Race 3 SEATON PARK MDN 1100
ROUGE (C O'Beirne) – Trainer L Pickford advised Stewards that the mare underwent further veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination upon return to her stable which revealed a soft palate issue with the veterinary recommending the application of a tongue tie and noseband.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SUPER LIQUOR MATAMATA 1400
CHIARA (D Johnson) - Slow away.	
FLYING FANTASIA (J Nason) – Jumped away awkwardly.	

LIFE JACKET (R Smyth) – Had to be steadied shortly after the start when **ULTIMATEEXPECTATION** shifted inwards when racing ungenerously, held up rounding the final turn and had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

ULTIMATEEXPECTATIONS (S Rusof) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

DRAKE BAY (V Colgan) – Over raced in the early and middle stages. When questioned into the performance, rider advised the gelding had been inclined to hang out from the 700 metres.

CARRELEUR (B Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover.

SURE HE CAN (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover.

ADIS (C Lamas) - Briefly held up near the 300 metres when **PARLIAMENT** shifted outwards

Race 2 | **PAUL JONES CONTRACTING 1200**

ARCTIC LADY (D Danis) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

IN A TWINKLING (S Rusof) - Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly shifting out dictating **HIGH PRIORITY** wider on the track, raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

HIGH PRIORITY (L Satherley) – Forced wider 800 metres then continued to race wide for the remainder of the race.

SOCIALIGHTS (D Johnson) – Steadied when in restricted room to the outside of **FAST MOVER** which lay out passing the 300 metres.

NAVAL FLEET (S Collett) – Held up until shifting in near the 200 metres to obtain clear running inconveniencing the weakening **SIMOGRAMOR**.

SIMOGRAMOR (M Coleman) -Inconvenience when weakening passing the 200 metres.

MEXICAN TYCOON (M Cameron) - When questioned into the performance of **MEXICAN TYCOON**, rider advised the colt had raced greenly throughout and lay out around the final bend.

Race 3 | **THE REDOUBT BAR & EATERY 1200**

LOOSE CHOUX (R Scott) – Crowded leaving the barriers, held up rounding the bend and early in the final straight.

SPINNAKER (S Spratt) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LOTHARIO (M Cameron) - Commenced to lay out rounding the bend near the 800 metres running wide around the final bend having to steady when awkwardly placed on heels. Steadied passing the 250 metres and becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **FRENCH CUT**.

CLARIOS (S Collet) – Commenced to lay out passing the 150 metres making contact with **GARADOS**, then having to steady.

Race 4 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE**

I'MA SHYGIRL (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover.

VERRY ELLEEGANT (R Smyth) - Slow away, lay out rounding the final bend.

ICING ON THE CAKE (S McKay) - Steadied when in restricted room 300 metres.

R Smyth Issued with a warning in that she angled VERRY ELLEEGANT outwards passing the 400 metres placing ICING ON THE CAKE in restricted room passing the 300 metres having to be steadied.

Race 5 | **WAIKATO BRANCH NZ FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 1400**

SUN GENES (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover.

SOUND THE SIREN (R Jones) – Commenced to give ground passing the 900 metres and was not preserved with from the 600 metres. Rider R Jones was unable to offer any reason for the gelding’s performance. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Trainer B Hawtin advised the gelding would no longer be preserved with as a racing proposition.

JEWELL OF JUMERIAH (J Fawcett) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight and could not be fully ridden out.

N Bakar - Issued with a warning in that he allowed his mount to shift out passing the 300 metres making contact with KING’S SECRET then continued to shift out finishing wide on the track.

Race 6 | **A P GOLAN REGISTERED VALUERS 1200**

ENDEAN EXPRESS (D Danis) - Crowded at the start between CAMEAHOTFRIDAY and PACQUIAO which both began awkwardly and shifted ground.

CAMEAHOTFRIDAY (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly making firm contact with ENDEAN EXPRESS unbalancing its rider, had to be steadied over the final 100 metres when held up after improving onto the heels of JET CHARGED.

MYRCELLA (M Coleman) - Raced three wide without cover.

PACQUIAO (M Hashizume) - Began awkwardly.

Race 7 | **LOWE SCHOLLUM JONES LTD 2000**

PYTHAGORAS (S McKay) - Jumped away awkwardly.

Race 8 | **MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS 2000**

BANKS ROAD (A Calder) – Severely crowded onto CANZAC at start when CASSIO jumped away awkwardly shifting outwards.

CANZAC (A Jones) Severely crowded onto BANKS ROAD at the start when LADY DAY jumped away shifting inwards. Raced wide for the majority of the race.

CASSIO (C Lammas) - Jumped away awkwardly, held up for clear running rounding the bend into the final straight.

LADY DAY (D Danis) - Jumped away awkwardly.
