R9 – HARCOURTS DAFFODIL RACEDAY SEPTEMBER 1 (1200)

C Lammas - Issued with a warning after allowing TOY KINGDOM to shift in approaching the 100 metres dictating LA ROCSETTA inwards further crowding BENAUD who was steadied losing ground.

BENAUD (R Elliot) - Held up passing the 300 metres. Raced in restricted room from near the 250 metres and was then further crowded and steadied passing the 150 metres.

DANGER DEE (B R Jones) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres making brief contact with O’GUY.

TOY KINGDOM (C Lammas) - Briefly contacted 250 metres.

LA ROCSETTA (A Sims) - Shifted out approaching the 250 metres making contact with the hind quarters of TOY KINGDOM.

RACE COMMENTS:**Race 1 | CONGRATULATIONS LAEKEEPER MAIDEN HURDLE 3100**

FORT KNOX (B Lammas) – Slow to begin then hampered after jumping the first fence by MASTER POET (G Walsh) which shifted in when not clear. G Walsh was issued with a warning. Jumped indifferently throughout.

IN A MINUTE (S Phelan) - Jumped the first fence awkwardly. Jumped the second fence awkwardly shifting in crowding BIG ‘N’ RICH and CRUISEO.

BIG ‘N’ RICH (M Vance) - Crowded after jumping the second fence. Misjudged the third to last fence. Hit the final fence.

CRUISEO (W Gordon) – Crowded after jumping the second fence. Pulled prior to jumping the second to last fence.

RESULT MERCHANT (E Farr) – Misjudged the second fence. Pulled up prior to jumping the third to last fence.

KAKAHU STALKER (M Roustoby) - Jumped indifferently throughout. Pulled up prior to jumping the third to last fence. Rider reported that the gelding had held its breath during the race.

DEFER (T Moki) – Was inclined to run down its fences. Hit the second to last fence. Lost the left front plate during the race. When questioned regarding the riding tactics adopted today, in particular why she had allowed DEFER to lead the field by a margin, rider T Moki explained that the gelding is a difficult horse to control and has not responded well when being restrained strongly. T Moki further explained that she had allowed DEFER more rein in an attempt to settle the gelding. T Moki was reminded of her obligations in that she must ride her mounts out fully to the finish when circumstances permit her to do so.

RAY’S LEGACY (J Seivwright) – Misjudged the seventh fence.

MASTER POET (G Walsh) – Crowded shortly after the start. Hit the second to last fence and landed awkwardly.

BORNINASANDPIT (S Fannin) - Crowded shortly after the start.

Race 2 | GRAHAM LEMON, MURRAY DARROCH, OPTIMISM SYND HURDLES 3100

HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Misjudged the first fence. Misjudged the final fence.

BANBURY LAD (S Higgins) – Raced keenly throughout. Hit the third to last fence.

SINO HEIGHTS (G Walsh) - Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

THE DASH (B Lammas) -Began awkwardly. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

HE'S DAN (E Farr) - Misjudged the second fence. Misjudged the fifth fence landing awkwardly. Hit the sixth fence. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

ARITE GURU (C Dell) – Hit the seventh fence unbalancing its rider.

Race 3 | **JOHN THE SPANNER HANNAH 1400**

JUSTACANTA (T Yanagida) - Began awkwardly.

REPO SUN (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

LUPELANI (K Cowan) - Was questioned regarding her riding tactics aboard LUPELANI and in particular why she had elected to go for an inside run approaching the 400 metres where there was an opportunity to shift to the outside of AZ GIVEN. Miss Cowan explained that at that stage of the race QUANTUM had appeared to be under pressure and was concerned that the gelding may have pushed her wider rounding the bend than necessary, adding in her opinion cutting the corner and covering less ground was to her advantage.

Race 4 | **THANK YOU FIBER FRESH 2200**

CASSIO (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly making contact and unbalancing its rider.

CANZAC (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

L Satherley (GINGEE) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 5 | **TE AROHA STALLION PLACEMENT SCHEME 1200**

MISS POSH (L Satherley) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be firmly restrained.

IKTOMI (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

NIGHT CAPTAIN (E McCall) – Began awkwardly.

CHARLIE RUNKLE (S Spratt) – Hampered shortly after the start.

REMEMBER ROSIE (R Smyth) - Lay in onto heels when weakening having to be steadied passing the 600 metres.

Race 6 | **THE NAMESBOND STEEPLECHASE 3500**

BEVERLEY BECK (S Higgins) – Slow to begin (3L).

JEALOUS BOY (M Roustoby) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Pulled up prior to jumping the fence near the 1000 metres. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

WONDER JUMP (S Fannin) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

KOKANEE GOLD (W Gordon) – Misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres. Lost the left front plate during the running.

SIR AL SYD (A Roustoby) - Knuckled on landing after jumping the second to last fence.

ISTIMAGIC (E Farr) – Jumped the second to last fence awkwardly.

ZEDSATIONAL (A Kuru) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider A Kuru advised Stewards that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. A Post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 7 | **KNOTTINGLY FARM STEEPLECHASE 3500**

PERRY MASON (A Kuru) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence.

THENAMESBOND (S Higgins) – Put in a poor jump at the second fence and fell dislodging its rider. Both horse and rider were uninjured.

THAT’S HOW IT GOES (B Lammas) - Hampered after jumping the second fence by the fallen runner.

TOP CHOICE (E Farr) - Hampered after jumping the second fence by the fallen runner.

ZAMORA (W Gordon) - Hampered after jumping the second fence by the fallen runner.

STAGEHAND (T Moki) - Slow to begin. Hampered after jumping the second fence by the fallen runner. Misjudged the fence near the 1200 metres hampering **HIGHLY LIKELY**.

HIGHLY LIKELY (J Seivwright) - Hampered after jumping the fence near the 1200 metres.

YIPSON (S Fannin) – Hampered then knuckled on landing after jumping the second to last fence.

J Seivwright – Was issued with a warning for leaving the Jockey’s room without seeking permission.

Race 8 | **FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES 1600**

SWEET TREAT (B Rogerson) – Slow to begin.

MERLOT (L Myers) – Slow to begin.

AONGATETE EXPRESS (L Calitz) - Became unbalanced passing the 1400 metres when awkwardly placed near the running rail.

WAGNER (N Alam) - Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

L Myers (MERLOT) – Admitted a charge of excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$250.

E Nicholas (NOT ALLOWED) - Issued with a warning for her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 9 | **FAREWELL GRAEME AMIES 1400**

UABASSO (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

EL COOLIO (T Thornton) - Slow to begin.
