RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1DIPROSE MILLER 1600DUKE STREET (T Thornton) – Refused to enter the barriers and was declared a late scratching at 12.15pm. The
connections were advised that the gelding is required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing
next. Trainer advised the gelding would no longer be persevered with as a racing proposition.

MAESTRO BLU (C Lammas) – Slow away. Held up until approaching the 150 metres.

MASTER MARBRIDOU (S McKay) – Crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground.

CAVALLO ECCELLENTE (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the middle stages, then commenced to give ground over the final 200 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

DEZZY MAC (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

INCOGNITO (L Satherley) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 600 metres.

GOLDCHI (D Danis) – Forced wider approaching the 400 metres when FRIDAY WOOLFE shifted out. S Rusof was advised to exercise care.

Race 2 THAMES RACEDAY 3RD JANUARY 2019 1600

EN SOIE (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SHANPARK (S Collett) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

DELLE QUARTZA (B R Jones) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1400 metres when being restrained.

MONBEAU (C Lammas) – Had to be steadied near the 1350 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

DAWON (L Satherley) – Held up entering the final straight until near the 350 metres.

GLENDALOUGH (S Rusof) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight inconveniencing PATCH MAN passing the 200 metres, then shifted out abruptly passing the 100 metres again inconveniencing PATCH MAN.

PATCH MAN (J Bayliss) – Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres and again near the 100 metres.

EKRAAR LASS (D Johnson) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration in the left nostril.

J Bayliss (PATCH MAN) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear of MONBEAU near the 1350 metres.

Race 3 TWO TONES CATERING 1400

HOUSE OF CARTIER (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering MELARITA. Hampered near the 1300 metres.

MELARITA (S Collett) – Crowded and hampered at the start losing ground. Hampered near the 1300 metres. Raced wide without cover.

STAR KAREN (S Rusof) – Slow away.

LITE MY CIGAR (O Bosson) – Steadied to avoid heels near the 1300 metres. Held up until approaching the 100 metres.

PENTEVEREST (M Coleman) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

OHIYESA (B R Jones) – Hampered near the 1300 metres.

MEDALZA (D Johnson) – Hampered and shifted out to avoid heels near the 1300 metres.

J Bayliss (SHEEZANICEGIRL) – Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift in near the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of LITE MY CIGAR which had to steady shifting back on to MEDALZA which was checked. Also hampered as a result was OHIYESA, HOUSE OF CARTIER and MELARITA. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension of J Bayliss' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 17 November up to and including 25 November, 6 national days.

Race 4 WAIKATO & BOP HARNESS 12TH JANUARY 2019 1400

WILLIAM SCOTT (J Waddell) – Began awkwardly shifting out crowding SYMBIO and SUNNY ROSE with both those runners being hampered losing ground.

SYMBIO (C Lammas) – Hampered start losing ground. Steadied and shifted out becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 1100 metres inconveniencing CHOUX A STAR.

SUNNY ROSE (S McKay) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

BEASTMODE (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to race keenly in the middle stages.

CHOUX A STAR (R Scott) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MR HASS (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early stages.

Race 5SWAMPFOXES MEADS CUP CHAMPIONS 1200

SOARING WYVERN (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay out over the concluding stages having to be straightened by its rider.

MAN OF THE WOODS (M Coleman) – Steadied shortly after the start when becoming awkwardly placed on heels losing ground.

BARLEYCOVE (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

TOFFEE POP (S Collett) – Became awkwardly placed having to be steadied after improving on to the heels of SOARING WYVERN which shifted out passing the 300 metres.

OVERTHEMARK (A Calder) – Raced wide without cover.

GUILLOCHARM (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

T Newman (SPINNAKER BAY) - Issued with a warning for her whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 6 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE

QUALITY PREVAILS (J Bayliss) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

CABOCHON (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

VALMUR (D Danis) – Had to steady when placed in restricted room to the inside of PONT ALMA (O Bosson) which shifted in passing the 200 metres. O Bosson was advised to exercise care.

KEEPELLA HEIGHTS (J Fawcett) – Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres.

Race 7 COMAG LTD 1600

SPLENDIDO (G Cooksley) – Slow away. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

ELEGANT D'ORO (N Bakar) – Over-raced in the early stages.

AUGUST EDITION (E McCall) – Held up until passing the 300 metres.

Race 8 PREAKNESS, BELMONT & CUBA WITH WHEELS 1200

PINOT GREY (O Bosson) - Came together with OLIVIA on jumping away when both runners began awkwardly.

OLIVIA (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.

PITCH AND SWITCH (V Colgan) – Reared as the start was effected and as a result lost ground.

REBEL ROSE (J Fawcett) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of GIANT GEM (T Yanagida) which shifted in passing the 150 metres. T Yanagida was advised to exercise care.

SHOW BIRD (L Satherley) – Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of PINOT GREY which shifted in approaching the 200 metres.

O Bosson (PINOT GREY) – Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of SHOW BIRD which was briefly steadied near the 200 metres.

ABBEY KAY (C Lammas) – Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres.

Race 9 SHACKELL ELECTRICAL 2200

DELUXE EDITION (R Scott) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

WINDOW SHOPPING (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.

NEDDY NADEEM (S Collett) – Began awkwardly.

MORRELLMAC (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly shifting in bumping MISS CAMPBELL which became unbalanced losing ground. Commenced to over-race making the bend awkwardly shifting out across heels near the 1700 metres.

UABASSO (D Johnson) – Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously in the early stages having to be firmly restrained and shift out off heels approaching the 1700 metres.

MISS CAMPBELL (D Prastiyou) – Over-raced in the early stages.
