Race 3 - Whangarei Racing Club Membership (1200 metres)LONDON BANKER (V Colgan) – Co-trainer R James advised that in the days following its race the colt was showing signs of being slightly jarred up, adding that consideration would be given to trialing LONDON BANKER prior to racing next.

Race 6 - Lion Red 1600

THE CASINO MAN (A Calder) – Co-trainer M Rogers advised that the gelding subsequently underwent a physiotherapy examination which revealed a pulled hamstring.

Race 8 - Christmas at the Races Ruakaka Dec 18 (1400 metres)

IN VINO VERITAS (T Thornton) – Co-trainer C Gibbs advised that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare and it is their intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 2 - CAMBRIDGE STUD.CO.NZ (1200)

ONE BAKERSTREET (S Spratt) – Co-trainer A Peard advised that the mare would be spelled to recover from the injuries sustained in this race.

Hawke's Bay Racing Inc. - Saturday 6 October 2018 Race 5 - SACRED FALLS HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS (1400m)

REEVEDERCI (L Innes) – Trainer L Noble advised that the gelding underwent blood tests in the days following this race which did not reveal any abnormality, adding it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

CYBER ATTACK (V Colgan) – Trainer T Pike advised that the gelding pulled up well and had now been sent for a spell. **Race 8 - LIVAMOL CLASSIC (2040m)**

SAINT EMILION (L Innes) – Co-trainer A Forsman advised that they were satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is their intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 9 - RED BADGE SPRING SPRINT (1400m)

UGO FOSCOLO (D Johnson) – Trainer S Marsh advised that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is their intention continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 STANLEY GROUP 1600

OUR KATY CRUZ (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

MR BAZAMOUR (A Calder) - Began awkwardly then crowded.

GRAND EAGLE (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly, had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

VERNANME (D Johnson) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

SUSPENSE (T Thornton) - Over raced in the early to middle stages, had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

STEVIE'S SURPRISE (R Smyth) - Over raced in the early to middle stages, made the bend awkwardly passing the 300 metres.

TROUBADOUR (J Nason) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

LORD VALENTINE (D Hain) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

JUST A PHOEBE (R Norvall) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses. A postrace veterinary examination found the mare to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia with the appropriate veterinary clearance required prior to racing again.

Race 2 MATAMATA MITRE 10 1600

MORRELLMAC (S Spratt) - Slow to begin (2L).

MOD MAUDE (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin.

MI PIACI (A Sims) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

KOOL CONNECTION (A Calder) - Raced three wide without cover.

BELLA BLUE (A Goindasamy) - Held up near the 300 metres before being angled outwards abruptly across heels passing the 200 metres apprentice Goindasamy being shown film footage of his ride in the presence of the National Riding Mentor.

STAR ELLA (T Thornton) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

DE KONING (L Satherley) - Made contact with ADIS after being taken out by DREAM ON near the 300 metres.

ADIS (D Johnson) - Bumped 300 metres.

CHARLI ROSE (M Cameron) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses. A postrace veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 3 G & S MCKENZIE LTD TRANSPORT 1400

VENTURA (A Calder) - Raced in restricted room shortly after leaving the barriers, had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 100 metres.

INDIAN MAID (D Danis) - Slow to begin, was unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

JON WICK (M Cameron) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after over racing in the lead, the gelding had failed to see out the 1400 metre distance of today's race.

SAINT CROIX (K Cowan) - Raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres.

MOET MOLLY (S Spratt) - Checked when placed in restricted room near the 250 metres when GAZARRA (L Satherley) was commencing to shift outwards before being corrected along with inward movement from TOODALOO which was taken in by DIRECT CAPITAL (A Goindasamy) which lay in under pressure. L Satherley and A Goindasamy were advised to exercise care.

GAZZARA (L Satherley) - Held up near the 250 metres.

OUR MCKAY (D Johnson) - Held up near the 250 metres until passing the 150 metres.

Race 4 FAIRVIEW MOTORS MATAMATA 1400

RIP EM UP (D Johnson) - Shifted outwards abruptly after leaving the barriers, raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages and had a tendency to hang outwards, ran wide making the final bend.

NULLI SECUNDUS (R Smyth) - Hampered leaving the barriers when forced wide, raced wide without cover throughout, shifted out slightly passing the 175 metres making contact and becoming briefly unbalanced.

ELATE (S Collett) - Began awkwardly then crowded losing ground.

