Race 3 LAMB-PETERS PRINT MAIDEN 1000 (1000 Metres)

MI GOLD CARD (L Allpress) – Trainer J Shaw advised Stewards that the gelding underwent further veterinary examination in the days following this race which revealed it to be suffering from shin soreness.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1000 Metres)

MAGICO (L Allpress) – Trainer J Brenner advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare adding it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Matamata Racing Club - 13 October 2018

Race 5 COMAG LTD 1600

QIAN GUA (O Bosson) – Trainer J Richards advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding adding it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 6 TEAM WEALLEANS MATAMATA CUP (1600)

PETITE EN JEU (T Thornton) – Trainer N Auret advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the mare adding it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 7 RUSSELL & YVONNE GREEN MEMORIAL 1200

CRAFTY JESS (M Cameron) - Trainer A Forsman advised Stewards that in the days following this race the mare underwent further veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality, adding that CRAFTY JESS would remain on box rest in the coming days before being reassessed.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 MAINFREIGHT 2200

FLYINGWITHOUTWINGS (R Norvall) – Slow to begin. Firmly restrained off heels passing the 2100 metres.

TURO DE POTENCO (D Danis) – Slow to begin. Raced wide until near the 1200 metres.

BANKS ROAD (A Calder) – Began awkwardly and then was steadied. Commenced to over-race when being steadied off heels near the 2000 metres.

CASSIO (C Lammas) – Crowded and hampered passing the 2000 metres by LAKE SUPERIOR which shifted in when being steadied to avoid the heels of BURDOCVELVETPRINCE which was also steadied. CASSIO then over-raced for a distance.

BURDOCVELVETPRINCE (J Nason) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 2000 metres, and then over-raced for a distance.

MAMBA (M Cameron) – Commenced to over-race for a distance when being steadied passing the 2100 metres which dropped back on to FLYINGWITHOUTWINGS which had to be firmly restrained off heels.

CANZAC (L Satherley) – Steadied and shifted out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels forcing GO GO GOAL wider on the track near the 1900 metres.

GO GO GOAL (J Riddell) – Hampered and forced wide near the 1900 metres.

DISRAELI (A Goindasamy) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 2 DONAGHYS UDDER MAX 1200

GOLDEN SUN (S Collett) – Slow to begin, then commenced to over-race for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

CHURCH ROAD (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

MY GALATINE (D Danis) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the filly had raced very greenly on debut and may appreciate some easing of the ground. A post-race veterinary inspection found the filly to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia and a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing next.

ITS ALL FAKE NEWS (J Nason) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BRAVISSIMO (J Fawcett) – Held up rounding the final bend until shifting out near the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

THE LAST WORD (D Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight until shifting out passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running.

THE BUZZ (L Innes) – Rider L Innes reported that his saddle had shifted early in the running which had placed him at a disadvantage.

Race 3 NOTTINGHAM CASTLE HOTEL 1200

MASTER FRECKLES (A Sims) – Escaped riderless under the front of the barriers and was late scratched at 12-59 pm. Trainer S Rees was advised that MASTER FRECKLES is required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. A post-race veterinary examination revealed superficial skin abrasions near the withers on both sides with swelling.

DAWON (D Danis) – Began awkwardly losing considerable ground.

YULONG LANSON (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

STARMAN (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GOLDCHI (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

GRANDE AMICI (B Grylls) – Held up rounding the final turn and early in the final straight.

STARMAN (S Collett) – Lay in and away from NEW LAWS becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ESPRESSO MARTINI having to be steadied passing the 200 metres.

RUSALKA (T Thornton) – Rider T Thornton dropped her whip passing the 150 metres.

NEW LAWS (O Bosson) and **ESPRESSO MARTINI** (M Cameron) – Made contact over the concluding stages when both runners shifted ground.

Race 4 DONAGHYS PRO-DAIRY 1400

PAQUITA (J Nason) – Began awkwardly then hampered losing ground.

