QJI DAN (T Thornton) – Transported to a veterinary clinic for further examination and was humanely euthanased after an x-ray found the gelding to have suffered a fracture to the right fore fetlock.

<p>FELAR (D Johnson) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>DELUXE EDITION (R Scott) – Raced wide without cover until near the 1300 metres.</p> <p>BLUETWENTYTWO (L Innes) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>REPO SUN (T Yanagida) – Held up until near the 300 metres.</p> <p>JOE'S LEGACY (S McKay) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.</p> <p>FINAL SUGGESTION (S Spratt) – When questioned Rider S Spratt could offer no tangible excuse for the performance other than the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.</p>	
Race 2	Partners Life 880
<p>HAPPINESS FOREVER (R Norvall) – Knuckled soon after leaving the barriers.</p> <p>NOT EVEN 'OW (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly. Hampered and forced wide 600 metres.</p> <p>O'CHARM (M Coleman) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barriers. Raced keenly through the middle stages shifting out approaching the 600 metres to avoid heels forcing NOT EVEN 'OW and MISS FENDT wide on the track.</p> <p>ROSARITO (R Smyth) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers losing ground. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 500 metres losing ground.</p> <p>MISS FENDT (R Elliot) – Forced wide 600 metres.</p> <p>COINTREAU (A Calder) - Lost the off hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	IRT 1400
<p>SISTABEEL (L Innes) – Slow to begin. Held up entering the final straight and shifted in approaching the 300 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (M Coleman) – Crowded soon after leaving the barriers losing ground. Raced in restricted room approaching the 300 metres.

ANICETA (O Bosson) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

SHE'S PRISMATIC (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MONEY TRAIL (T Yanagida) – Held up early in the final straight.

PINK GRAFFITI (V Colgan) – Became awkwardly placed when laying in approaching the 300 metres.

Race 4

Mondiale 1400

STACCATO (R Elliot) – Crowded soon after jumping away losing ground.

NOT USUAL HEART (V Colgan) – Slow to begin then crowded and steadied.

VOLER POUR MOI (T Yanagida) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SWISSWATCH (E McCall) – Apprentice Rider E McCall was questioned regarding her riding tactics and more specifically why she had not restrained the gelding to take a sit passing the 1200 metres when there was an opportunity to do so. Apprentice Rider E McCall explained that her riding instructions had been to lead and after improving to the outside of HATTON GARDEN near the 1200 metres she had not anticipated HATTON GARDEN racing so keenly when challenged for the lead and developing in to a speed duel for a distance. E McCall's explanation was noted.

BEAUTY WAY (T Harris) – Shifted in under pressure approaching the 200 metres dictating SAVE THE DATE wider on the track.

SAVE THE DATE (L Innes) – Forced wide approaching 200 metres.

Following the race Rider **D Johnson** was stood down by the course doctor after becoming unwell. D Johnson is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

Race 5

Logistics Group 1600

ANDOYAS (O Bosson) – Blundered when leaving the barriers making heavy contact with the side of the barrier with O Bosson suffering an injury to his foot as a result. ANDOYAS was then quickly pulled up with **O Bosson** being stood down from his remaining rides.

ROCETTE LADY (S Spratt) – Jumped away awkwardly. Eased down from near the 200 metres and returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A veterinary examination deemed the mare to have bled with ROCETTE LADY now being stood down from trialing or racing for 3 months in New Zealand and training for 2 months and with a veterinary clearance also required.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (V Colgan) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

AUGUST EDITION (E McCall) – Raced wide from near the 800 metres.

DEMONETIZATION (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding the performance M Coleman advised that the horse had not felt entirely comfortable in its action when asked for an effort in the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

Race 6	Partners Life Soliloquy Stakes (1400 metres)
<p>MAGIC CONDOR (S Spratt) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground. Contacted and briefly unbalanced passing the 1200 metres by POWER OF STRENGTH which shifted in abruptly.</p> <p>ELATE (R Elliot) – Raced in restricted room soon after leaving the barriers and was steadied.</p> <p>QUEEN OF THE AIR (D Danis) – Commenced to race keenly passing the 1100 metres shifting out to avoid heels. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p>NULLI SECUNDUS (R Smyth) – Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1000 metres. Steadied approaching the 600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed, shifting out making contact with ELATE.</p> <p>VALALIE (L Innes) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>ROCKET FUEL (A Calder) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres making brief contact with ANNIE OKAY.</p>	
Race 7	South Auckland Racing Club Cup (1400 metres)
<p>UGO FOSCOLO (M Coleman) – Jumped away awkwardly shifting out abruptly and losing ground. Raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres and again shifted out abruptly. Rider M Coleman advised that the gelding had proven difficult to ride throughout and had become disinterested.</p> <p>RONCHI (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>YEARN (S McKay) – Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>SULTAN OF SWING (L Innes) – Eased down by its rider from near the 600 metres with L Innes reporting that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality. Trainer S Ritchie was advised that SULTAN OF SWING will be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p>TIPTRONIC (T Thornton) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider T Thornton could offer no excuse other than the gelding may not have been suited to the addition of blinkers today.</p>	
Race 8	Coverstaff 2400
<p>MODEL AYE (D Mansour) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final turn. Had to steady when crowded near the 100 metres to the outside of AONGATETE EXPRESS which was taken out slightly by PEARLESCENCE (T Yanagida). Apprentice Rider T Yanagida was advised that he must exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>UNVEILING (A Jones) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>PRINCE JABEEL (L Innes) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Came together with REDCAYENNE on a number of occasions over the final 150 metres when both runners had a tendency to shift ground.</p> <p>SURREY (R Elliot) – When questioned regarding the performance Apprentice Rider R Elliot advised that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in its action when asked to quicken in the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.</p>
