Auckland Racing Club – 6 November 2018

Race 6 OMF STAKES

BLUE BREEZE (S Spratt) – Trainer A Morley reported that post-race the gelding had pulled up in a distressed state with the gelding subsequently undegoing a post-race veterinary examination, on 7 November, which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer A Morley further advised that blood tests had been taken and undertook to advise Stewards of any abnormality.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 Shuttle 2000

ISKANDER (R Smyth) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared a late scratching at 12:41pm after it was found to be lame in the right hind leg. Connections were advised that the gelding would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing or trialing next.

PIGGY MALONE (A Calder) – Slow away. Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres.

RODOLFO (R Elliot) – Slow away.

ZENNTARI (D Danis) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SUSPENSE (T Thornton) – Raced wide until improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 1100 metres.

VOLANTIS (J Bayliss) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

CABALLERO (J Riddell) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 200 metres inconveniencing PIGGY MALONE.

Race 2 City 1200

HAVANA HEAT (L Satherley) – After becoming fractious in the barriers was removed undergoing a veterinary examination and was daclared a late scratching at 1:25pm.

DANCE CARD (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TICKADIVA (R Smyth) – Shifted in abruptly on jumping away hampering A PROPER LADY and MCEDITH.

A PROPER LADY (L Innes) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

MCEDITH (L Allpress) – Hampered on jumping away losing ground.

THORNERY (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider M Coleman advised that the filly had raced greenly, had found the line well late in the race and would improve with the experience.

Race 3 Supporters Club 1200

PUMBAAH (S McKay)- Began awkwardly losing ground.

BELLE SOUTH (L Allpress) – Slow away.

MARIJA (J Bayliss) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

OUR PROM KING (L Innes) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until passing the 250 metres.

ACUTUS (J Riddell) – Shifted out in an attempt to obtain clear running making contact with FULL SERVICE near the 350 metres.

FULL SERVICE (A Calder) – Bumped and forced wider near the 350 metres.

RUNNING MAN (S Collett) – Held up until near the 300 metres.

Race 4 NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race (1400 metres)

VICHY (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly shifting in forcing FIRE KATYUSHA in on to SIERRA VISTA which was hampered losing ground.

SIERRA VISTA (S Collett) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

MASSACHUSETTS (A Calder) – Slow away.

WESTERN GIRL (M Cameron) – Slow away.

O'DAHLIA (S Spratt) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

GRANDE AMICI (B Grylls) - Lay out when placed under pressure over the final 150 metres.

KELTIC ROCKSTAR (J Riddell) – Held up entering the final straight and shifted inwards in an attempt to obtain clear running. Was denied a run to the outside of MASSACHUSETTS which shifted out slightly near the 75 metres and then was held up for the remainder of the race.

BIRDIE BLITZ (S McKay) – Lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 5 Grand Central 1400

HUAYU UNIVERSE (C Lammas) – Blundered when leaving the barriers then was crowded shortly after losing ground.

SPEED CALL (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Shifted in near the 300 metres making contact with SWISS MAID. Had to be steadied when hampered near the 50 metres between SWISS MAID which lay out and CHARLIE ZULU which was forced inwards by THE BUZZ (S Mckay) which shifted in after being stuck with the whip before being corrected by its rider. S Mckay was advised to exercise care.

GOLDEN SUN (L Allpress) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Unable to obtain clear running throughout the final straight.

THE BUZZ (S McKay) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CHARLIE ZULU (M Coleman) – Came together with THE BUZZ when placed under pressure passing the 350 metres. Bumped and forced inward becoming unbalanced near the 50 metres.

DAMESEL (D Johnson) - Held up until near the 150 metres.

Payment was withheld due to the connections of the 5th placed runner CHARLIE ZULU wishing to view the video alleging interference by the 3rd placed runner THE BUZZ over the concluding stages, before electing not to proceed.

Race 6 AJC Members 1400

COME BACK TIGER (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

CLUTCH CARGO (V Colgan) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

NEW LAWS (O Bosson) – Held up until shifting out across heels to obtain clear running passing the 200 metres.

Race 7 West Brook 'Crackling Rose' 2017 – 1400

BET SHE IS (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

FINE BOUQUET (O Bosson) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied near the 1200 metres for a distance.

SMILING MORE (J Riddell) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

DON BLANCO (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover.

HYPNOS (M Coleman) – Raced keenly in the middle stages. Unable to obtain clear running for the majority of the final straight. M Coleman was questioned regarding his riding tactics, in particular approaching the 300 metres when

he had improved on to the back of ST ANDRE when there was an opportunity for him to continue to shift outwards and improve. M Coleman explained that approaching the 300 metres the rider of ST ANDRE had looked to his left and he had anticipated him shifting out and as a consequence had elected not to continue to improve into that run. M Coleman's explanation was noted.

Race 8 West Brook Wines 1600

SUPERA (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

REEVEDERCI (L Innes) – Shifted in abruptly on jumping away bumping TREASURE which steadied losing ground.

TREASURE (V Colgan) – Hampered at start losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages then had to be firmly restrained off heels near the 900 metres when placed in restricted room.

TAKE IT OUT (D Danis) – Had to be firmly restrained after improving on to heels passing the 800 metres.

KING'S CROSS (O Bosson) – Crowded when attempting to obtain clear running near the 350 metres by SUPERA (D Johnson) which shifted in before being corrected by its rider. Contributing to the incident was movement from SECRET AMBITION, then was held up until near the 250 metres. D Johnson was advised to exercise care.

Race 9 Western Line 2100

JIMMY ROCKET (M Coleman) – Slow away.

PEARLESCENCE (L Allpress) – Slow away.

BALLET CHOUX (S McKay) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

ROCANIC (A Jones) – Had to be steadied approaching the 600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

M Coleman (JIMMY ROCKET) – Was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.