SAHAR (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly.

OPERATOR (S Rusof) – Began awkwardly then crowded. Had to be firmly restrained passing the 1200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels and dropped back on to MONT VENTOUX which had to be firmly restrained off that runner's heels. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 650 metres.

MONT VENTOUX (A Calder) – Slow to begin. Firmly restrained off heels passing the 1200 metres.

FLAUNT IT GIRL (S McKay) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of MASETTO which shifted in when not fully clear near the 1000 metres.

LET ME TELL YA (D Johnson) – Held up until shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

PRINCE ALBERT (J Bayliss) – Lay in near the 450 metres making contact with OPERATOR which became briefly unbalanced, with the colt continuing to lay in under pressure for the remainder of the race. Rider J Bayliss dropped his whip near the 350 metres.

ELEANOR RIGBY (M Cameron) – Briefly held up early in the final straight having to shift out to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.

MONGOLIAN SPIRIT (O Bosson) – Commenced to give ground near the 250 metres and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. Rider advised that the colt had raced keenly throughout, and was unable to offer any reason for the colt's performance. The colt underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 5 DAILYFREIGHT 1400

DAM RELIABLE (M Cameron) – Slow to begin.

PERFECTLY TUNED (A Calder) – Began awkwardly. Hampered 900 metres.

DESIGNEDTOIMPRESS (J Nason) – Began awkwardly.

MANRICO (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly, and then was steadied from its wide barrier. Commenced to race keenly from near the 1200 metres making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres losing ground and hampering PERFECTLY TUNED. MANRICO continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages. Shifted out across heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres inconveniencing DISPATCHED.

RELIABLE BELLE (M Coleman) - Lost the right hind plate during the running.

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (S Collett) – Briefly held up early in the final straight having to shift out across heels to obtain clear running.

DISPATCHED (C Lammas) – Lay in under pressure passing the 200 metres.

Race 6 DONAGHYS N-BOOST 1400

SODA (B Grylls) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded losing ground, then raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early to middle stages. Made the corner awkwardly passing the 900 metres hampering GLENDALOUGH. Shifted across heels to obtain clear running near the 400 metres.

GLENDALOUGH (S Rusof) – Hampered when forced wide leaving the barriers. Hampered 900 metres.

PLUSHENKO (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.

GRANT (S Collett) – Crowded leaving the barriers and steadied.

SKAABOOM (M Coleman) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.

THE HAMMER (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BIRDIE BLITZ (C Lammas) – Held up until shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.

CLUTCH CARGO (L Innes) – Held up for clear running until passing the 250 metres.

CHARLIE ZULU (R Elliot) – Briefly held up early in the final straight.

Race 7 DONAGHYS PRO-EQUINE 1400

MAESTRO BLU (A Sims) – Very slow to begin. Trainer S Rees was advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding.

ROCK WITH CHOUX (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded losing ground.

SWISS MAID (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover.

MANGAROA DIVA (J Nason) – Commenced to hang out rounding the bend into the final straight finishing wide on the track. Trainer was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare for its racing manners.

THE GOOD FIGHT (J Riddell) – Held up for clear running until passing the 200 metres.

ACRE (S Collett) – Held up for clear running near the 200 metres.

SLEEPY GEEG (R Norvall) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and upon veterinary inspection was confirmed to be a bleeder, and as such is unable to be in training for two months and unable to race or trial for three months with a veterinary clearance required prior to racing or trialing next. Trainer N Elliott indicated that the gelding would now be retired.

CONQUERING KELLY (B Grylls) – Shifted out over the concluding stages crowding and hampering BARZELLAR before being corrected by its rider. Rider B Grylls was issued with a warning.

BARZELLAR (M Coleman) – Crowded and hampered concluding stages.

WHEAO (J Riddell) – Dislodged its rider when commencing its preliminary and escaped galloping some distance before				
being captured, then being declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 3.53 pm.				

