Race 1	ANN BROWNE RACING STEEPLECHASE

ISTIMAGIC (M Roustoby) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

LETMEBY (E Farr) – Slow to begin. Blundered on landing after jumping the fence near the 2300 metres. Blundered badly after jumping the second to last fence.

TELL ME MORE (E Nicholas) – Slow to begin.

WINDERMERE LAD (S O'Malley) – Slow to begin.

RAY'S LEGACY (L Horner) – Jumped the fence near the 2300 metres awkwardly landing close to the heels of MEXICAN having to be corrected by its rider.

CASHEL (M Cropp) – Misjudged the fence near the 1700 metres.Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

STORMING THE TOWER (A Kuru) – Ran down the final fence becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of JUSTNAMETHEPRICE. When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding had jumped hesitantly throughout in its first steeplechase start, but could offer no other reason.

Race 2 JOHN WHEELER RACING STABLES HURDLE

ALL IN ROCK (L Douglas) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

PAVLICHENKO (B Lammas) – Got its head up and commenced to over-race when placed in restricted room passing the 1000 metres on the first occasion. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

NO TIP (A Kuru) – Crowded and hampered near the 1800 metres to the inside of CHEVAL DE FOND which shifted in and away from ARITE GURU (M Roustoby) which shifted in. Rider M Roustoby was issued with a warning.

ZED LEPPELIN (E Nicholas) – Misjudged the fence near the 1100 metres and stumbled on landing. Misjudged the second to last fence and landed awkwardly.

CHEVAL DE FOND (T Moki) – Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

ARITE GURU (M Roustoby) – Misjudged the final fence and fell. Rider M Roustoby was attended to by St John's paramedics and stood down for the remainder of the day. The gelding was attended to by the Club veterinarian and was found to have sustained minor lacerations with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next.

L Horner HENRY TUDOR – Issued with a warning in that he allowed HENRY TUDOR to shift in when not fully clear of ARITE GURU which shifted in on to CHEVAL DE FOND with that runner shifting in crowding PAVLICHENKO which had to be steadied near the 1000 metres on first occasion. Contributing to this incident was outward movement from NO TIP.

Race 3 PAUL NELSON RACING HURDLE 3100

REVOLUTION (A Kuru) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Inclined to run down its fences throughout. Badly misjudged the final fence with its rider becoming unbalanced losing momentum.

RESULT MERCHANT (T Moki) – Ran down the fourth fence hampering MAGIC CANNON. Hit the fence near the 1350 metres losing ground. Stumbled on landing after jumping the final fence.

MAGIC CANNON (P Hamblin) – Hampered when jumping the fourth fence.

RICH HABIT (M Cropp) – Had to briefly steady when placed in restricted room passing the 1200 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

Race 4 FAULKNER DRAINAGE MARAMARUA HUNT HURDLE

IT'S A WONDER (S O'Malley) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

HESALLJAZZ (L Douglas) – Slow to begin. Placed in restricted room after jumping the second fence having to be steadied. Hit the final fence.

GALLANTE (B Lammas) – Misjudged the first fence.

HE'S DAN (E Nicholas) – Hit the fourth fence. Misjudged the fifth fence. Ran down the second to last fence.

THE OTHER HALF (P Hamblin) – Misjudged the fifth fence.

DELEGATE (L Horner) – Had to be firmly restrained after jumping the third to last fence when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of THE GREAT GURU. Had to shift in passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

FAST CATCH (T Moki) – Misjudged the second to last fence.

Race 5 MIKE FRASER-JONES 2200

CANZAC (E Farr) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was found to have a minor abrasion inside the left hock and was cleared to race. Began awkwardly. Hampered 400 metres by fallen rider.

BURDOCVELVETPRINCE (J Nason) – Became awkwardly placed on the heels of COWBOYS DONT CRY passing the 800 metres shifting out, and then raced wide for a distance.

BANKS ROAD (S Fannin) – When improving forward near the 400 metres clipped a heel of BURDOCVELVETPRINCE and stumbled and dislodged its rider. Rider S Fannin was attended to by St John's paramedics and was stood down for the remainder of the day. Hampered as a result was CANZAC and BREKY AT TIFFANYS.

BREKY AT TIFFANYS (L Douglas) – Hampered 400 metres by fallen rider.

S Wenn – Admitted a breach of Rule 614(2) in that he presented TURO DE POTENCO and SHAHANA to race with the incorrect saddle cloths and was fined \$50 by the Judicial Committee.

Race 6 CAPISTRANO LODGE DUKE OF GLOUCESTER CUP 2200

ONEFORTHEDITCH (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

AVE MARIA (L Myers) – Began awkwardly.

FORT KNOX (B Rogerson) – Slow to begin.

MEDINI (H Parkes) – Began awkwardly.

EL CORBY (C Isdale) – Crowded and steadied to the inside of MOOSE which was taken in by FORT KNOX (B Rogerson) passing the 2100 metres. Contributing was outward movement from BARB DWYER. Rider B Rogerson was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

BARB DWYER (J McIlroy) and **SENASSY** (N Jensen) – Were crowded and steadied to the inside of TABOO which was dictated in by TRANSFORMER (L Wheeler) which was only marginally clear passing the 2100 metres, and continued to

shift in, and approaching the 1700 metres TABOO had to shift out when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of TRANSFORMER. Rider L Wheeler admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) and was fined the sum of \$300.

Race 7 BAYLEYS WAIKATO HUNT CUP STEEPLECHASE

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (E Nicholas) – Misjudged the third fence.

CABALLO NOIR (P Hamblin) – Misjudged the fence near the 1600 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final two fences.

THENAMESBOND (M Cropp) – Hit the fence near the 1600 metres, and then was pulled up shortly after. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration to the left hind fetlock.

PYTHAGORAS (B Lammas) – Slow to begin.

MI PIACI (P Hamblin) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Made contact with the running rail when placed in restricted room to the inside of LUEN YAT MIRACLE which was taken in by ZEDSATIONAL which shifted in when not fully clear near the 1000 metres.

BABOONSKI (C Dell) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

ZEDSATIONAL (E Farr) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After undergoing an endoscopic examination the gelding was found to have a haemorrhage from the upper respiratory area with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing next. Trainer advised the gelding would now be spelled.

Race 9 GEOFF BRINDLEY MEMORIAL 1600

DISRAELI (B Harrison) – Began awkwardly, then was crowded shortly after losing ground. Held up for clear running until passing the 250 metres.

LOOSE CHOUX (L Petersen) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

APEROL (J McIlroy) – Had to be steadied when crowded to the inside of MR BAZAMOUR (S Wenn) which when overracing became awkwardly placed inside the heels of ACACIA which shifted in slightly, with APEROL then shifting out dictating ARIANA and LORDE HAVE MERCY over extra ground. Rider S Wenn was advised to exercise care.
