RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES 2100 (2100 Metres)
<p>RED AURORA (Z Moki) - Jumped away awkwardly, checked to avoid heels near the 1900 metres then continuing to over-race through the middle stages on a moderate pace, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that after beginning poorly the gelding had raced ungenerously and failed to finish the race off. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.</p> <p>COG KNISH (R Myers) - Slow away.</p> <p>W Pinn (OUR MATRIARCH) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount OUR MATRIARCH to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of GRAND REX which had to be restrained, going back onto RED AURORA which was checked near the 1900 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee imposed a suspension from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 12 August until the conclusion of racing on Thursday 23 August (5 national riding days).</p> <p>GRAND REX (S MacNab) -Had to be firmly restrained to avoid heels near the 1900 metres.</p>	

OUR CHARLI'S ANGEL (C Johnson) - Momentarily held up on the home turn.

Race 2	MERRYLEES HOTEL 2100 (2100 Metres)

RED CLOUD (J Parkes) - Raced in tight quarters in the run to the winning post on the first occasion.

FINN (T Johnson) - Slow away, made the final turn awkwardly forcing WEE BISKIT over extra ground passing the 400 metres.

WEE BISKIT (C Dell) - Hampered when forced over extra ground passing the 400 metres.

S O'Malley (HIGH QUALITY) - Spoken to regarding his whip use prior to the 100 metres.

Race 3	SCALETEC WEIGHING TECHNOLOGY 1200 (1200 Metres)

GUILLADA (D Hirini) - Slow away, settled back in the early stages.

POSH POROTENE (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly had failed to cope with today's heavy track conditions.

Race 4	MARTY & DI'S CATERING 1200 (1200 Metres)

ROUGE (M Singh) - Began very awkwardly almost dislodging its rider hampering AFTER YOU, then struck a heel of THATZ DAISY and blundered, steadied when crowded 150 metres.

AFTER YOU (C Johnson) - Hampered start losing ground, held up near the 300 metres and when shifting outwards to obtain clear running forced THATZ DAISY wider on the track. C Johnson was advised to exercise care.

DRATINI (J Parkes) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages, lay out rounding the final turn.

COWBOYS DON'T CRY (H Durrant) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

W Pinn (HEAVENLY ECHO) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards under pressure crowding ROUGE near the 150 metres.

THATZ DAISY (S O'Malley) - Inconvenienced passing the 400 metres when SIMPLY DEVINE (R Myers) shifted outwards to obtain clear running. R Myers was advised to exercise care. Forced wider passing the 300 metres.

REKOHU DIVA (T Johnson) - Briefly held up near the 300 metres.

Race 5	SHANE BROWN RACING 1400 (1400 Metres)

KEEP IT UP (D Hirini) and **TAVISTELLA** (S MacNab) were crowded leaving the barriers between MADAM MAKFI and SON OF ANNA KAY which both began awkwardly and shifted ground. HEINEKEN HANK also began very awkwardly from the outside barrier and shifted inwards abruptly hampering TORQUE TIME, ITALIAN LOVER and RELIABLY PERKY, which were all forced inwards with RELIABLY PERKY making solid contact with SON OF ANNA KAY, further crowding TAVISTELLA onto KEEP IT UP. In this incident the left rein of S MacNab became entangled around the foot of D Hirini for a distance before S MacNab was able to regain her rein but losing ground in the process. As a result D Hirini lost the use of her irons and the saddle shifted with the gelding then unable to be ridden competitively for the remainder of the race.

TAVISTELLA (S MacNab) - Crowded at start, hampered when rein entangled losing ground.

MADAM MAKFI (T Johnson) - Began awkwardly.

SON OF ANNA KAY (D Turner) - Began awkwardly.

ITALIAN LOVER (L Allpress) - Hampered start, raced keenly in the early to middle stages, when questioned regarding performance rider advised that after suffering interference at the start the mare had then wanted to over-race and had failed to finish the race off as a consequence adding that it may not have been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

TORQUE TIME (C Johnson) - Hampered start, raced three wide without cover, came together with **HEINEKEN HANK** passing the 75 metres.

RELIABLY PERKY (W Pinn) - Hampered start.

HEINEKEN HANK (C-M Waddell) - Began very awkwardly, came together with **TORQUE TIME** passing the 75 metres.

Race 6	DANNEVIRKE DAIRY SUPPLIES 1400 (1400 Metres)

DUFFERS CREEK (T Taiaroa) - Raced wide without cover.

ZAC BROWN (S MacNab) - Rider reported the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.

OUTSTANDING (M Singh) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuses.

BROTHER ONE (L Allpress) - Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 7	THE LAVENDER FARM WOODVILLE 1600 (1600 Metres)

KINI MARIE (D Hirini) - Slow away.

THE BIEBER (M Singh) - Raced wide without cover.

ROYAL DIAMOND (T Johnson) - Compounded from the 600 metres finishing a distant last. A post-race veterinary examination was clear.

OBRIGADO (W Pinn) - Steadied when placed in restricted room shortly after the start, lay out under pressure in the final straight.

HANDSOME BLUE (C Dell) - Rider reported that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and may benefit from the addition of a tongue tie.

Race 8	MURRAY CONTRACTORS 1600 (1600 Metres)

EM KAY POPS (T Johnson) - Slow away, steadied when improving onto heels near the 100 metres.

MY TOMMY (C Johnson) - Raced wide without cover.

GORBACHEV (D Hirini) - Raced three wide without cover.

LOOK OUT (L Allpress) - Hung outwards throughout.

SWISS ANGEL (J Parkes) - Rider reported that the mare failed to handle today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be suffering from the thumps and tachycardia. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to **SWISS ANGEL** racing next.