FAZIOLO (L Innes) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

RAZOR (J Fawcett) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

BLUE ON BLACK (G Cooksley) - Began awkwardly, over raced badly in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that gelding had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure after over-racing.

DAWN PATROL (O Bosson) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages to obtain cover.

NOTABADIDEA (J Bayliss) - Shifted inwards slightly making contact passing the 150 metres.

Race 5COMAG LTD 1600BERGERAC (S Spratt) - Crowded shortly after jumping away.

RED SKY AT NIGHT (A Calder) - Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground, held up passing the 300 metres and continued to have difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race.

MANHATTAN FLAME (G Cooksley) - Began awkwardly.

MOTUMAN (J Nason) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with BLUETWENTYTWO, when racing in restricted room shortly after the start, got its head up and again made contact with BLUETWENTYTWO unbalancing both runners resulting in MOTUMAN having to be checked when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of QIAN GUA.

BLUETWENTYTWO (K Cowan) - Contacted start and again shortly after the start being unbalanced.

TIPICAL (D Johnson) - Raced three wide without cover, hampered near the 250 metres when TWEEDLEDEE lay in under pressure.

TWEEDLEDEE (S Collett) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

QIAN GUA (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding performance, rider could not offer any excuses advising that the gelding had felt a beaten runner prior to entering the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination found the gelding to be lame in the right hind leg.

Race 6 TEAM WEALLEANS MATAMATA CUP (1600)

DELUXE EDITION (R Scott) - Began awkwardly.

SHERRIF (D Johnson) - Began awkwardly.

WOODSMAN (A Jones) - Raced three wide without cover.

PETITE EN JEU (T Thornton) - Race keenly in the early to middle stages. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had been quickly beaten when placed under pressure and had been disappointing. Trainer N Auret advised that he would have the mare vetted on return to his stable.

B R Jones - Issued with a warning regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 7 RUSSELL & YVONNE GREEN MEMORIAL 1200

SLEEPING BEAUTY (D Danis) - Lay out in the early stages shifting out passing the 950 metres hampering GLORIOUS BEIJING which lost ground.

GLORIOUS BEIJING (S Collett) - Hampered 950 metres losing ground, crowded 150 metres.

ROLL THE GOLD (J Fawcett) - Jumped away awkwardly, had a tendency to over race in the early and middle stages becoming awkwardly placed inside heels for a distance passing the 750 metres being steadied, again becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 500 metres.

ROSA CAROLINA (D Johnson) - Eased down approaching the 400 metres after commencing to give ground and retired from the race having bled from both nostrils. Connections advised the mare will now been retired from racing.

CRAFTY JESS (M Cameron) - Rider reported that the mare had felt sore after pulling up with a post-race veterinary inspection revealing the mare to be lame in the right fore-leg. Co-trainer A Forsman was advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing again.

J Fawcett - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards under pressure crowding GLORIOUS BEIJING onto MAJIC OF THE SUN near the 150 metres.

MAJIC OF THE SUN - Crowded 150 metres.

Race 8COLCHESTER ENGINEERING LTD 2000SULIMAN (S Collett) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SWITCH IN TIME (G Cooksley) - Raced three wide without cover.

G Cooksley - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards crowding WOODEN EDGE near the 1600 metres.

WOODEN EDGE (K Cowan) - Crowded 1600 metres, held up near the 250 metres.

ALI BABA (J Bayliss) - Held up entering the final straight and did not obtain clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 200 metres.

Race 9 MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES LTD 2000

MODEL AYE (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin, held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

COOL CASSIE (A Sims) - Raced wide without cover.

EL JODI (D Danis) - Raced in restricted room approaching the 1900 metres then steadied, held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

AONGATETE EXPRESS (A Calder) - Held up rounding the final turn before obtaining clear running near the 250 metres.

FLY TO THE MOON (J Bayliss) - Raced in restricted room rounding the bend passing the 400 metres making contact with the hind quarters of SECONDS OUT which was unbalanced and turned inwards, further crowding FLY TO THE MOON which was checked.

SECONDS OUT (M Hashizume) - Unbalanced and turned inwards when received contact to hind quarters rounding the bend near the 400 metres.

BABOONSKI (D Hain) - Unable to obtain clear running over the final 150 metres.

VAINGLORY (S Collett) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after getting back as instructed from its wide draw the mare had been forced very wide having to do too much work when attempting to improve into the race rounding the final bend.
