Racing Te Aroha - 17 October 2018

Race 8 DONAGHYS PRO-ABAMAC 1400

YATIMA (D Johnson) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that in the days following this race the mare was showing signs of shin soreness and will now be sent for a spell.

Race 11 CELEBRATING 20 YEARS WITH DONAGHYS 1400

SIMPLY IMPECCABLE (O Bosson) – Trainer D Guy advised Stewards that she was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding adding that it is now the connections intentions to export it to Macau.

Racing Tauranga - 19 October 2018

Race 5 RYAN & ALEXANDER RECRUITMENT

PODRAVINA (M Cameron) – Trainer A Forsman advised Stewards that in the days following this race the mare was showing signs of being jarred up and will now be sent for a spell.

ALPHASTAR (D Danis) - Trainer W Hillis advised Stewards that the mare has now been retired.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 SSANGYONG 1200

SHORT FUSE (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

LADY AMADEUS (M Coleman) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance trainer S Autridge advised that after attempting to ride the mare quietly today LADY AMADEUS had become disinterested. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.

SHE'S NOT BAD (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly.

O'SAM (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.

O'PRINCESS (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.

TOITOI (S Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

SEDUTTORE (J Bayliss) – Raced four wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BEYOND DISPUTE (J Waddell) – Attempted a marginal run to the inside of BELLINSKY having to be steadied for a distance when BELLINSKY shifted in passing the 200 metres. Also inconvenienced was KAILANI SUNSET.

KAILANI SUNSET (M Cameron) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.

BELLINSKY (A Calder) – Hampered 200 metres. Lay out over the concluding stages making contact with TOKYO LIL.

TOKYO LIL (S Rusof) – Held up until approaching the 350 metres, then when shifting out into a run ahead was then crowded near the 200 metres to the inside of SHE'S NOT BAD (O Bosson) which shifted in when not sufficiently clear. Also hampered in this incident was BELLINSKY.

O Bosson - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed SHE'S NOT BAD to shift in when not sufficiently clear if TOKYO LIL passing the 200 metres, also hampered in this incident was BELLINSKY. After viewing all relevant

videos and hearing submissions O Bosson licence was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 27 October up to and including racing on 4 November, 5 national riding days.

Race 2 DUNSTAN FEEDS 1200

SHE'S FOXY (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Improved into a marginal run passing the 50 metres.

ELLE D'BERRY (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly and then was hampered losing ground. Bumped and unbalanced shortly after the start.

SPRING BOUQUET (S Rusof) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Angled in towards the inside shortly after the start, making contact with the hind quarters of ELE D'BERRY, which became briefly unbalanced.

CHOUX A STAR (R Scott) – Made the 900 metre bend awkwardly.

MUSICAL BLUES (M Coleman) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

FLYING FLAME (O Bosson) – Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages having to be steadied between CANTSTOPTHEFEELING and MUSICAL BLUES which both shifted ground.

STILTON (L Satherley) – Improved into a marginal run over the concluding stages.

Race 3 MOUNT SHOP 1200

CONTRARY MARY (A Calder) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

RIDING THE WAVE (L Innes) – Began awkwardly.

QUICK PREVIEW (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up entering the final straight, and again passing the 200 metres.

RIPPEDEEDOODAH (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MCEDITH (S Rusof) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of QUICK PREVIEW which had to shift out off the heels of SPEED AND EXPEL which had been taken out slightly by IT'S DOABLE passing the 400 metres. Held up until shifting out passing the 250 metres to obtain clear running.

IT'S DOABLE (B Grylls) - Held up rounding the bend into the final straight.

RIDING THE WAVE (L Innes) – Held up until near the 200 metres.

PERSISTENCE (S Collett) – Steadied when placed in restricted room for a distance passing the 300 metres.

Race 4 OSCAR ON MAIN 1200

WILD SEAS (J Bayliss) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE REFLEX (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CHLOE'S CASH (S McKay) – Slow to begin.

LAURANT (S Rusof) - Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 300 metres.

MARKLE (L Innes) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

PAUL'S SUPER ARIKI (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse advising that the gelding had been disappointing.

Race 5 HAUNUI FARM 1200

WAIWETU LASS (J Bayliss) - Slow to begin.

MONACO (V Colgan) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers. Hung out around the bend.

THEE MADAME (L Satherley) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.

RED SENNA (C Lammas) – Became awkwardly placed inside heels for a distance approaching the 800 metres.

WITCHERY (O Bosson) – When shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 450 metres dictated SNITZ OF TIME and MADURO wider on the track. Shifted out passing the 400 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

Race 6 ROGER GILL AGRICULTURE 1200

SILVER CLOUD (S Collett) - Raced fiercely in the early to middle stages when being restrained.

