MESMERIZE (I Lupton) – Trainer R Connors advised Stewards that the gelding underwent further veterinary examination upon return to his stable which revealed a swollen off hind leg which has since received treatment.

When questioned rider M Cameron advised the gelding was unsuited to today's track conditions.</p> <p>ROSCHANA (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>AZABEAT (C Lammas) – Slow away.</p> <p>HUNUA HANK (K Cowan) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.</p> <p>CAPTAIN COURIER (B Grylls) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.</p> <p>CROSSED MY MIND (J Bayliss) - When questioned rider advised the mare had pulled hard early when over racing and was unsuited to today's track conditions.</p>

<p>JEWELL OF JUMERIAH – Trainer G Shaw was issued with a warning for presenting the mare to race in side blinkers that were not notified.</p> <p>KATIE PERRIE (S McKay) – Slow to begin. Steadied for a distance when placed in restricted room passing the 300 metres having to shift out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>KANDARI (L Innes) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>LOOSE CHOUX (R Scott) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1000 metres then commenced to race keenly shifting out near the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>WHOSHE'S GIRL (R Smyth) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>TINTERO (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>IMELDA MARY (D Danis) – Steadied and shifted in when becoming awkwardly placed on heels of SHAHANA which shifted out hampering TINTERO (R Elliot) which had improved to the inside of IMELDA MARY. After questioning rider R Elliot he advised the mare had over reacted when being steadied near the 800 metres.</p>

<p>MILLY MOO (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact on two occasions with ZAPPEUR which was briefly crowded.</p>	

IFNOT WAINOT (C Dell) – Lay in passing the 800 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SAINT CROIX.

<p>ARENARULER (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously after improving onto heels passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p>MARIOTA (S McKay) – Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after losing ground.</p> <p>LANGBEIN (A Calder) – Crowded leaving barrier.</p> <p>JUST TREASURE (S Weatherley) - Steadied 250 metres.</p> <p>NIGHT CAPTAIN (J Fawcett) - Improved onto the heels of JUST TREASURE passing the 250 metres and steadied.</p> <p>T Thornton - Issued with a warning for permitting DON'T LIE TO ME to shift out passing the 250 metres crowding JUST TREASURE which was steadied.</p> <p>C Lammas (SURE HE CAN) - Admitted a charge under Rule 638(3((b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.</p> <p>J Bayliss (IVETTE) - Admitted a charge under Rule 638(3((b)(ii) for excessive use of the whip prior to the 100 metres. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended J Bayliss' licence to ride at race meetings from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 5th September until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 13th September 6 National days.</p>

<p>GOLD SPICE (M Hashizume) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned, rider advised the mare was not suited to today's track conditions.</p> <p>TIN SOLDIER (C Dell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p>

<p>CRITICS CHOICE (C Dell) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>TWEEDLEDEE (T Yanagida) - Lost the off-hind plate during the race.</p> <p>FLY TO THE MOON (J Bayliss) - Was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. When questioned J Bayliss advised that the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing.</p> <p>J Riddell - Issued with a warning in that he angled his mount out when not clear of BOUNDARY which had to be steadied near the 800 metres.</p>

<p>CRIQUEY CRON (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p>WEE BISKIT (C Dell) -Crowded soon after leaving the barriers losing ground.</p> <p>MOOSE (D Danis) - Began awkwardly.</p>	
Race 8	GCM FEEDS 2000
<p>GINGEE (L Satherley) – Commenced to race ungenerously approaching the 1600 metres for a distance.</p>	

BURDOCVELVETPRINCE (K Cowan) - Raced in restricted room 1500 metres and steadied.

LADY DAY (D Danis) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 1600 metres then again passing the 550 metres.
