RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Northland Rural Mechanical Services (1200 metres)
<p>S Marsh (LET ME TELL YA) – Issued with a warning after LET ME TELL YA was presented to race without notified gear (side winkers).</p> <p>CASUAL WINKS (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend awkwardly running wide near the 900 metres.</p> <p>CAPELLANI (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly and then was further crowded having to be steadied.</p> <p>POWER OF STRENGTH (T Yanagida) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.</p> <p>HASABRO (S Spratt) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied passing the 900 metres shifting out slightly and forcing PACIFIC on to the hind quarters of RIPPA EAGLE when making the bend with PACIFIC then being hampered.</p> <p>PACIFIC (A Calder) – Crowded and hampered 900 metres.</p> <p>RIPPA EAGLE (B Grylls) – Briefly contacted and unbalanced 900 metres then raced wide without cover.</p> <p>KEEP THE CASH (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MR HASS (J Nason) – Hung outwards throughout and shifted out making the final bend approaching the 400 metres forcing MAISON ROXANNE wider on the track. Inconvenienced 300 metres. J Nason reported that the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>MAISON ROXANNE (D Johnson) – Forced wide 400 metres and then lay in when placed under pressure passing the 300 metres inconveniencing MR HASS. Rider D Johnson was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.</p>	
Race 2	Bear Morgan @ Harcourts Bream Bay (2100 metres)
<p>GREENCAST (S Spratt) – Slow away.</p> <p>MAJOR TOM (J Fawcett) – Raced wide until improving forward to lead near the 1400 metres.</p> <p>JAKE THE MUSS (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider D Johnson advised that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions which she described as shifty.</p> <p>R Elliot (BANROCK) – Severely reprimanded and issued with a warning after relaxing his ride prior to the finish.</p> <p>ROC DE BANK (M Hills) – Underwent a veterinary examination after giving ground appreciably in the final straight which could find no obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 3	Harcourts Just Rentals (2100 metres)
<p>TAVIROSE (K Cowan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>AMAZING AZ (D Johnson) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>BLACK LACE (R Smyth) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Dictated wide passing the 700 metres.</p> <p>FIRENZE (D Danis) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>Z Moki (SMEDLEY) – Spoken to regarding her whip use in the final straight.</p>	
Race 4	Hirepool (1600 metres)
<p>BLUE LAGOON (K Cowan) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight making contact passing the 200 metres before being corrected by its rider.</p>	

ALPHASTAR (D Danis) – Briefly hampered passing the 200 metres when crowded to the outside of BLUE LAGOON which lay out under pressure.

K Cowan – Issued with a warning after allowing BLUE LAGOON to shift out under pressure making contact with ALPHASTAR which was briefly hampered near the 200 metres.

MARBLES (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had not travelled comfortably throughout and failed to respond under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 5 | **Harcourts Whangarei (1200 metres)**

GOBSTOPPER (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

VINEVALE (B Grylls) – Crowded and steadied shortly after the start.

D Danis (WATCH THIS SPACE) – Defended a breach of careless riding in that he allowed WATCH THIS SPACE to shift in passing the 900 metres when insufficiently clear of EXCELLERATION which was dictated into the line of SPIDER which was checked. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee did not find the charge proven.

SPIDER (J Nason) – Crowded and checked approaching the 900 metres losing ground.

RIKKI TIKKI TAVI (S Spratt) – Held up passing the 400 metres having to shift out across heels approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

EXCELLERATION (K Cowan) – Held up passing the 400 metres having to shift out near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

MAGNUM (R Elliot) – Shifted out when placed under pressure in the final straight

WATCH THIS SPACE (D Danis) – Improved onto heels approaching the 300 metres and was inconvenienced when looking to obtain clear running.

Race 6 | **MWIS Lawyers (1400 metres)**

ROCKABYEBABY (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HELLO IT'S ME (A Calder) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 7 | **Tavistock at Cambridge Stud (1000 metres)**

STAR PERFORMANCE (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

LUVLUCY (J Nason) – Hampered when improving on to heels near the 150 metres.

CHAPEAU (K Cowan) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 100 metres.

Race 8 | **Harcourts Bream Bay (1200 metres)**

TOY KINGDOM (R Elliot) – Became fractious in the barriers and was removed to undergo a veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching at 4.46pm on veterinary advice. Co-trainer M Bradley was advised that the mare will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

KING KANE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

NOT USUAL HEART (D Danis) – Slow away and then hampered shortly after losing ground. Crowded and steadied 900 metres.

A Calder (I SEE RED) – Issued with a warning after permitting I SEE RED to shift in passing the 900 metres when insufficiently clear of NOT USUAL HEART which had to be steadied.

SWISSWATCH (E McCall) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SANTA MONICA (T Thornton) – Held up early in the final straight.

Race 9

Polwarth Design & Whangarei Menswear (1400 metres)

LUCKY DREAMER (L Satherley) – Shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier forcing **PRIOR ENGAGEMENT** out on to the hind quarters of **WOODEN RED** with both those runners being hampered losing ground.

PRIOR ENGAGEMENT (K Chowdhoo) – Hampered start losing ground.

WOODEN RED (M Hills) - Hampered start losing ground.

CECEE SIGNOR (D Johnson) – Raced fiercely in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson advised that after racing fiercely in the early stages the gelding had failed to quicken as a consequence.

L Satherley (**LUCKY DREAMER**) – Issued with a warning after allowing **LUCKY DREAMER** to shift out passing the 400 metres when insufficiently clear of **JIMMY ROCKET** which was forced out into the line of **MI SKY** which was hampered. Taken into account was the inward movement from **MI SKY** which contributed to the incident.

MI SKY (A Calder) – Forced wider on the track passing the 1000 metres then raced wide for the remainder of the race. Shifted in after improving onto heels passing the 400 metres crowding **POKER FACE** which was hampered. Contributing was outward movement from **JIMMY ROCKET** which was dictated out by **LUCKY DREAMER** (L Satherley) which shifted out under pressure.

POKER FACE (B Grylls) – Slow away. Crowded and hampered 400 metres then shifted in to obtain clear running.

JIMMY ROCKET (R Elliot) – Briefly crowded 400 metres.
