# Race 1 DISTINCTION HAMILTON HOTEL 2100

**HESALLJAZZ** (R Scott) – Slow to begin.

**YOUWANTMORE** (W Pinn) – Raced keenly middle stages. When questioned regarding the riding tactics, Apprentice Rider W Pinn explained that his left foot had become displaced leaving the barrier and when attempting to regain his foot in the correct position passing the 1700 metres YOUWANTMORE had commenced to race keenly and continued to do so through the middle stages. Apprentice Rider W Pinn was reminded that he must ride his horse out to the end of the race when circumstances allow him to.

### Race 2 BECOME A WRC MEMBER ONLY \$125 1400

BEE TEE JUNIOR (E McCall) - Slow to begin.

ANDOYAS (M Coleman) – Slow to begin then hampered.

**GRAND RIO** (A Sims) – Began awkwardly.

**TEMPLE TIGER** (J Fawcett) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres when racing keenly. Raced in restricted room from near the 300 metres and then changed ground inwards passing the 200 metres to gain clear running.

**T Yanagida** (STRADIVARIUS) – Issued with a warning for allowing STRADIVARIUS to shift out for a distance from near the 300 metres inconveniencing TEMPLE TIGER which was placed in restricted room and then had to briefly steady approaching the 200 metres and change ground inwards to obtain clear running.

**AZ GIVEN** (A Calder) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance Rider A Calder could offer no tangible excuses. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

# Race 3 JOHN LETTS GUEST SPEAKER 17<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 1100

**Michael Moroney** & **P Gerard** (TINY TERROR) – The training partnership of M Moroney & P Gerard were fined \$50 after TINY TERROR was presented to race in gear which had not been notified (ear-covers).

ROYAL PATCH (C Lammas) - Crowded leaving the barrier. Briefly crowded passing the 300 metres.

**MORE WONDER** (S Collet) – Began awkwardly.

**TINY TERROR** (S Rusof) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages. Inconvenienced from near the 150 metres when forced wider on the track until the 50 metres. Promoted from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup>.

**CYBER ATTACK** (M Coleman) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

**NULLI SECUNDUS** (R Smyth) – Steadied near 450 metres when awkwardly placed.

**VON TRAPP** (A Calder) – Shifted out under pressure from near the 150 metres. Relegated from 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup>.

A Calder (VON TRAPP) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed VON TRAPP to shift out between the 150 metres and the 50 metres when insufficiently clear of TINY TERROR which was forced wider on the track. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended A Calder's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, 4 August up to and including racing on 19 August 2018, 7 national riding days.

Following the race, the connections of the 2<sup>nd</sup> placed horse **TINY TERROR** lodged a protest against the 1<sup>st</sup> placed horse **VON TRAPP** alleging interference in the final straight. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee upheld the protest with the placings now reading 1<sup>st</sup> **TINY TERROR** 2<sup>nd</sup> **VON TRAP**, 3<sup>rd</sup> **CYBER ATTACK** and 4<sup>th</sup> **NULLI SECUNDUS**.

### Race 4 FOXBRIDGE PLATE RACE DAY 18<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 1600

VAN DIAMOND (J Nason) - Slow to begin.

PRETTY LION (M Coleman) - Began awkwardly.

**GO GO GOAL** (L Satherley) - Shifted out approaching the 400 metres to obtain clear running crowding LUCK OF MASTER which briefly steadied. L Satherley was reprimanded by Stewards and advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.

**LUCK OF MASTER** (S Collett) – Briefly steadied approaching the 400 metres when crowded. Improved onto heels approaching the 150 metres.

**S Collett** (LUCK OF MASTER) - Reminded of her obligations in that she must ride her mount out fully when circumstances allow her to do so.

# Race 5 PATHWAYS IMMIGRATION SERVICES 1600

**IGRAINE** (M Coleman) - L Innes who was 0.5 kilograms overweight was replaced by M Coleman at the request of trainer R Priscott.

**REAL FUN** (S Collett) – Over-raced when being restrained in the middle stages.

**SOUND WORKS** (S Rusof) – Raced keenly through the middle stages when the paced eased. Held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight.

**MENTAL TELEPATHY** (J Parkes) – Rider J Parkes advised Stewards that the gelding had not been suited by the kickback of track conditions.

### Race 6 ALLIED SECURITY 1200

**CLOSE UP** (G Cooksley) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

**DARCI MAC** (W Pinn) - Crowed for a distance after the start having to be steadied.

**CONTESSA VANESSA** (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Bumped and unbalanced 900 metres.

**SOUTHERN ICON** (M Hills) – Began awkwardly.

**JULIUS** (J Waddell) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres shifting out and forcing RESURRECT out onto the hindquarters of CONTESSA VANESSA which became briefly unbalanced.

# Race 7 CAL ISUZU 1200

**PINK GRAFFITI** (M Coleman) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres. Rider M Coleman advised the filly had never been comfortable with the existing track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

MAJIC RULER (A Calder) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

**SWISSILICIOUS** (T Yanagida) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

**TIME TO FLY** (M Hills) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than normal recovery.

**TRYFAN** (W Pinn) – When questioned Apprentice Rider W Pinn advised that the gelding had a tendency to hang out throughout and was not comfortable in existing track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

#### Race 8 GR CLEANING AND ABSEILING 2100

MR DOOLE (T Johnson) – Began awkwardly and then crowded.

MASTER POET (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

GABRIEL (T Newman) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 700 metres.

**SHOCKWAVE** (D Danis) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than normal recovery.

MASTER GENIE (J Parkes) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

**J Parkes** (MASTER GENIE) – Reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mount out fully when circumstances allow him to.