HAMMER KING (C Lammas) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BEVAN STREET (J Waddell) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 500 metres dictating SILVER CLOUD wider on the track.

I AM GRACIE (J Fawcett) – Held up passing the 400 metres having to shift out across heels to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

SACRED CHARM (L Innes) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight. Rider reported that the mare felt indifferent in its action. A subsequent post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 7 SPLICE CONSTRUCTION 1400

TAV IT UP (C Lammas) - Began awkwardly.

CHURCH ROAD (T Thornton) - Crowded start.

NEVER BACK DOWN (S Rusof) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

WAINAMU (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to over-race when being steadied for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Made the 900 metre bend awkwardly.

PALAZZO ROYALE (S Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TIGER SILK (A Calder) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend awkwardly near the 850 metres. When questioned into the performance rider advised the filly had raced greenly, but otherwise was disappointing.

AMAZING BELLE (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and following a veterinary inspection was confirmed to be a bleeder, and as such is now ineligible to be in training for a period of two months and can not trial or race for a period of three months, with a veterinary clearance required prior to trialing or racing following that period.

RIP 'N' BURN (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

QUALITY PREVAILS (B Grylls) – Returned to the enclosure with a small amount of blood present in the left nostril. After undergoing a post-race veterinary examination, the filly was found to have sustained a minor laceration consistent with having struck its head in the barriers.

Race 8 FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1400

BLADE RUNNER (B R Jones) – Began awkwardly. Became awkwardly placed when improving on to heels passing the 700 metres and was hampered shifting back on to BAYEUX which was also hampered.

ZENNTARI (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

BAYEUX (S Rusof) – Slow to begin. Placed in restricted room passing the 1200 metres, and then was hampered when shifting out across the heels of TOP TRUMPS which was dictated in slightly by BLADE RUNNER which was steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of WILLIAM SCOTT which was steadying to avoid HEZA BIG HOPE which was shifting out when hanging. Riders B R Jones and L Satherley were both advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. Hampered 700 metres.

HEZA BIG HOPE (J Bayliss) – Commenced to hang outwards soon after leaving the barriers, then running wider when making the bend passing the 800 metres, and continuing to hang out then being eased down by its rider. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality with trainer S Ritchie being advised that the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

DIAMONDSANDBUBBLES (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

NOCTURNAL (S McKay) – Bumped and unbalanced passing the 450 metres by WILLIAM SCOTT which shifted out to obtain clear running. J Waddell was advised that he must exercise greater care.

Race 9 ITM AUCKLAND SUPERSPRINT 2-4 NOV 1400

NOTHINGLEFTTOLOSE (R Smyth) – Began awkwardly. Shifted out under pressure passing the 400 metres forcing REEVEDERCI outwards into the line of LIPS OF AN ANGEL which then shifted out inconveniencing MERCY HILL.

EASY WALKING (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

GOBONIEGO (J Bayliss) – Began awkwardly. Held up for clear running until passing the 200 metres.

REEVEDERCI (L Innes) – Slow away. Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages shifting out approaching the 1000 metres hampering NOTHINGLEFTTOLOSE.

MERCY HILL (A Calder) – Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages getting its head up and shifting out passing the 700 metres, racing wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

MOTIVATION (O Bosson) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

LIPS OF AN ANGEL (J Waddell) – Inconvenienced 400 metres.

DON BLANCO (B Grylls) – Unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.

SACRED SIREN (C Lammas) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

Rider L Satherley SPLENDIDO – Dropped her whip passing the 250 metres.

Race 10 COUNTIES CUP DAY 24TH NOVEMBER 1600

QIJI DAN (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly. Crowded approaching the 1500 metres having to steady. Pulled up noticeably lame in the right foreleg. After undergoing a post-race veterinary examination, it was found that the gelding had a suspected fracture of the right fore fetlock and would be transported to the veterinary centre to undergo further examination and x-rays. A veterinary clearance will be required prior to racing next.

HUNUA HANK (S Collet) – Began awkwardly. Unable to obtain clear running until passing the 200 metres.

CURIOUS GEORGE (S Rusof) – Inconvenienced 1400 metres when forced wider.

EKRAAR LASS (A Goindasamy) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages, then raced three wide without cover.

SAHAR (M Cameron) – Held up early in the final straight.

MISS PACIFIC (C Lammas) – Attempted a marginal run passing the 400 metres, and then had to be steadied and shift out across heels to obtain clear running near the 250 metres.

J Waddell VERNANME – Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he allowed VERNANME to shift out forcing ETCH into the line of OUR KATY CRUZ which clipped a heel and blundered near the 400 metres. After viewing relevant videos and hearing submissions J Waddell's licence was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 27 October up to and including racing on 8 November, 8 national riding days.