WITHARMSWIDEOPEN (R Norvall) – Slow to begin.

EN SOIE (T Thornton) – Hampered leaving the barriers losing ground. Had to be firmly restrained approaching the 1100 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance, and dropped back on to MASTER PAINTON which had to be firmly restrained. Unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.

MCHALE (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly.

AZAMOUR QUEEN (J Nason) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barriers and was steadied. Raced wide without cover throughout.

MASTER PAINTON (C Lammas) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Held up for clear running until passing the 200 metres.

TINTERO (M Cameron) – Placed in restricted room to the inside of MCHALE which shifted in and away from AZAMOUR QUEEN near the 900 metres. Unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

CARRELEUR (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

PICTURE THIS (S Rusof) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 250 metres.

YATIMA (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses with a postrace veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 9 DONAGHYS PURE FLUSH 1400

SUPERA (D Johnson) – Blundered badly leaving the barriers badly unbalancing its rider and losing considerable ground.

THE BOY WONDER (J Bayliss) – Crowded leaving the barrier.

DONIZETTI (K Chowdhoory) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barrier.

DELEGATE (K Cowan) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barrier.

ENDEAN EXPRESS (C Lammas) – Inconvenienced on a number of occasions approaching the 200 metres and forced wider by DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC which shifted out under pressure.

DELEGATE (K Cowan) – Disappointed for a run approaching the 200 metres when improving on to the heels of DONIZETTI which shifted in under pressure.

INCA WARRIOR (J Fawcett) – Crowded and checked 100 metres. Lost the left front plate during the running.

The connections of the third placed runner INCA WARRIOR (J Fawcett) lodged a protest alleging interference by the second placed runner DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC (N Bakar) near the 100 metres. After viewing relevant videos and hearing submissions from the connections the protest was dismissed.

N Bakar DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed DON'TBLAMETHEMUSIC to shift out when insufficiently clear into the line of INCA WARRIOR which was checked near the 100 metres. N Bakar was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 19 October up to and including racing on 2 November, 8 riding days.

Race 10 DONAGHYS TASMAN TIM 20 YEARS 1400

ALL KNITTED UP (T Newman) – Knuckled leaving the barrier. Crowded approaching the 900 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of HYPNOS which lay in when being steadied off heels.

FINE BOUQUET (S Rusof) – Briefly crowded approaching the 700 metres by IAGO which lay in despite the efforts of its rider.

LOWRIDER (R Scott) – Became unbalanced approaching the 600 metres shifting back on to HYPNOS which shifted out to avoid heels. Went off stride passing the 500 metres losing ground.

S McKay LINK ROAD – Rider S McKay was questioned regarding his riding tactics adopted during the race, in particular why he had asked LINK ROAD to improve forward at a fast pace in the early to middle stages. S McKay explained that

his instructions had been to lead, but agreed with Stewards that he had made an error of judgement, and was advised that he would be expected to show better judgement in future.

Race 11 CELEBRATING 20 YEARS WITH DONAGHYS 1400

FLOURISHING (S Collett) – Began awkwardly making contact and losing ground. Held up early in the final straight. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. Underwent post-race veterinary inspection which revealed a laceration in the right nostril.

TOBI (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly and then was restrained.

PURSUED (A Calder) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

KING KANE (N Bakar) – Steadied when in restricted room early in the final straight. Lost the left front plate during the running.

FLORENCE IVY (K Cowan) – Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 300 metres.

KONSTANTINA (M Cameron) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 250 metres.

SIMPLY IMPECCABLE (O Bosson) – Was not persevered with in the final straight being retired from the race, rider O Bosson advising that the gelding had been making abnormal breathing noises and felt to have choked down. A post-race veterinary inspection, including an endoscopic examination, did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer D Guy advised that she would be giving consideration to the gelding's racing future in consultation with the owners.
