GENERAL:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CHIPPERFIELD ALL ROUND EQUINE EDUCATION 1150
UP 'N' GONE (J Fawcett) - Slow away, made contact with the running rail becoming unbalanced passing the 1000 metres.	
ARNAGE (M Cameron) - Slow away. Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 900 metres.	
MASTER HERB (B Grylls) - Slow away.	
Race 2	VILAGRAD WINERY 1400
T Harris - Fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after advising on race morning that he was unable to make the weight for SPEEDKEEPER being replaced by S Rusof.	

LORD VALENTINE (T Thornton) - Hampered leaving the barriers when SAMMY'S BOY jumped away awkwardly.

SAMMY'S BOY (L Satherley) - Jumped away awkwardly.

OUR KATY CRUZ (B Grylls) - Slow away.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (R Smyth) - Slow away. Continued to lose ground in the early stages becoming tailed off and proving uncompetitive for the remainder of the race. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer Mr D Wilson was advised that the filly is required to trial satisfactorily prior to racing again. Mr Wilson advised that he is now likely to spell the filly.

S Rusof - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount SPEEDKEEPER to shift outwards near the 300 metres making solid contact with RAZOR (J Fawcett) which was badly unbalanced. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Rusof's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 23 September until the conclusion of racing on Friday 5 October, 7 national riding days.

RAZOR (J Fawcett) - Badly unbalanced when received solid contact near the 300 metres.

Following the race S Rusof reported that his mount SPEEDKEEPER had lost its footing approaching the 600 metres. After meeting with riders a track inspection took place involving Stipendiary Stewards along with rider, trainer and Club representatives. The view of the Inspection Committee was that the track was in suitable condition to continue racing and again after meeting with all riders the meeting proceeded with Race 3 being delayed to 1.56 pm.

THE ONE THING (B Grylls) - Slow away. Had to be steadied after improving onto heels near the 700 metres.

TUNZAGUTZ (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MAN POWER (D Hain) - Raced three wide without cover.

HONG QUI (S Collett) - Held up over the final 150 metres.

S Spratt (IZTAMOUR) - Following the running of this race S Spratt advised that she was feeling unwell and after being attended to by St John's personnel was stood down from her remaining rides with a medical clearance required prior to riding next.

SECRET EMBRACE (D Johnson) - Slow away. Unbalanced when received contact to its hind quarters near the 250 metres.

TIME ALONE (S Collett) - Had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages being wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BABOONSKI (C Dell) - Had to be firmly restrained after improving onto the heels of LOTUS LAUD near the 1000 metres. Made contact with the hind quarters of SECRET EMBRACE when attempting to obtain clear running near the 250 metres, then raced in restricted room for a distance.

C Dell - Issued with a warning after angling his mount BABOONSKI outwards near the 250 metres making contact with the hind quarters of SECRET EMBRACE unbalancing that runner.

<p>IMPULSIVE HABIT (T Thornton) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>TICKET TO RIDE (K Cowan) - Held up passing the 250 metres when attempting a run to the inside of SELLWOOD which failed to eventuate, then having to be steadied to shift out across that runner's heels before obtaining clear running near the 50 metres.</p>

<p>MOET MOLLY (S Collett) - Blundered leaving the barriers hampering STAR ELLA.</p> <p>STAR ELLA (T Thornton) - Hampered start.</p>	
Race 7	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE
<p>MADAM ACE (R Elliot) - Slow away.</p> <p>POP DIVA (T Allan) - Slow away.</p> <p>BELOW ZERO (J Castano) - Shifted outwards rounding the bend near the 600 metres when not fully clear hampering POLLY GREY and EXEMPLAR which were both forced over extra ground with BELOW ZERO then racing wide without cover for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>POLLY GREY (B Grylls) - Hampered and forced over extra ground going into the bend near the 600 metres.</p> <p>EXEMPLAR (D Johnson) - Hampered and forced over extra ground going into the bend near the 600 metres.</p> <p>R Elliot - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount MADAM ACE to shift outwards rounding the final turn approaching the 250 metres crowding BELLE SOUTH.</p> <p>BELLE SOUTH (S Collett) - Crowded 250 metres.</p> <p>J Castano - When questioned regarding the riding tactics employed on his mount BELOW ZERO apprentice Castano agreed with Stewards that he had erred in his decision to move from a trailing position approaching the 600 metres shifting outwards across heels to race wide around the bend. J Castano was advised that he would be expected to show far better judgement in future.</p> <p>RECENSION (J Bayliss) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing SKAABOOM passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>SKAABOOM (M Coleman) - Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.</p>
