GENERAL:

The meeting was put back one race following the fall in race two, with the final race being run at 5.18 pm.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 FARMLANDS CO-OPERATIVE HDL

CASHEL (M Cropp) – Had to be firmly restrained after jumping the second fence when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of CAPTAIN ORANGE.

ZED LEPPELIN (E Nicholas) – Hit the fence near the 900 metres losing ground.

RESULT MERCHANT (M Roustoby) – Misjudged the fence approaching the 1000 metres. Misjudged the final fence.

MAGIC CANNON (G Walsh) – Misjudged the fence approaching the 900 metres.

JOCHEN RINDT (E Farr) – Had to shift ground outwards passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running. When questioned regarding performance rider E Farr advised that in her opinion the gelding had not felt entirely comfortable on today's track conditions and would appreciate more rain-affected footing.

MRS ME (L Douglas) – Hit the second to last fence and blundered on landing.

CAPTAIN ORANGE (A Kuru) – Misjudged the second to last fence.

Race 2 TEAM WEALLEANS HDL

CHEVAL DE FOND (G Walsh) – Began awkwardly losing ground, and jumped indifferently throughout.

PRIZE LAD (L Douglas) – Began awkwardly losing ground (4L), and jumped indifferently throughout.

BIG 'N' RICH (T Moki) – Misjudged the fence near the 1900 metres.

ZEDSATIONAL (M Vance) – Misjudged the second to last fence and fell dislodging its rider who was attended to by on course paramedics and transferred to hospital for further evaluation. ZEDSATIONAL underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a haemorrhage from both nostrils due to head trauma.

I'M BRONSON (B Lammas) – Hampered by fallen runner after jumping the second to last fence.

CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (E Farr) – Hit the second to last fence.

PAVLICHENKO (A Kuru) – Hit the final fence and blundered on landing losing momentum.

Race 3 SWEENEY TOWNSEND & ASSOCIATES ROTORUA & BOP HUNT CUP

GO GO GONZO (G Walsh) - Slow away.

HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) – Slow away.

RAAJ (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the third fence. Hit the second to last fence.

YIPSON (B Lammas) – Misjudged the fourth fence and landed awkwardly. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

HE'S DAN (E Nicholas) – Misjudged the final fence.

Race 4 T W MOORE LTD HWT

STORMING THE TOWER (G Walsh) – Slow away, then hampered shortly after losing ground.

MASTER POET (S Phelan) – Had to shift ground inwards entering the final straight to obtain clear running.

Race 5 ROTORUA DISTRICT RDA – FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES

J'WALKE (G Duncan) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover throughout

PIERIAN SPRING (M Northcott) – Began awkwardly and then was further crowded losing ground by MR DOOLE which was taken in by BLAZING OPAL. Crowded having to be steadied passing the 1600 metres.

LOCHARBURN (L Myers) – Crowded having to be steadied passing the 1600 metres. Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

WILIJONMCBRIDE (B Rogerson) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

B Rogerson – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount WILIJONMCBRIDE to shift in when not sufficiently clear of AONGATETE EXPRESS which was crowded inwards on to PIERIAN SPRING and LOCHARBURN for a distance passing the 1600 metres. WILIJONMCBRIDE then lay in making contact with AONGATETE EXPRESS and becoming unbalanced shifting inwards further, resulting in AONGATETE EXPRESS being checked.

AONGATETE EXPRESS (L Calitz) – Crowded passing the 1600 metres then checked shortly after. Improved wide from inside the 750 metres.

BLAZING OPAL (S MacNab) – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Lost the left hind plate during the running.

E Nicholas (NO TIP) – Was reminded of her obligations in that she must ride her mount out fully to the end of a race when circumstances permit.

Race 6 K MYERS RACING STABLES 1230

HONORA (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly having to steady losing ground when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HINGIS.

JAZDANZER (T Miles) – Began awkwardly shifting out forcing EASY M'LADY out on to RED JAKKAL with both those runners being hampered. Commenced to lay out shortly after the start, then continued to lay out rounding the bend inconveniencing HINGIS passing the 550 metres when running wider.

EASY M'LADY (C Lammas) – Hampered start. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 500 metres.

RED JAKKAL (S Rusof) – Hampered start.

Race 7 PREAKNESS BELMONT STAKES & CUBA WITH WHEEL'S

LAMBADA (J Nason) – Slow away, and then was further hampered by ICEBOMB which began awkwardly shifting out. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when over-racing.

ICEBOMB (N Bakar) – Began awkwardly shifting out.

NUCLEAR FUSION (R Elliot) – Commenced to over-race shortly after the start when being steadied. Held up for a distance passing the 300 metres.

TIN SOLDIER (C Dell) – Over-raced when being restrained approaching the 1100 metres.

GOODNIGHT IRENE (L Satherley) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of MILLY MOO (A Goindasamy) which shifted ground near the 300 metres. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care.

Race 8 THANKS TO THE LANDOWNERS 1400

ZEDCREST (A Calder) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

OCEAN STAR (S Rusof) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider S Rusof advised Stewards that the gelding had raced keenly during the running and then had run home fairly when placed under pressure in the final straight.

STEVIE'S SURPRISE (R Smyth) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1000 metres when racing keenly and shifted out making the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

INNOCENT MAN (D Hain) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

NIGHT CAPTAIN (J Fawcett) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight. Shifted ground outwards near the 150 metres having to be corrected by its rider, and again passing the 50 metres into the line of MEDAGLIA VELOCE which had to be steadied over the concluding stages.

MEDAGLIA VELOCE (S Collett) – Had to be steadied over the concluding stages when awkwardly placed on heels. Prior to the authorization of dividends the connections of the third placed MEDAGLIA VELOCE viewed the Stewards video footage before electing not to proceed with a protest against the first placed NIGHT CAPTAIN.

CAPELLANI (R Elliot) – Briefly held up entering the final straight having to shift ground outwards passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

J Fawcett – Issued with a warning for allowing her mount NIGHT CAPTAIN to shift out when not sufficiently clear of MEDAGLIA VELOCE over the concluding stages.

J Bayliss (VOLANTIS) – Issued with a warning after weighing-in in excess of 0.5 kg over his weigh out weight.
