) - Required veterinary attention post race for a laceration to the right hock.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MONGOLIAN FALCON AT WILLOW GLEN PREMIER (1600m)</b>

<b>WISE MOVE</b> (B Morgenrood) - Slow to begin.	
<b>KENSINGTON</b> (S MacNab) - Shifted outwards at the start crowding MASTER PLATINUM which lost ground.	
<b>MASTER PLATINUM</b> (T Moseley) - Crowded start losing ground.	
<b>OREPUKI LAD</b> (J Lowry) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>FIRE LILY</b> (R Myers) - Over raced for a short distance passing the 1200 metres and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained off heels, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that once placed under pressure the mare had hung outwards and had been disappointing. A post race veterinary inspection was clear.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>HEATSTORE PREMIER (2000m)</b>
<b>L Stewart</b> - Issued with a warning after presenting SPIDER LILY without an item of notified gear.	
<b>LADY BEALEY</b> (B Murray) - Began awkwardly and lost ground.	
<b>SMILING ASSASSIN</b> (C Johnson) - Jumped outwards at the start, had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.	
<b>WHISKEY IN THE JAR</b> (J Morris) - Jumped away awkwardly, commenced to over race passing the 1200 metres.	
<b>HAND IT TO JONESY</b> (B Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>WHAT'S UP ALF</b> (R Mudhoo) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1700 metres, held up until near the 250 metres.	
<b>THE MAN</b> (C Campbell) - Inclined to lay inwards in the final straight.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>BRACKENFIELD HUNT PREMIER (1200m)</b>
<b>ON POINT</b> (J Lowry) - Slow to begin.	
<b>SO NATURAL</b> (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.	
<b>OPIO ROSE</b> (L Callaway) - Jumped away awkwardly and blundered.	
<b>FREE AND EASY</b> (T Moseley) - Jumped inwards at the start making contact with ISHINKTAATLEDO.	
<b>ISHINKTAATLEDO</b> (J Laking) - Buffeted at the start losing ground.	
<b>MR CONDUCTOR</b> (KMudhoo) - Over raced in the early and middle stages, lay out badly throughout the run home shifting wider on the track inconveniencing MISS BRAHMOS approaching the 200 metres.	
<b>SUGGESTIVE LOOX</b> (K Williams) - Held up and had to steady for a distance early in the final straight before obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>RACECOURSE HOTEL &amp; MOTOR LODGE 144<sup>TH</sup> GRAND NATIONAL STEEPLECHASE (5600m)</b>
<b>IRISH DUDE</b> (G Walsh) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.	
<b>NOTABADROOSTER</b> (W Gordon) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages, put in a poor jump at the second of the double near the 1200 metres on the final occasion, poor in a poor leap at the final fence.	

**TAI HO** (S Higgins) - Badly misjudged the fence near the 1800 metres on the first occasion.

**AMANOOD LAD** (A Kuru) - Rider reported that the gelding would have been better suited to more rain affected conditions.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MILLENNIUM HOTELS &amp; RESORTS PREMIER OPEN (1400m)</b>
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**WIZE ACT** (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

**SALAMANCA** (D Hirini) - Over raced in the early to middle stages, when questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding would be better suited to more rain affected conditions.

**FINBARR** (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**HE KIN FLY** (T Moseley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of FINBARR (L Callaway) near the 1000 metres. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care.

**SHAARA** (K Mudhoo) - Held up passing the 200 metres having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

**DRESSED TOKILL** (G Jogoo) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing SHAARA near the 200 metres with SHAARA then shifting outwards across the heels of DRESSED TOKILL to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.

**B Murray** (TIMY TYLER) - Issued with a warning for his whip use.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>DYER DECORATING PREMIER (1400m)</b>
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**SHOWPIN** (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

**MIRA** (B Morgenrood) - Slow to begin.

**TAPONISME** (C Johnson) - Over raced in the early stages and had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1200 metres.

**MIDDAGURD** (R Myers) - Over raced when being restrained approaching the 1200 metres getting its head up for a distance.

**JOBY** (K Asano) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

**MONTERRAT** (C Campbell) - Held up early in the run home before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres then being inclined to lay in.

**BELLS OF OUZELEY** (B Grylls) - Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 300 metres.

<b>Race 9</b>	<b>CHRISTCHURCH CASINO WINTER CLASSIC (1800m)</b>
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**SHAKTI** (G Jogoo) - Over raced in the middle stages and shifted outwards to avoid heels near the 1200 metres then being allowed to improve forward outside the leader.

**PLATINUM COMMAND** (R Elliot) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.

<b>Race 10</b>	<b>VERNON &amp; VAZEY PREMIER (2000m)</b>
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**PAT IN BRACKETS** (B Murray) - Slow to begin.

**REDESDALE** (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly, raced wide for the majority of the race.

**OLAF** (K Mudhoo) - Raced keenly through the early to middle stages and had to be steadied away from heels passing the 1100 metres.

**KEYBOARD WARRIOR** (B Morgenrood) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

**AVE MARIA** (R Myers) - Had to be steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres.

**FRANCONI** (L Callaway) - Held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.
