Race 5 - VERNON & VAZEY 1400

A Goindasamy (POKER QUEEN) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted his mount POKER QUEEN to shift in near the 1100 metres when insufficiently clear of ON THE DOT which was checked with the Judicial Committee suspending his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on November 7th up to and including racing on the 14th November, 5 National riding days.

Race 7 - NZB Insurance Pear Series Race

CASTLEREIGH (A Goindasamy) - An inquiry was concluded into the circumstances surrounding CASTLEREIGH clipping a heel and blundering passing the 800 metres dislodging rider A Goindasamy with video footage and evidence taken from riders proving inconclusive.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 SUNLIVE MAIDEN (1200 metres)

MOIRAS TOWN (R Smyth) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied when awkwardly placed near the 900 metres. Held up entering the final straight. Held up for a distance passing the 200 metres until near the 100 metres.

HETTY (T Yanagida) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained from the barrier. Held up early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 200 metres.

SIMPLY SACRED (L Innes) – Steadied when in restricted room passing the 1000 metres. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

SUPERSTATIC (V Colgan) – Had to shift out to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

ELLEMAECLAMPET (A Jones) – Raced wide in the early stages. Crowded and checked passing the 50 metres between MOIRAS TOWN which was dictated in slightly by SUPERSTATIC which shifted away from DONNA IMELDA (M Coleman) which had lay in despite the efforts of its rider and slight outward movement by SIMPLY SACRED (L Innes). M Coleman and L Innes were both advised to exercise care in a similar circumstances.

Race 2 CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES – NOVEMBER 17 (1200 metres)

TAMMIE WYNETT (M Cameron) – Bumped becoming unbalanced leaving the barrier.

ITS ALL FAKE NEWS (V Colgan) – Bumped becoming unbalanced leaving the barrier. Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the middle stages shifting out to avoid heels passing the 750 metres, hampered as a result was GARADOS.

YAMUNA (S McKay) – Crowded and steadied shortly after jumping away.

LAURAMIA (S Spratt) - Slow away. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 200 metres.

GARADOS (M Coleman) - Hampered 750 metres.

CAILIN (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

HONORA (R Scott) – Steadied 800 metres when awkwardly placed.

Race 3 CLASSIC CUISINE CATERING (1400 metres)

EL COOLIO (L Innes) - Slow away.

HOOF HEFNER (D Prastiyou) - Began awkwardly.

TOBI (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

POPPY STAR (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly. Briefly steadied when awkwardly placed 350 metres.

RASPBERRY SWEET (M Hashizume) - Became unbalanced shortly after leaving the barrier. Raced wide without cover throughout. Lost a plate during the running.

PERSUED (A Calder) - Raced keenly passing the 1000 metres for a distance then became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 850 metres and was hampered shifting back onto CODECRACKER which was also hampered.

CODECRACKER (M Coleman) - Hampered 850 metres.

MASU (S Collett) - Raced in restricted room passing the 150 metres.

Race 4 OASIS BAR & GRILL (2100 metres)

FLY TO THE MOON (J Bayliss) - Slow away. Commenced to over race when being steadied passing the 1700 metres and continued to so for a distance.

UABASSO (A Calder) – Lay in making contact with the running rail passing the 1800 metres. Held up for a distance until shifting out passing the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

MISS CAMPBELL (D Prastiyou) - Raced wide without cover.

PRODIGAL SON (R Elliot) – When questioned regarding the performance Apprentice Rider R Elliot could offer no tangible excuses. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 5 MILLS REEF WINERY (1300 metres)

VEINE D'OR (M Cameron) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up entering the final straight then shifted ground passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

DAMA ZORRO (L Innes) – Crowded soon after leaving the barrier losing ground. L Innes reported the mare had pulled up showing signs of lameness.

STANDING IN LINE (D Mansour) - Began awkwardly.

NEESON (S Spratt) - Crowded approaching the 1200 metres and steadied. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance Rider S Spratt advised that although the gelding had not been helped after being caught wide without cover further advising the gelding would derive benefit from today's run.

M Coleman (POWER DREAM) – Issued with a warning after permitting POWER DREAM to shift in passing the 1200 metres when insufficiently clear of NEESON which was crowded and steadied.

DESCENDANT (A Calder) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BEAUDEN (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously when being steadled off the heels near the 900 metres.

AILEEN GRACE (R Elliot) - Held up entering the final straight and had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 150 metres.

Race 6 CHESTERS PLUMBING & BATHROOM (1300 metres)

RICH BILLIE MARSH (R Scott) – Slow to begin then commenced to over-race soon after, shifting out approaching the 1200 metres hampering GIOVANNI CANALETTO then again shifted out approaching the 1100 metres to avoid heels, crowding CONSENSUS and then forcing EMBELLISH wider on the track. Apprentice Rider R Scott was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of RICH BILLIE MARSH.

GIOVANNI CANALETTO (S Collett) - Hampered 1200 metres.

EMBELLISH (L Innes) - Forced wide 1100 metres.

RESURRECT (T Newman) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CONSENSUS (S Spratt) – Had its hind quarters contacted passing the 1200 metres and then was further crowded by EMBELLISH which shifted in, CONSENSUS then raced in restricted room for a distance before being further crowded by RICH BILLIE MARSH which shifted out to avoid heels.

L Innes ((EMBELLISH) - Issued with a warning after allowing EMBELLISH to shift in passing the 1200 metres when insufficiently clear of CONSENSUS which was placed in restricted room for a distance.

Race 7 AON INSURANCE BROKERS (1600 metres)

KOOL CONNECTION (A Calder) – Slow away. Over-raced in the early stages.

JUST FOR KICKS (S McKay) - Lay in passing the 1000 metres placing PACQUIAO in restricted room.

PACQUIAO (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded 1000 metres. Improved onto heels approaching the 300 metres and was then hampered when attempting a run to the outside of SAFFRON LADY (J Bayliss) which shifted away from NABIAC (D Mansour) which shifted out slightly. D Mansour and J Bayliss were both advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. PACQUIAO was then held up until near the 200 metres.

Race 8 CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES – 14 DECEMBER (1600 metres)

RAKETO (J Bayliss) – Knuckled leaving the barrier shifting out hampering SASERELLO.

SASERELLO (R Elliot) - Hampered at start losing ground.

INITIATIVE (S McKay) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up early in the final straight until shifting out passing the 250 metres.

LAGERTHA (S Spratt) - Crowded and hampered 1400 metres.

L Innes (SKAABOOM) - Admitted a breach of careless riding in that he permitted SKAABOOM to shift in passing the 1400 metres when insufficiently clear of LAGERTHA which was hampered losing ground with the Judicial Committee suspending his license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 10th November to up to and including racing on the 16th November, 5 National riding days.

PAQUITA (D Danis) - Raced in restricted room passing the 1100 metres to the inside of LET ME TELL YA (M Coleman) which shifted in before being corrected by its rider. M Coleman was advised to exercise greater care when in a similar circumstances.

MALIBU MAGIC (A Calder) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting out passing the 300 metres.
